

**KEY TAKEAWAY** 

Teach our children the scriptures.

**Example:** Story Time - Mehida went to BJ's with her daughter and witnessed a white woman disrespecting a black woman in the checkout line. Her daughter was able to see for herself how the heathens mistreat our people.

# CHAPTER 12 KEY TAKEAWAY

Israel has always been curious about what the other nations have been doing. TMH has always given us the instruction NOT to follow after the other nations.

Deuteronomy 12:8 (KJV) Ye shall not do after all the things that we do here this day, every man whatsoever is right in his own eyes.

This also coincides with Proverbs 3:5



# <u>Proverbs 3:5 (KJV)</u>Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

- > A woman's mind is like a maze. It is extremely easy to get lost.
- Example of leaning into your own understanding: Thinking a sister purposely did not shalom you, all the while she may have had her hands full and could not hug you. The maze convinces you that the sister does not like you. Again, this is an example of leaning unto your own understanding.

This is also an example of "Evil Surmising"

<u>1 Timothy 6:4 (KJV)</u> He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, *evil surmisings* 

Define: Surmise - suppose that something is true without having evidence to confirm it. "he surmised that something must be wrong"

This is why it is important to constantly stay busy in good things as Proverbs 31 commands us. People who suffer from depression should know that their minds will lie and trick us. TMH said we are not to be given to idleness (Proverbs 31:27)

<u>Deuteronomy 12:30 (KJV)</u> - Take heed to thyself that thou be not snared by following them, after that they be destroyed from before thee; and that thou inquire not after their gods, saying, How did these nations serve their gods? even so will I do likewise.

Israel tends to follow after everyone else!

<u>Deuteronomy 12:31 (KJV)</u> - Thou shalt not do so unto the LORD thy God: for every abomination to the LORD, which he hateth, have they done unto their gods; for even their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods.

Some examples of what the Egyptians and other nations were doing:

- sleeping with near kin (incest)
- idolatry
- cross dressing (women wearing pants, men wearing dresses)
- abortions



- interracial marriages

- bestiality

- > These abominations occur today here in spiritual Egypt.
- > We have to be an example to our people!

CHAPTER 13 KEY TAKEAWAYS

"The Dreamer"

#### Deuteronomy 13:1-3(KJV)

<u>Vs 1</u> If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and giveth thee a sign or a wonder

<u>Vs 2</u> And the sign or the wonder come to pass, whereof he spake unto thee, saying, Let us go after other gods, which thou hast not known, and let us serve them;

<u>Vs 3</u> Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for the Lord your God proveth you, to know whether ye love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

We cannot rely on our dreams to guide us. There is no sin in questioning a dream when it occurs, BUT if a person comes to you and says, "God was speaking to me", that is evil and dangerous.

### Deuteronomy 13:6-9 KJV)

<u>Vs 6</u> If thy brother, the son of thy mother, or thy son, or thy daughter, or the wife of thy bosom, or thy friend, which is as thine own soul, entice thee secretly, saying, Let us go and serve other gods, which thou hast not known, thou, nor thy fathers;

<u>Vs 7</u> Namely, of the gods of the people which are round about you, nigh unto thee, or far off from thee, from the one end of the earth even unto the other end of the earth;

<u>Vs 8</u> Thou shalt not consent unto him, nor hearken unto him; neither shall thine eye pity him, neither shalt thou spare, neither shalt thou conceal him:

<u>Vs 9</u> But thou shalt surely kill him; thine hand shall be first upon him to put him to death, and afterwards the hand of all the people.



We are NOT to sin, even if it comes to your own family.

**For example:** Your parents want your help cleaning out the shed, but they need you on the sabbath. You cannot honor that. You can help them as LONG as you do not break the laws.

The most high will send them to PROVE you! TMH wants to know if you love that person more than him!

#### CHAPTER 14 KEY TAKEAWAYS

- In regard to the Levites the most high keeps saying do not forget your brother they do not have an inheritance...
- The majority of the chapter is going over the dietary laws. We have to go over this over and over again - because we are the CHILDREN of Israel. The instructions have to be repeated because we have the tendency to follow after the other nations.

<u>Deuteronomy 14:12 (KJV)</u> But these are they of which ye shall not eat: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the ospray...

- These birds are birds of prey. We do not eat them because they are the scavengers of the air and eat all of the unclean dead animals, like rats, lions, etc.
- > Deuteronomy verse. 22 29 will help you understand tithes.
- Tithing is NOT giving 10% of your check to preachers. You can give ALMS, but not tithes.

#### Deuteronomy 15:12-18 (KJV)

<u>Vs 12</u> And if thy brother, an Hebrew man, or an Hebrew woman, be sold unto thee, and serve thee six years; then in the seventh year thou shalt let him go free from thee.

<u>Vs 13</u> And when thou sendest him out free from thee, thou shalt not let him go away empty:

<u>Vs 14</u> Thou shalt furnish him liberally out of thy flock, and out of thy floor, and out of thy winepress: of that wherewith the Lord thy God hath blessed thee thou shalt give unto him.

<u>Vs 15</u> And thou shalt remember that thou wast a bondman in the land of Egypt, and the Lord thy God redeemed thee: therefore I command thee this thing to day. <u>Vs 16</u> And it shall be, if he say unto thee, I will not go away from thee; because he loveth thee and thine house, because he is well with thee;

<u>Vs 17</u> Then thou shalt take an aul, and thrust it through his ear unto the door, and he shall be thy servant for ever. And also unto thy maidservant thou shalt do likewise.

<u>Vs 18</u> It shall not seem hard unto thee, when thou sendest him away free from thee; for he hath been worth a double hired servant to thee, in serving thee six years: and the Lord thy God shall bless thee in all that thou doest.

- > We were bondservants, NOT slaves to each other. We did this to pay off debts.
- We were not abused; we were not hurting each other. If we did, we were judged for it.
- Unlike the nations man, we were not removing each other's nationalities, enforcing slavery for life.
- Under the white man, we had to go back to the plantation after being freed because we had nothing.
- > No one can equate indentured servitude with transatlantic slavery.
