Topic: Foremother Esther



Esther 1:1 Now it came to pass in the days of Ahasuerus, (this is Ahasuerus which reigned, from India even unto Ethiopia, over an hundred and seven and twenty provinces:)

King Ahasuerus ruled from India to Ethiopia





Esther 1:2 That in those days, when the king Ahasuerus sat on the throne of his kingdom, which was in Shushan the palace,

Esther 1:3 In the third year of his reign, he made a feast unto all his princes and his servants; the power of Persia and Media, the nobles and princes of the provinces, being before him:

During this time he made a feast. He was reigning over Persia and Media





Esther 1:4 When he shewed the riches of his glorious kingdom and the honour of his excellent majesty many days, even an hundred and fourscore days.

Esther 1:5 And when these days were expired, the king made a feast unto all the people that were present in Shushan the palace, both unto great and small, seven days, in the court of the garden of the king's palace;

He had a party for 180 days. He had a feast straight. They partying daily

Rich and poor came to celebrate in the Kings palace

Esther 1:6 Where were white, green, and blue, hangings, fastened with cords of fine linen and purple to silver rings and pillars of marble: the beds were of gold and silver, upon a pavement of red, and blue, and white, and black, marble.

White hangings from ceilings, blue hangings, purple coming from the ceiling



Floor was blue, white, black and marble



Esther 1:7 And they gave them drink in vessels of gold, (the vessels being diverse one from another,) and royal wine in abundance, according to the state of the king.

Men and women they was all drinking. Drinking out gold cups and bed gold and silver

When they drunk had pure gold glasses. No two cups was the same. Different designs. King said give them abundantance of all kind of wines

They was rich in the castle

Esther 1:8 And the drinking was according to the law; none did compel: for so the king had appointed to all the officers of his house, that they should do according to every man's pleasure.

King gave an order to give permission to the people as much abundance as they want

Esther 1:9 Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women in the royal house which belonged to king Ahasuerus.



King Ahasuerus had a wife name Queen Vashti



She had a feast at her own building. Her women is all decked out

Esther 1:10 On the seventh day, when the heart of the king was merry with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king,

Esther 1:11 To bring Vashti the queen before the king with the crown royal, to shew the people and the princes her beauty: for she was fair to look on.

King having a party. He's excited and wanted to show his wife off. I am going to send for his wife to show her off

Ecclesiasticus 36:22 The beauty of a woman cheereth the countenance, and a man loveth nothing better.

Ecclesiasticus 36:23 If there be kindness, meekness, and comfort, in her tongue, then is not her husband like other men.

Ecclesiasticus 36:24 He that getteth a wife beginneth a possession, a help like unto himself, and a pillar of rest.



Esther 1:12 But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by his chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

The wife refused to come because she was having her own party. She turning up with her girls I can't come right now. King was very angry. Servants told him your wife not coming right now



He sent these men to get his wife and bring her to me

Ephesians 5:22 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.

Ephesians 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

Ephesians 5:24 Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing.

Genesis 3:16 Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

Her desire is unto her husband. She should be doing as he likes. In this truth we should be



1 Corinthians 7:34 There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please her husband.

A women who is married she always be thinking how to please their husband and what makes him feels good. What brings him joy. Vashti wanted to do her own thing

Elder women teach the younger women. So we can have successful marriages

1 Timothy 4:12 Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

When you married you should be example in your speech, conversations and faith and charity and purity pure heart. You not fake and phony with your husband.

Esther 1:12 But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by his chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

King was angers she didn't come

Esther 1:13 Then the king said to the wise men, which knew the times, (for so was the king's manner toward all that knew law and judgment: Esther 1:14 And the next unto him was Carshena, Shethar, Admatha, Tarshish, Meres, Marsena, and Memucan, the seven princes of Persia and Media, which saw the king's face, and which sat the first in the kingdom;)

They started to see his faces

His boys was sitting there with him



Esther 1:15 What shall we do unto the queen Vashti according to law, because she hath not performed the commandment of the king Ahasuerus by the chamberlains?

These men saw she didn't come. They was looking like dang your wife had no respect for you. That's such an insult.

Esther 1:16 And Memucan answered before the king and the princes, Vashti the queen hath not done wrong to the king only, but also to all the princes, and to all the people that are in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

Your wife Vashti didn't only disrespect you because she's your wife however she disrespected all the men.

