

**<u>1 Corinthians 12:4 (KJV</u>)** Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.

- > Many different gifts we will have but we should all work in the same gifts in one spirit
- > Do the work with fruit of the spirit

# Ask yourself:

Do I have the fruit of the spirits? Am I longsuffering

• Examine yourself

# Am I peaceful to work with others?

- Discipline ourselves to handle it in the right way
- Am I patience with my sisters?
  - We all trying to get the Kingdom
  - As an Israelite women, we don't know how to work together as a team >> but we must all learn to work together

**<u>1</u> Thessalonians 4:11 (KJV)** And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;

- Study to be quiet
- Just carry out what is being asked and take instructions
  - Example a sister is over sewing office. You should not say what you think is better. You are there to follow.
  - If the sister ask for feedback that's difference
  - Everybody has a place and purpose you just have to find out what yours is

#### Once you find out your gift you want to jump in and go running...

- It's okay to be quiet and be in subjection to who's over that office
  - Sometimes, it's not your time
- The Most High place someone in there for you to follow first. When the Most High sees fit he will elevate you

## **<u>1 Corinthians 12:5 (KJV)</u>** And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.

- > Different administrations but the same Lord
- Such as...
  - Kitchen team
  - Children team
  - Cleaning team
- It's all of the Lord
- > We all are working for the Most High

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:6 (KJV) And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

- Different operations
  - Deacon over the Captain
  - Captain over the Officers
- > However, we still working for the Most High

#### Did I apply the fruits of the spirits?

## Have long suffering and patience...

- > Apply it for yourself and teach others by your example
  - Stop the fighting, arguing and stop throwing shade
- If you need to work on charity, ask the Lord for it
- > If your failing miserable it's because you're not applying what's in this book

#### **<u>1 Corinthians 12:7 (KJV)</u>** But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

- Coming through with your gift
  - Your spirit is to profit the nation



The gift is not for you to have vainglory, it's for the nations profit

- It's to profit everyone around you

Galatians 5:26 (KJV) Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.

Don't provoke your sisters

**Define Vainglory** - inordinate pride in oneself or one's achievements, excessive vanity.

- Examples: Oh I sew the best. Oh I cook the best
  - Share to uplift, not to be better than your sisters
  - Don't be jealous of your sisters

# "Idle time is the devil's playground"

**Romans 12:3 (KJV)** For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

- Don't start feeling yourself...
- > Being so blinded to other because you think you're better than those around you
- > When we learn the scriptures, we need to be nice to others

# <u>Titus 3:3-5 (KJV)</u>

vs 3 For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another.

vs 4 But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared,

<u>vs 5</u> Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

- > The Love of sisterhood and family is all we have
- > The scripture is reminding us how we once were
  - We were all once young and not doing things according to the scriptures
- > Be there for each other and stop being emotional and petty

Galatians 6:3 (KJV) For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.

- > We are acting like we are something and really, we are deceiving ourselves
- > The only thing making us something is the laws

**Philippians 2:3 (KJV)** Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.

- > The Lord said to compliment each other. Esteem other higher than thyself
- > Don't have vainglory excessive pride in yourself
  - Be humble
  - \_



- When you're blessed with...
  - A new car use it to help nation
  - A new house use it help nation
  - Extra money use it help nation
- > Don't use it to ball out and think you better than others

**Philippians 2:4 (KJV)** Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

- > Don't worry just about you, find out what your sisters and brothers need
- > Help the nation

**Philippians 2:5 (KJV)** Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

- Christ had love for the nation
- > Christ said put this in your mind, be concern of who's in need

**Philippians 2:8 (KJV)** And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

- > Christ took the beating so we can get another chance
  - Christ didn't talk back; he was not prideful. But you prideful and think you're better than others
- > Yes, your sisters are going to get on your nerves but are you going to apply thus saith the Lord?
- Remember Gentleness, Meekness and Kindness

# <u>Sirach 3:18 (Apocrypha)</u> The greater thou art, the more humble thyself, and thou shalt find favour before the Lord.

