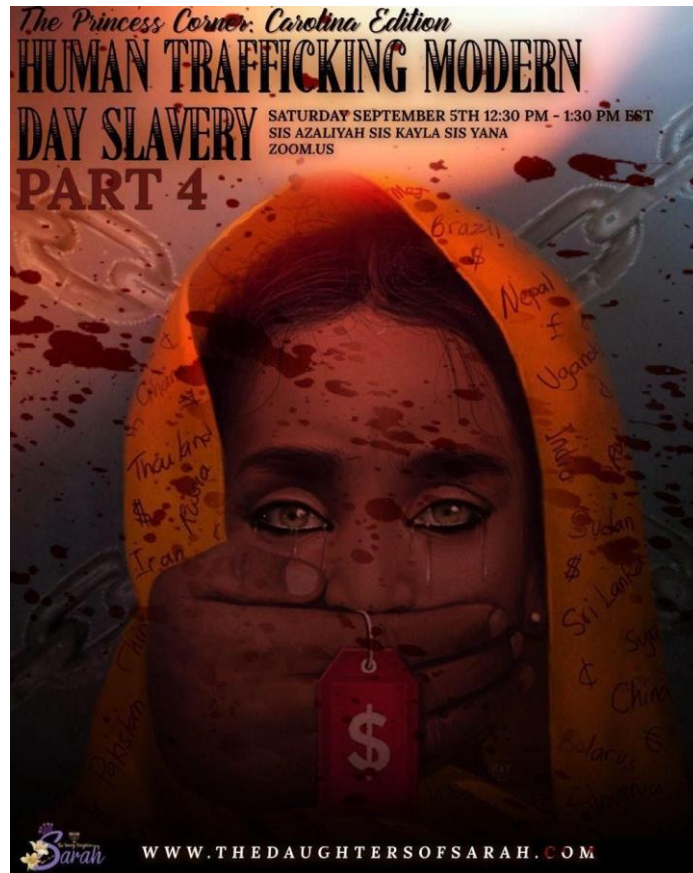

Sis Azaliyah: Today I will be doing a review of the topics we have gone over these past three weeks. We were the first people to be human trafficked essentially based on Deuteronomy 28: 15-68. Our men and women were raped and murdered back then, and the same thing is happening today in human trafficking. Here are some statistics that I found from my research:

- 62% of human trafficking suspects are African Americans
- 52% of all juvenile prostitution arrests are African Americans
- 40% of human trafficking victims are African Americans
- ~ 20.9 million victims of human trafficking in 2012 w/ 1.8 million from northern kingdom countries [[www.fas.org/sgp/crs/row](http://www.fas.org/sgp/crs/row)]

- ❑ According to the Missed Opportunities: Youth Homelessness in America “1 in 10 youth between the ages of 18 and 25 and 1 in 30 youth between the ages of 13 to 17 experience homelessness each year. That is an estimated 4.2 million youth. For blacks that make up this percentage is overwhelming 1,680,000 of our kids.”

**Q:** What do you know about human trafficking among African Americans?

- ❑ In 2018, Essence reported that more than 14,000 calls were made to the National Human Trafficking Hotline.
- ❑ Aka Modern-day slavery
- ❑ Victims are more likely to be African American than other ethnicities

**Some ways enemies’ prey on their victims:**

- ❑ Isolation - the sense of being alone, separated from one other, either socially or emotionally
- ❑ Emotional abuse - behavior that causes psychological trauma or stress (bullying, mocking, humiliating, isolating, yelling)
- ❑ Intimidation - to force into or deter from some action by inducing fear or to make timid
- ❑ Power of Control - to have power over or to bend at will
- ❑ Minimizing - to reduce someone to the smallest possible amount or degree

**Sis Azaliyah: When you see something, say something!!!** The people that harmed me were imprisoned once I spoke up and said something. If you know something that is going on and it is inappropriate, say something.