Why are they saying that? They like your the King and she disrespect you so their wives will do the same thing because she's the First Lady and have no respect. Bad example

Your lord may call you and you don't feel like answering it's disrespectful

Esther 1:17 For this deed of the queen shall come abroad unto all women, so that they shall despise their husbands in their eyes, when it shall be reported, The king Ahasuerus commanded Vashti the queen to be brought in before him, but she came not.

The seven men spoke all the women they going to hear about this and not honor their husbands.

It's a big deal when we don't honor your husband

When all the women hear this all the women going to be disrespectful

Esther 1:18 Likewise shall the ladies of Persia and Media say this day unto all the king's princes, which have heard of the deed of the queen. Thus shall there arise too much contempt and wrath.



Define contempt - the feeling that a person or a thing is beneath consideration, worthless, or deserving scorn.

Scorn is disrespectful

She just didn't come she was disrespectful

We have to put on a new spirit in this truth for the kingdom

Example- we should not be as an unrepentant Israelite women when we should be acting as virtuous women

Esther 1:19 If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.



They made a new law because of her actions

They said put here away for not coming to her husband when he commanded her too



The Lord repeat hisself over and over it's up to us to listen

Give her royal estate position to somebody else that has respect

Example: IUIC a husband get honor from all the men and congregation. His wife come in and talk and treat him with no respect guess what's going to happen to the respect the men had for him. It's gone out the door.

Another husband calls his wife and she don't answer and next week that happen to you that sister like last week his wife did it and no one said anything to her so why they saying something to me. Examples is serious

Estate- Her estate is her riches, Royalty, jewelry, clothes, shoes, and etc...

Pray for patience and fruit of the spirit

Esther 1:20 And when the king's decree which he shall make shall be published throughout all his empire, (for it is great,) all the wives shall give to their husbands honour, both to great and small.

Let's write a new law and send copies of it to everyone

They said when you put her away this new law is from great and small and every man house will respect their husband whether they poor or rich.

Israelite women think it's normal to be disrespectful to their husbands.

Rich or poor the law went out

Define reverence- deep respect for someone or something.

Deep respect

Synonyms: satisfied, pleased, happy

Even when you angry and mad you must have that deep respect for your husband

Play our position as the women

Esther 1:21 And the saying pleased the king and the princes; and the king did according to the word of Memucan:

The King was like you right I don't want to see her anymore I am going to get me another wife I should be honored

Esther 1:22 For he sent letters into all the king's provinces, into every province according to the writing thereof, and to every people after their language, that every man should bear rule in his own house, and that it should be published according to the language of every people.

He sent this letter to every people and every language you better honor your husband

Chapter 2

Esther 2:1 After these things, when the wrath of king Ahasuerus was appeased, he remembered Vashti, and what she had done, and what was decreed against her.

Now he started feeling better

After everything he thought about what his ex wife did and what was decreed against her.



Esther 2:2 Then said the king's servants that ministered unto him, Let there be fair young virgins sought for the king:



Instead of you being alone we going to gather all the young virgins in the land. They was having like a pageant

He don't want a harlot

Teach our daughters to keep their virginity until marriages

Esther 2:3 And let the king appoint officers in all the provinces of his kingdom, that they may gather together all the fair young virgins unto Shushan the palace, to the house of the women, unto the custody of Hege the king's chamberlain, keeper of the women; and let their things for purification be given them:

This is a picture of the virgins they looked like when they enter the place

Images of purification- meaning to wash their bodies





You must take a real good bath.

Your skin should not be looking ashy and your husband can write on you as a repentant Israelite



Your skin should feel like a women and you should smell like a women

Esther 2:4 And let the maiden which pleaseth the king be queen instead of Vashti. And the thing pleased the king; and he did so.



Princes told king whoever pleases you that is who you will have as a Queen

Apply the scripts not just memorize

Which women in this pageant going to please me and make me happy. You know those women was putting on they A game. Purification they gave them to pure themselves, cloths, oils and bath water. We going to get a girl who want to please you the best

Example- your husband spirit is low and angers you can calm him down with your beauty and smell

Esther 2:5 Now in Shushan the palace there was a certain Jew, whose name was Mordecai, the son of Jair, the son of Shimei, the son of Kish, a Benjamite;

There is a man in the city name Mordecai Persia - East Indians Medes - Arabs Before captivity of these two is was Nebuchadnezzar captivity where Mordecai came from





Esther 2:6 Who had been carried away from Jerusalem with the captivity which had been carried away with Jeconiah king of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away.

They was already in Babylon captivity in Africa. Kind of went under the Persian

Esther 2:7 And he brought up Hadassah, that is, Esther, his uncle's daughter: for she had neither father nor mother, and the maid was fair and beautiful; whom Mordecai, when her father and mother were dead, took for his own daughter.