- > The greater you are, meaning the higher you go, the more humble you will be
- Be more compassion, and patient

#### Leadership wives has to be extremely humble...

- Sisters who are new have to learn from sisters, those who been here long time you have to be humble and not stop mistreating the people
- > The Most High will favor you. "Look at her I moved her up and look how humble she is"
- > You may be praying for a new house, car, and job. Most High is going to help you.
  - Why? Because you stayed humble
- > You can be firm and humble, just don't treat others as if they are beneath you

# **Luke 14:11 (KJV)** For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

- You walk around like you High & Mighty, having vain glory. The Most High will abased you meaning "Throw you out the seat"
- > Humble himself because you doing for the Most High, and He will exalt you to better
- Sister may be disrespectful a couple times, you must stay humble and Most High will deal with her
- > When you allow someone to move you you give them too much power over you
  - It's not worth you not getting the Kingdom because you couldn't rule your spirit



- Give no people power over your salvation
- You're eating the bread and drinking the wine for nothing if you are not doing it for the Most High.
- > You can play the blame game but you going to get it too
- God sending a test, are you failing or passing?

**<u>2</u>** Corinthians 10:5 (KJV) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

- > Bring into captivity... it's like taking to jail every evil thought
  - You have to bring it to this book (the Bible)
  - If it's not pleasing to God, be quiet. It doesn't matter what the other people did, it's about what you do
  - Stop saying what others did, focus on you according to this book
  - When they reviled Christ, he did not reviled back
- Bring every thought into the subjection of Christ
  - Until you get to that level of discipline you not going to make it in
- Put every thought into subjection of what God says
  - Examples: Sister get on my nerves and I want to quit? Remember Sirach 2:1
- > Why when working for Esau we listen and don't quit because it's a check
- Imagine Bishop wanted to quit when Deacons got on his nerves? No
  That's not the attitude to have

#### Your check (your reward) is the Kingdom...

**<u>1</u> Thessalonians 4:11 (KJV)** And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;

- Sister want to explain everything... Proverbs 15:1
- Study to be quiet. Everything doesn't need an answer.
  - Be quiet
  - If it's not working, fast and pray
  - Listen and learn the word

#### Ask yourself:

Am I handling it according to God or according to myself?

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:8 (KJV) For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;

- Some people get a lot of wisdom, they have great wisdom and some people get knowledge
  They both work for the same spirit and that's God
- > Are we helping the nation when we are fighting and arguing? No.
  - We must work together
- God wants exceptional women
  - When someone does evil and you don't do evil back



**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:9 (KJV) To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

- Some sisters have great faith when everyone else lacks faith
  - Example: Foremother Judith had faith
- Some sisters have the gift of healing
  - Healing a sister is sad, she wants to harm herself, but she then speaks to a sister or brother and she feels revived because that's their gift that they have from the Most High

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:10 (KJV) To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

- Disciples had power to work miracles
- Some people can prophesy what's going to happen before it happens
- Some can discern spirits, soon as you walk in the room they can tell right away
  - Example: Foremother Susanna story raised up Daniel to speak on her behalf, that was a gift for the Lord
- Some people can speak many languages
- Some can interpret many languages
  - Nothing for us to be jealous of
  - We are to work together
  - Don't be jealous, don't have envy towards one another
- > Your gift will show in time
  - Ask God to bring it out
  - I am jealous of sister A, B, and C. "Lord take that spirit off me so I can help my sisters and be better."
  - Tell the Most High what you're struggling with, after your prayer fast about it
  - If you act like it's not there, everyone will be able to see it. That's evil
- Let's work together for the Lord

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:11 (KJV) But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

- > We are moving as one body, one nation under God
- > Whatever gift others have, the Most High gave it to them
- > You chose your husband so you deal with him correctly.
  - You waited for him so submit to him in all things in righteousness
- > You are mad at another sister's gift that the Most High found worthy >> That's evil.
  - So you're actually mad at God
- > You may not like her in that seat but God placed her in that seat. So fall in line

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:12 (KJV) For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.

