Susanna 1:1 There dwelt a man in Babylon, called Joacim:




Susanna was a beautiful woman and she feared the Lord

When we read it how do we become like this to teach our children


Are we going over the basics and implement this in our life?

Mama- you want your daughter to be better than you not make the same mistakes you made before the truth in this wicked world we live in


If you are young and raised in this truth count it as a blessing

She was raised in the truth and married to a wealth man


She was married to leadership

Susanna 1:10 And albeit they both were wounded with her love, yet durst not one shew another his grief.


Creepy perverts

Sun going down and everyone says goodnight.


They did not leave they both trailed back to watch Susanna

Israel is wise to do evil


Susanna 1:15 And it fell out, as they watched a fit time, she went in as before with two maids only, and she was desirous to wash herself in the garden: for it was hot.

Susanna 1:20 Behold, the garden doors are shut, that no man can see us, and we are in love with thee; therefore consent unto us and lie with us.


You are naked as the day you were born. These two men you have an esteem for because they are judges and they bust in there.

Right now, since they are watching her, they are off and they are building a case.


When you even think upon another married woman you already in sin

If you don't like the life you are living, make the changes thus saith the Lord


Precept

Susanna screams very aloud. The elders acted like something was wrong and they screamed too. To play it off.


Susanna 1:25 Then ran the one, and opened the garden door.




They ran to the door like they didn't know what was going on

Susanna 1:32 And these wicked men commanded to uncover her face, (for she was covered) that they might be filled with her beauty.



It's like a funeral. They know they about to put her to death




When a person commits a sin, they don't only hurt themselves but the people that love them




Susanna weep and loom towards heaven

Precept


Leviticus 24:14- the point two elders put they hands on her head that means they was ready to put her to death. That's when she sent her prayers up.

The Lord heard her voice.


Going around in the congregation that is not edifying.

Susanna 1:47 Then all the people turned them toward him, and said, What mean these words that thou hast spoken?



He's mocking him ohhhh you are an elder now.


We know how Israel is like you all knowing

Northern Kingdom sisters did it because they were scared. MH out the spirit on Daniel to see this.

We have not yet been brought to blood. Gird up loins.


We must go through trials to exercise patience to endure