Mordecai has a niece name Esther.

When she went in Persia and Medes captivity they changed her name to Hadassah

Esther father and mother died. Uncle raised her in the law

Esther 2:8 So it came to pass, when the king's commandment and his decree was heard, and when many maidens were gathered together unto Shushan the palace, to the custody of Hegai, that Esther was brought also unto the king's house, to the custody of Hegai, keeper of the women.

Esther was brought to the kings house and brought her to Hegai

So it was many maidens gathered together. Esther went to the pageant and she went to Hegai. Hegai was the keeper / watcher of all the women.





Esther 2:9 And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained kindness of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged to her, and seven maidens, which were meet to be given her, out of the king's house: and he preferred her and her maids unto the best place of the house of the women.

When Esther entered into the kings place the King was pleased with her

She won favor over the man who have all the purification products

Question: what are you like when you go into a place?

He moved fast because how she carried herself.

Image Hegai keeper the women

Question: do you carry yourself as an unrepentant women or virtuous women?

The way she carried herself he gave her the best place in the palace

Fruits of the spirit, she's kind, gentle, peaceful

Esther 2:10 Esther had not shewed her people nor her kindred: for Mordecai had charged her that she should not shew it.

Mordecai said don't tell nobody she's Israel

They didn't know she was a Jew. She didn't tell them who she was.

Esther 2:11 And Mordecai walked every day before the court of the women's house, to know how Esther did, and what should become of her.

Mordecai the uncle every day he checked on his niece. How's she acting and talking daily. That uncle raised her and watched to see how she was carrying herself even though she was grown.

We still should be watching over our children even when they are of age before marriage.

Esther 2:12 Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of the women, (for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, to wit, six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with sweet odours, and with other things for the purifying of the women;)

Every women had a chance that been in line for him. Esther had 12 months to get it together and go one by one to see who he like. She want to wash her goodies.

Our foremother was juicy and silky before she went in to lay with him. She bathed 6 months in certain oils and 6 months in another oils. She was smelling good. We must care for our body. Take baths. You got ninjas turtle toe nails scratching the damn husband up go get a pedicure. You should not be so ashy and he can write his name on you.

They had to bath six months in myrrh and six months in sweet odours before stepping in the Kings face



They honor before going to the king

They had to get they body smelling right before the King

So they will be effeminate when he touch them

Regardless of long you are married we must take care ourselves

Marinade the goodies before lying with your husband

Esther 2:13 Then thus came every maiden unto the king; whatsoever she desired was given her to go with her out of the house of the women unto the king's house.

As the Women goes up to the King and they needed extra Hegai got it for them

You had to win him over to even see if you worthy of being married too

Esther 2:14 In the evening she went, and on the morrow she returned into the second house of the women, to the custody of Shaashgaz, the king's chamberlain, which kept the concubines: she came in unto the king no more, except the king delighted in her, and that she were called by name.

Only way you can come to the king if he called you by name

She went in to the King and you couldn't go back unless the King called for you. He had to miss you in his spirit to call you

Esther 2:15 Now when the turn of Esther, the daughter of Abihail the uncle of Mordecai, who had taken her for his daughter, was come to go in unto the king, she required nothing but what Hegai the king's chamberlain, the keeper of the women, appointed. And Esther obtained favour in the sight of all them that looked upon her.

Whatever he gave her for her bath she took that and nothing more. Everywhere she went she had favored and every one loved her. When she leaves they missed her.

How do people feel about you when you around? Your reputation matters in Israel.

The king likes Esther she didn't get extra she won him over by how she carry herself. She had favor in the King eyes. Win him over in conversation

Comfort in the tongue

Esther 2:16 So Esther was taken unto king Ahasuerus into his house royal in the tenth month, which is the month Tebeth, in the seventh year of his reign.

Esther 2:17 And the king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.

So when the King met Esther he fell in love with her by how she carried herself. Being herself not fakeness



He put that crown on her head

Question: How do we carry ourselves? Do we obtain favor when we go places?

Question: If you die today what will people say about you?

Proverbs 31:10 Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price is far above rubies.



That's what the King was looking for

She's different her price is far above rubies

We as Israelite women is far above rubies

Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

Esther was content. She didn't want the extras she was content

We must be content as women

Proverbs 31:25 Strength and honour are her clothing; and she shall rejoice in time to come.

The joy of the Lord is your strength. She was confident of who she was and she serve the Most High God.

Proverbs 31:26 She openeth her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the law of kindness.

