Ecclesiastes 8:1 (KJV) Who *is the* wise *man*? and who knoweth the interpretation of a thing? a man's wisdom maketh his face shine, and the boldness of his face shall be changed. To everything there is a season

2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJV) Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. When we come into the truth, we change

Ecclesiastes 9:10 (KJV) Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do *it* with thy might; for there *is* no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest. You fight for your marriage with all your might and soul.

vs 11 (She *is* loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house: She is loud and argumentative. She always has an opinion. The woman that wants to rule over her man carries a combative spirit.

vs 12 Now is she without, now in the streets, and lieth in wait at every corner.) She won't abide at home. Abide meaning she will not except her role & act accordingly

Sirach 25:20 (KJV) As the climbing up a sandy way is to the feet of the aged, so is a wife full of words to a quiet man. Don't step out of your role. for an example your husband is quiet and lay back... don't take advantage of that by not asking his permission and doing what you want.and don't be the energizer bunny always talking

Proverbs 9:13 (KJV) A foolish woman is clamorous: she is simple, and knoweth nothing. Don't be clamorous (loud) Clamorous making a loud confused noise

Proverbs 11:29 (KJV) He that troubleth his own house shall inherit the wind: and the fool shall be servant to the wise of heart. Constantly arguing and bickering correct so stressful troublesome environments with no peace at home.

Sirach 7:26-26 (KJV) Hast thou a wife after thy mind? forsake her not: but give not thyself over to a light woman. She believes that he will eventually get tired and give and it's better to play your role don't create division in the home

Sirach 25:16 (KJV) I had rather dwell with a lion and a dragon, than to keep house with a wicked woman. This man would rather live with two dangerous animals until there was a dragon better to live with a lion than a dragon in the house.

Proverbs 17:27 (KJV) Who shall praise the most High in the grave, instead of them which live and give thanks?

How do I change the atmosphere? Take your time to know your lord. Do it in a wise manner; be direct take emotion out of it

Titus 2:5 (KJV) To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

Providing a peaceful environment is critical to your house. Also, create tranquility at home. It's more than cooking and cleaning; Know your husband. Men need time to rejuvenate at least 2 hours a day... Be consistent with this.

1 Peter 5:8 (KJV) Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

You must understand the evil of this world isn't going anywhere.

1 John 5:19 (KJV) And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness. Make sure when you examine your marriage. When you observe your husband not wanting to be at home, find out how to make the home pleasant for him.

Matthew 26:10 (KJV) When Jesus understood it, he said unto them, Why trouble ye the woman? for she hath wrought a good work upon me. The woman with the precious ointment coming to Christ. Your reward might not come right then. The ultimate reward is the kingdom.

Isaiah 58:9 (KJV) Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I am. If thou take away from the midst of the yoke, the putting forth of the finger, and speaking vanity; We as wives should not always point the finger. Watch your actions, make sure your actions line up with the scriptures.

- 1. Withholding sex This is dangerous Be mindful; someone will give him what he needs if you don't.
- 1 Corinthians 7:2-5 (KJV) vs 2 Nevertheless, to avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband. vs 3 Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband.
- vs 4 The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body, but the wife. vs
 5 Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency. Don't defraud your husband of what he needs. Withhold only with agreement of fasting and prayer.
 - 2. Treating your lord as a child –

Another way you emasculate him – being disrespectful in speech.

Ephesians 5:33 (KJV) Nevertheless let every one of you so love his wife even as himself; and the wife sees that she reverence her husband.

You should see Christ in your lord... We are to reverence our husbands Reverence: having a deep respect

Psalm 12:3 (KJV) The LORD shall cut off all flattering lips, and the tongue that speaketh proud things:

- 3. Flattering him The Lord will cut off the flattering lips (lying lips) It's deceitful & done maliciously
- 4. Compared to other men Don't bring up past relationships. What if he did that to you? Don't compare... Comparison causes insecurity.

Encourage your lord to spend time with those you admire. Iron sharpens iron

Men cannot be emotional men. Having a weak man is not attractive, build him up if he is weak.

Genesis 2: 18-25 18 (KJV) vs 18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. vs 19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. vs 20 And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him. vs 21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; vs 22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. vs 23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. vs 24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh. vs 25 And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed. they shall be one flesh we were created for them they need our help

Learn your lord... figure him out. You cannot treat your lord like a child.

