

Romans 15:4 [4]For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope.

Remember what our foremothers did.

Numbers 12:1 [1]And Miriam and Aaron spake against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: for he had married an Ethiopian woman.

She was talking about Moses wife and Aaron as well.

We are not to marry out of our nation.

Numbers 12:2

[2]And they said, Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? hath he not spoken also by us? And the LORD heard it.

They were trying to usurp authority over Moses. They were saying they knew the scriptures too.

Miriam didnt follow this scripture.

1 Timothy 2:12 [12]But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence.

Definition or usurp: to take a position of power by force.

She was trying to be on the same level as Moses.

Numbers 12:3 [3](Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)

What's Meek? Zephaniah 2:3 [3]Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.

Out of the men of the earth Moses was the most righteous.

Numbers 12:4

[4]And the LORD spake suddenly unto Moses, and unto Aaron, and unto Miriam, Come out ye three unto the tabernacle of the congregation. And they three came out.

Imagine this after shes running her mouth TMH comes out to defend Moses. Tmh was angry

Numbers 12:5-7

[5]And the LORD came down in the pillar of the cloud, and stood in the door of the tabernacle, and called Aaron and Miriam: and they both came forth.

[6]And he said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, I the LORD will make myself known unto him in a vision, and will speak unto him in a dream.

[7]My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house.

Moses is different.

Numbers 12:8-9

[8]With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the LORD shall he behold: wherefore then were ye not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?

His telling them to know their place.

Miriam was right but the way shes usurping authority is wrong. You still cant strive and go railing for railing. You have to know how to speak to your husband.

Asking them why were they not afraid to go against Moses?

Women will run their mouths and TMH is listening to it.

Can you submit to gu or husband? You have to learn to apply these scriptures.

[9]And the anger of the LORD was kindled against them; and he departed.

Tmh was angry for them arguing with him in that.

Scripture speaks about doing things decently and in order. Just wait on the lord. Send up your prayer and wait.

Numbers 12:10-11

[10]And the cloud departed from off the tabernacle; and, behold, Miriam became leprous, white as snow: and Aaron looked upon Miriam, and, behold, she was leprous.

God plagued her for running her mouth. Some wives like to run their mouths. There's a God who can make you sick, or kill you. Scripture says study to be quiet. Some Israelite women, this is so hard.

[11]And Aaron said unto Moses, Alas, my lord, I beseech thee, lay not the sin upon us, wherein we have done foolishly, and wherein we have sinned.

Aaron started begging for her. Aaron was in order. Scripture says the woman to not usurp authority. Don't lose your seat over foolishness.

Numbers 12:12-14

[12]Let her not be as one dead, of whom the flesh is half consumed when he cometh out of his mother's womb.

The Lord is listening to me and my house.

Malachi 3:16

[16]Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

The Lord listens to our conversations. If you need help call an Elder sister to get counsel. Everything you say is being written down. A book of remembrance for all of us. Work everyday to be respectful and loving for your husband.

[13]And Moses cried unto the LORD, saying, Heal her now, O God, I beseech thee.

Moses asked God to heal her.

[14]And the LORD said unto Moses, If her father had but spit in her face, should she not be ashamed seven days? let her be shut out from the camp seven days, and after that let her be received in again.

Spit in her face mean her father taught her how to be respectful.

This behavior starts at a young age. Pay the scriptures on training up child.

Ezekiel 16:44

[44]Behold, every one that useth proverbs shall use this proverb against thee, saying, As is the mother, so is her daughter.

Titus 2:3-5

[3]The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

Aged women the

[4]That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

Sober means to be serious.

[5]To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

Ecclesiasticus 26:2 [2]A virtuous woman rejoiceth her husband, and he shall fulfil the years of his life in peace.

Rejoice means to make him happy.

Ecclesiasticus 26:13 [13]The grace of a wife delighteth her husband, and her discretion will fatten his bones. She makes him happy and thinks ahead for him. How to make things easier, more comfortable for him.

Ecclesiasticus 26:14 [14]A silent and loving woman is a gift of the Lord; and there is nothing so much worth as a mind well instructed. Still be silent as a woman.

What is loving? Examples.

Your husband came home from work, you may have ran him a hot bath. Making sure he's comfortable.

Marriage takes work.

Mind well instructed = Dinner ready prepared when he gets home.

Genesis 3:16

[16]Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

Definition of Desire : A strong feeling

Synonyms: Yearning, want, need, determined

You have to become that woman he likes.

You need to start learning your husband and become it.

Try to aspire to this.

Whatever you like woman. You're there to serve him.

When you want to do it. He can feel it. Learn how to make a man feel good.