She had wisdom and kindness. That's what the King liked

Proverbs 31:29 Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all.

Proverbs 31:31 Give her of the fruit of her hands; and let her own works praise her in the gates.

He loved her above everybody

When you really transformed into a virtuous women you will do your own works



Esther 2:18 Then the king made a great feast unto all his princes and his servants, even Esther's feast; and he made a release to the provinces, and gave gifts, according to the state of the king.

Esther 2:19 And when the virgins were gathered together the second time, then Mordecai sat in the king's gate.

Esther 2:20 Esther had not yet shewed her kindred nor her people; as Mordecai had charged her: for Esther did the commandment of Mordecai, like as when she was brought up with him.

The commandment she was following just as her uncle taught her she followed his instructions even as an adult. She was not like I am grown don't tell me what to do. That's honor.

Esther 2:21 In those days, while Mordecai sat in the king's gate, two of the king's chamberlains, Bigthan and Teresh, of those which kept the door, were wroth, and sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.

Two men Bigthan and Teresa they was mad at the King and wanted to kill him.

Mordecai here then and was spying

Esther 2:22 And the thing was known to Mordecai, who told it unto Esther the queen; and Esther certified the king thereof in Mordecai's name.

Mordecai was like look Esther these two men hate the king let him knows she received the news and told the king

Esther 2:23 And when inquisition was made of the matter, it was found out; therefore they were both hanged on a tree: and it was written in the book of the chronicles before the king.

The King has a book they will keep Important matters in. The hung the men

Esther 3:1 After these things did king Ahasuerus promote Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, and advanced him, and set his seat above all the princes that were with him.

King has a friend name Haman king like him above all men in castle. Ahasuerus was first and Haman was second in command



Esther 3:2 And all the king's servants, that were in the king's gate, bowed, and reverenced Haman: for the king had so commanded concerning him. But Mordecai bowed not, nor did him reverence.

He wanted everyone to bow down to him. Mordecai didn't bow down to him

Exodus 20:4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth:

Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

We don't bow down or worship no man.

Mordecai didn't bow down because he keep Gods laws he was not being rude.

Esther 3:3 Then the king's servants, which were in the king's gate, said unto Mordecai, Why transgressest thou the king's commandment?



All Kings servant like why you going against the Kings command. This is Esther uncle Mordecai. Now he not listening because it breaks Gods laws

Esther 3:4 Now it came to pass, when they spake daily unto him, and he hearkened not unto them, that they told Haman, to see whether Mordecai's matters would stand: for he had told them that he was a Jew.

Mordecai said I am a Jew I can't bow down that breaks my God laws. They went back and told Haman

Esther 3:5 And when Haman saw that Mordecai bowed not, nor did him reverence, then was Haman full of wrath.

Haman is angry because he won't bow down to him

Esther 3:6 And he thought scorn to lay hands on Mordecai alone; for they had shewed him the people of Mordecai: wherefore Haman sought to destroy all the Jews that were throughout the whole kingdom of Ahasuerus, even the people of Mordecai.

He wanted to kill Mordecai and kill Israel because they all Jews

Haman like I am going to kill all his people and him

Esther 3:7 In the first month, that is, the month Nisan, in the twelfth year of king Ahasuerus, they cast Pur, that is, the lot, before Haman from day to day, and from month to month, to the twelfth month, that is, the month Adar.

Esther 3:8 And Haman said unto king Ahasuerus, There is a certain people scattered abroad and dispersed among the people in all the provinces of thy kingdom; and their laws are diverse from all people; neither keep they the king's laws: therefore it is not for the king's profit to suffer them.

Now they went to the King. It's a certain people in the land and they not keeping the law.



So now Haman not only mad. He telling King it's a group of people that is not worshiping you. He saying doesn't make sense to take care of them because don't care about your laws

Esther 3:9 If it please the king, let it be written that they may be destroyed: and I will pay ten thousand talents of silver to the hands of those that have the charge of the business, to bring it into the king's treasuries.

Haman said who kill the Israelites I will pay them ten thousand talents of silver

Esther 3:10 And the king took his ring from his hand, and gave it unto Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, the Jews' enemy.

He took the kings rings to sign the letter to kill who won't listen to their law. Haman want all Israel killed

Agagite is Esau the enemy to the Jews. Don't want us keeping Gods laws

Esther 3:11 And the king said unto Haman, The silver is given to thee, the people also, to do with them as it seemeth good to thee.