Scriptures mention live joyfully with the wife of your youth.

Romans 5:3 (KJV) And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; Trials make you more patient Job 5: 17-18 (KJV) vs 17 Behold, happy is the man whom God correcteth: therefore despise not thou the chastening of the Almighty: vs 18 For he

maketh sore, and bindeth up: he wounded, and his hands make whole. The Most High must jack you up before making you whole. Sometimes the Most High does this with some marriages.

Ephesians 5:20-31 (KJV) vs 20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; vs 21 Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God. vs 22 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. vs 23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body. vs 24 Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. vs 25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; vs 26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, **vs 27** That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. vs 28 So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself. vs 29 For no man ever vet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church: vs 30 For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. vs 31 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh.

Submit yourself to your role. Don't let the lines get blurred. Wives are to submit to their husbands in everything. The church starts at home, we are one body/one team/one unit.

If you have a separatism spirit, working not as a team... the marriage won't last.

1 Samuel 15:23 (KJV) For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king. Rebelliousness = witchcraft Scriptures mention the Most High does not suffer a witch to live.

Are you going to be rebellious?

Joshua 1:8 (KJV) This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. Once we start keeping the laws as they are written we will have prosperity and great success

Sirach 26:26 (KJV) A woman that honoureth her husband shall be judged wise of all; but she that dishonoureth him in her pride shall be counted ungodly of all.

A woman that honors her husband is judged wise; a woman that doesn't honor her husband is counted ungodly.

2 Esdras 9:7 – 12 (KJV) vs 7 And every one that shall be saved, and shall be able to escape by his works, and by faith, whereby ye have believed, **vs 8** Shall be preserved from the said perils, and shall see my salvation in my land, and within my borders: for I have sanctified them for me from the beginning. **vs 9** Then shall they be in pitiful case, which now have abused my ways: and they that have cast them away despitefully shall dwell in torments. **vs 10** For such as in their life have received benefits, and have not known me; **vs 11** And they that have loathed my law, while they had yet liberty, and, when as yet place of repentance was open unto them, understood not, but despised it; **vs 12** The same must know it after death by pain.

By your works, you are saved from these torments

The sinners (law abusers) will dwell in destruction & torment. The sinners hate the laws. They will know death by pain.

Ecclesiastes 8:11-13 (KJV) vs 11 Because sentence against evil work is not executed speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil. vs 12 Though a sinner do evil an hundred times, and his days be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear God, which fear before him: vs 13 But it shall not be well with the wicked, neither shall he prolong his days, which are as a shadow; because

he feareth not before God. Because your judgment doesn't happen immediately. People that do this, get comfortable in sin.

- **2 Peter 2:9 (KJV)** The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished: For sinners, it will be reserved punishment on the day of judgment.
- **2 Peter 2:20 (KJV)** For if after they have escaped the pollution of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. It's better to stay in the world then it is to know the law and forsake it to go back to the world (the judgment will be greater)

James 2:10 (KJV) For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.

Galatians 2:17-18 (KJV) vs 17 But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, is therefore Christ the minister of sin? God forbid. **vs 18** For if I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor.

We seek to be justified by Christ ...But are yet sinners. This goes to the old law of sacrifice. Grace is now the ultimate sacrifice we cannot still deal and soon I will

Revelation 20:11-13 (KJV) vs 11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. vs 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. vs 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

These books that are opened gives us a count of our entire lives as in accordance with the law. We are judged according to our actions no other

actions. Those not found in the book of life will be cast into the lake of fire.

2 Esdras 8:38-39 (KJV) vs 38 For indeed I will not think on the disposition of them which have sinned before death, before judgment, before destruction: **vs 39** But I will rejoice over the disposition of the righteous, and I will remember also their pilgrimage, and the salvation, and the reward, that they shall have.

Before these things happen, the Most High doesn't care about what led up to it (disposition/mood) the Most High will rejoice over the disposition of the righteous.

We need to take the Most High seriously. This is our final captivity.

The Most High word doesn't return to him void. Be serious about these laws. Challenge: write down what you deal with that's against the Most High and try to deal with it
