During the Feast of Tabernacles (Leviticus 23: 33-34, Lev 23: 41-43) we are commanded to dwell in booths for 8 days. In these modern times, that means we..... Go Camping! Take the time to prepare your child for the adventure and creating memories they won't soon forget!