King said I am going to give you the money and do what you want to have them killed. King like Haman

Esther 3:12 Then were the king's scribes called on the thirteenth day of the first month, and there was written according to all that Haman had commanded unto the king's lieutenants, and to the governors that were over every province, and to the rulers of every people of every province according to the writing thereof, and to every people after their language; in the name of king Ahasuerus was it written, and sealed with the king's ring.

They wrote a letter and signed with the kings ring and sealed it. Anywhere you see a Jew murder them for not bowing down to our law since they want to keep they own law

Esther 3:13 And the letters were sent by posts into all the king's provinces, to destroy, to kill, and to cause to perish, all Jews, both young and old, little children and women, in one day, even upon the thirteenth day of the twelfth month, which is the month Adar, and to take the spoil of them for a prey.

He sent a letter to kill old, young and children. No mercy on no Israelites. They all have the same mindset. When they die anything you can get that's left over take it for yourselves

Esther 3:14 The copy of the writing for a commandment to be given in every province was published unto all people, that they should be ready against that day.



They picked a day and be ready to murder all the Jews for Mordecai not bowing down

Esther 3:15 The posts went out, being hastened by the king's commandment, and the decree was given in Shushan the palace. And the king and Haman sat down to drink; but the city Shushan was perplexed.

Haman and King was drinking and the city of the Jews like what just happened. Now Israel is scared

Esther 4:1 When Mordecai perceived all that was done, Mordecai rent his clothes, and put on sackcloth with ashes, and went out into the midst of the city, and cried with a loud and a bitter cry;

When Mordecai found out what happen he ripped his clothes off and cried out because they was about to all get murdered

Esther 4:2 And came even before the king's gate: for none might enter into the king's gate clothed with sackcloth.

Mordecai now at gate by Kings house. They would not allow him to come in because he had sackcloth on.

Esther 4:3 And in every province, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, there was great mourning among the Jews, and fasting, and weeping, and wailing; and many lay in sackcloth and ashes.

When everybody heard a decree sent everywhere. They started crying why everyone want to kill us

What we going to do on 13th day when they come. Started praying and was scared

Esther 4:4 So Esther's maids and her chamberlains came and told it her. Then was the queen exceedingly grieved; and she sent raiment to clothe



Mordecai, and to take away his sackcloth from him: but he received it not.

Esther maids

Her maids came in Esther we have to tell you something. Haman just put a order out to kill all your people on the 13th day. Her husband the King doesn't know these are her people. She's upset. So she gave him clothes to change and it's okay and he refuse to take clothes. He's crying and stress and praying to his God

Esther 4:5 Then called Esther for Hatach, one of the king's chamberlains, whom he had appointed to attend upon her, and gave him a commandment to Mordecai, to know what it was, and why it was.

She hearing her uncle at gate crying and got on sackcloth. She don't know why yet. The King fave her servants she sent servant to ask her uncle what's going on and why he won't take clothes

Esther didn't know why her uncle was crying. Found out what he's crying about

Esther 4:6 So Hatach went forth to Mordecai unto the street of the city, which was before the king's gate.

Esther 4:7 And Mordecai told him of all that had happened unto him, and of the sum of the money that Haman had promised to pay to the king's treasuries for the Jews, to destroy them.

Mordecai finally told Hatach what happen that Haman plan to kill Israel on certain day

Mordecai like tell my niece Esther because I would not bow down to her husband he put out a order to kill all Israelites on 13th day and he will pay anybody

Define eloquent- fluent or persuasive in speaking or writing.

Some people use eloquent speech to start drama that is not right

Esther asked to put a spirit on him that he can change Lord

Esther 14:14 But deliver us with thine hand, and help me that am desolate, and which have no other help but thee.

She said Lord I only have you in the palace. My faith is in you please help me

Esther 14:15 Thou knowest all things, O Lord; thou knowest that I hate the glory of the unrighteous, and abhor the bed of the uncircumcised, and of all the heathen.

She said I hate being queen, all that jewelry, and palace she hate it. They are not my people.

She said she hate the riches, you know I hate being in bedroom with him. She was not in there getting it in with the riches. She in there for her people. She hate even his bed. She called him uncircumcised. He didn't even get his forskin removed. I hate it



She hate all the other nations

Esther 14:16 Thou knowest my necessity: for I abhor the sign of my high estate, which is upon mine head in the days wherein I shew myself, and that I abhor it as a menstruous rag, and that I wear it not when I am private by myself.

She hates the stank crown on my head. You k ow Lord I don't like this. I can't stand them. She hated it like a monthly cycle Like a menstrual rag. I just want to serve you Lord. She's royal to God.