Ecclesiasticus 26:14-15

[14]A silent and loving woman is a gift of the Lord; and there is nothing so much worth as a mind well instructed.

[15]A shamefaced and faithful woman is a double grace, and her continent mind cannot be valued.

Shamefaced = shy Present it kindly and worth respect. It's all about how you present it and if your being kind. Are you being loving?

Continent = content For now its enough. Until TMH gives us more your content. APTTMH for what we do have.

The love comes from each other.

The love is in the people not in materials. Tmh has given us men who love us, love him and their children. We need to be content.

Ecclesiasticus 26:25

[25]A shameless woman shall be counted as a dog; but she that is shamefaced will fear the Video : Tyler Perry's Why Did I Get Married 2 - Angry Train

These type of women are not going to make it in.

Numbers 12:14

[14]And the LORD said unto Moses, If her father had but spit in her face, should she not be ashamed seven days? let her be shut out from the camp seven days, and after that let her be received in again.

Were starting over again. Tmh is testing u to see if were worthy to get the kingdom.

Numbers 12:15

[15]And Miriam was shut out from the camp seven days: and the people journeyed not till Miriam was brought in again.Lord.

Ecclesiasticus 26:26

[26]A woman that honoureth her husband shall be judged wise of all; but she that dishonoureth him in her pride shall be counted ungodly of all.

Proverbs 31:10 [10]Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price is far above rubies.

Proverbs 31:26 [26]She openeth her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the law of kindness.

Every time you speak to your husband it needs to be wisdom or study to be quiet.

Wife is supposed to be a kind woman.

When you open your mouth what is that like? Miriam was right but the way she went about it was wrong. We have to train ourselves to be kind.

Practice makes perfect.

Fast and pray for TMH to give you a humble spirit. Ask TMH. It's a spiritual change.

Ecclesiasticus 36:22-24 [22]The beauty of a woman cheereth the countenance, and a man loveth nothing better. Take care of yourselves.

[23]If there be kindness, meekness, and comfort, in her tongue, then is not her husband like other men.

Comfort- you know how to being him back. If not you, need pray for a comforting tongue.

Romans 12:2 [2]And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Transform into a meek, kind, shamefaced wife.

John 6:63

[63]It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

You have to change your spirit.

Proverbs 3:5-6 [5]Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

Lean is a slow process of going back to the old woman.

Old woman who used to be sinful and evil.

[6]In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

TMH is going to help you. A soft answer turns away wrath. (Proverbs 15:1) You have to learn how to speak softly. A soft spiritual answer.

Matthew 5:38-39 [38]Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth:

Taught in world if my husband belittled me, I'm belittle him.

[39]But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.

"But" means opposite.

"Turn to him the other also" means You ignore the person Don't go railing for railing.

1 Peter 3:9

[9]Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.

Railing is arguing. Study to be quiet. Pray for your lords and put it into action. There's a blessing called the kingdom that you will inherit for keeping your mouth shut. Ask TMH to increase your faith.

2 Timothy 2:24 [24]And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient,

Wait for each other to calm down.

Be gentle to your husband, that's what makes a marriage work.

Ephesians 5:22 [22]Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.

Definition of submit. To accept of a superior force.

As a wife, it means to fall back to how he wants it.

That's how serious marriage is, as its onto Christ. If it's in sin so not follow him.

Ephesians 5:23 [23]For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

Your husband is over you. He is over you. Whoever the head is that is who you need to follow. The head does mean when you feel like listening. You follow what he likes, that's a successful marriage. When you break the order that's when everything goes out of place.

1 Timothy 4:12

[12]Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

Dont hate when you come into this truth and you have to do this change. You have to be an example of what an Israelite women looks like.

In your words, your conversation (the kids are listening), and genuine (You have to want your marriage to work).

Additions to Esther 14:13

[13]Give me eloquent speech in my mouth before the lion: turn his heart to hate him that fighteth against us, that there may be an end of him, and of all that are likeminded to him:

She had a husband with a rough spirit.

Eloquent speech (Definition): persuasive in speaking.

Your able to persuade your husband through your speech.

Some women are married to men who are rough. Use eloquent speech righteously.

Ecclesiasticus 21:1-2

[1]My son, hast thou sinned? do so no more, but ask pardon for thy former sins.

If you have sinned, been disrespectful in your mind, that's evil too.

TMH says stop. He tells us to handle problems different. He tells us to be shamefaced.

Ask forgiveness for all those times you did do it.

[2]Flee from sin as from the face of a serpent: for if thou comest too near it, it will bite thee: the teeth thereof are as the teeth of a lion, slaying the souls of men.

Use a soft answer.
