

## Supporting My Lord during the 40 Day of Camp

When leadership announced that IUIC Austin would begin a 40 Day Camp Mission, the entire congregation was excited. I, too, was motivated and thought about what I could do to show my lord support during the 40 days. The mission presented a great opportunity to apply Titus 2:3-5 with our daughters. I began discussing my vision with them to dedicate a wall in our room where we would post encouraging scriptures for each day the prophets went to camp.

### Titus 2:3-5 KJV

V3 The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things.

V4 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

V5 To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

We started by assembling a garment rack for my lord's uniforms and boots and collectively chose scriptures that represented a go to war or a revolutionary spirit. Each day the men went to camp, we would add a new scripture to the wall. Seeing my lord smile while reading the scriptures each day before camp, was well worth our efforts. In addition to this, a Telegram group was created where the leadership wives would share and post actions they would do to motivate and inspire their husbands each day.

### These activities included:

- Leaving a nice note on the mirror or a hand-written letter
- Making sure we dress, look, and smell nice.
- Making their favorite dish.
- Creating and giving our husbands a nice motivational package filled with scriptures, pictures, small drinks, and snacks.
- Even, setting up a 40-day chart and marking off each day the camp was completed to show them reaching their goal.
