DIY Glow In The Dark Full Moon

While looking for new craft ideas to represent the moon in her perfection, I came across this one. The kids loved it! Feel free to try it for yourself!

We used paper plates, glow in the dark Elmer's glue, and shaving cream.

1. Mix in ingredients in a 3:1 ratio (3 parts shaving cream and 1 part glow in the dark glue)
2. Place a dollop on the plate and let the kids have fun! We used spoons to spread.
3. Let dry.

Here is Levi 8, Simeon 5, and Aya 1 with their creations. Having bible-based fun is essentially a way to lock in the information. The children will surely know that the New Moon is the Full Moon!
