

TEACHING 101: PASSOVER

UNDER 8'S

Teach!

Explain that Passover came into play after the Egyptians received plagues and death for the hard bondage that they put us through.

Leviticus 23:4 - 8

Explain that Passover is in the first month of our year, which is in between March - April/Spring.

Abib: Ear of corn

Teach!

Explain that the Passover is for 7 days and it is the same as the Feast of Unleavened Bread.

The first day of Passover, we are to eat bitter herbs, lamb and unleavened bread.

For the rest of the six days we are to eat unleavened bread for six days.

Teach!

Explain that another important part of observing Passover, is making sure there is no leaven nor should we be eating any leaven.