- > Although it's one body, it's many members and there's many gifts
  - The Most High gave those gifts as he liked



**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:13 (KJV) For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

- > One spirit working together for the glory of God
- > When you start trouble, you cause issues in God's program
- Bondage captivity still got to keep the commandments
- Free still got to keep the commandments
- We was all called to keep the commandments, speaking the same thing >> no matter what you go through
- > One Body One Spirit One Mind
  - Not your own Agenda
- > Take off your unrepentant mind and put on Christ mind

#### Ask Yourself:

- What I did, was it pleasing to God?
- When your resume comes up before God will it be pleasing?

**<u>1 Corinthians 12:14 (KJV)</u>** For the body is not one member, but many.

The nation is not all about you, one person, but about the many of us working as a unit together

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:15 (KJV) If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

- Visual: Your feet are used for walking, can your foot tell your hand I am not of the body.
- Are these body parts not important?

- Yes, they are

- Every member is important stop acting like we better than each other and we need one another
- > Everyone is important in this truth, playing their important roles
- > You don't know what a sister is called to do for the Lord
  - It's not your program

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:16 (KJV) And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

- ➢ Ear − used for hearing
  - Can the ear tell the eye we don't need you
- Eye used for seeing
  - Can the eye tell the ear we don't need them
- > We need each other

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:17 (KJV) If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?

- If your whole body was one big eyeball how will you touch and hear
- If the whole body was an ear how will you smell or taste anything



- It's not about one person, it's about the whole body working together.
- Each member has a purpose from God and God placed them here to do a job
- > Everybody is important in this truth
- > We must start seeing Christ in each other
  - We must do better

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:18 (KJV) But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

God said I placed the members where they need to be because it pleases him. It's not about you. That's evil

**<u>1 Corinthians 12:19 (KJV)</u>** And if they were all one member, where were the body?

- > If everything was just you how will we get the other jobs done
- We need each other
  - Be kind and respectful to each other gifts

# **<u>1 Corinthians 12:20 (KJV)</u>** But now are they many members, yet but one body.

It's a thousand of us but as a whole, it's one body, keeping the laws statutes and commandments

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:21 (KJV) And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

- > We can't tell the hands and eyes "We don't need them here"
- Head used to think and do what's needed
  - We still can't tell it, "We don't need you" it does it's job
- No sister should feel they are not important in this walk
  - The Most High places you here for a purpose

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:22 (KJV) Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:

- Even the people you look at that can't walk, talk, or cripple are the more feeble people to the Most High.
  - They are all necessary
  - We don't know who the next person is
  - Treat them right according to God
- > Do your job and be humble

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:23 (KJV) And those members of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness.

- You may have sisters in the body and you look down on them and think of them less honourable
  - But The Most High said she important because I sent her there



- Example: Sister in a wheelchair "offer her more honor" thus saith the Lord

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:24 (KJV) For our comely parts have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked:

- > What's not beautiful now he will make them beautiful in his time
  - It's not our job to belittle them
- > God sent them in and the nerve for you to mistreat them is evil
  - God put that member together
- The Most High saw them worthy. We weren't worthily in the world and God called us in this truth
- > We were changed from a not so beautiful thing to a beautiful thing

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:25 (KJV) That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.

- We must train ourselves to look at each other of the spirit and not the other way around.
  The Most High judges us by our spirit
- Same care you give the Most High you give to your sisters and the feeble ones

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:26 (KJV) And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

- > When one member suffers
  - Example: a sister child dies we should all feel her pain
- > If one member gets honored, we all are be honored
  - Sister get honored for doing well in the kitchen we should all be happy
  - She's making all us look good
- > We are one body
- Don't be jealous >> Be happy she did it right

# 1 Corinthians 12:27-29 (KJV)

vs 27 Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

vs 28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.

vs 29 Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles?

- Not everyone are apostles
- > Are All prophets No
  - But learn from them

**<u>1 Corinthians 12:30 (KJV)</u>** Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret?

- > Do All Healing No
- Do All Speak with tongues No
- > Do All Interpret No
  - But learn from them



**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 12:31 (KJV) But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.

- Covet meaning glean from her
  - Ask the Most High to bless you with the same gift and pray that "I can help the nation grow and my sisters as well"

<u>Sirach 20:5 (Apocrypha)</u> There is one that keepeth silence, and is found wise: and another by much babbling becometh hateful.

- Be quiet and you are found wise
- > Too much talking you become hated
