

Everyone could use a P.A.S.



We as Daughter's of Sarah call our helpers P.A.S., but it can be called many things: charity, kindness, unity, alms, or support. PAS is simply a concept. P.A.S. stands for *personal* assistance sister, and we do exactly that, assist.

The concept was founded upon the idea that if we all assisted each other just a little, we all would fare much better. The assistance received can vary based on the needs of the sister/ home as well as the skills and willingness of the sisters involved. Most of the time, assistance is centered around house care, childcare, errands, and miscellaneous tasks.

The system can be set up as a committee or executed amongst proven friends.

HOW DO YOU SET UP THE PAS SYSTEM?

Select the group of individuals that will be working together. It typically works best with a group large enough to spread the workload to avoid burnout but small enough where it's easy to manage.

With services requiring visits to one another's home, it is prudent to select sisters within a limited distance.

Once the group is set, establish a schedule. In most cases the schedule is on a weekly basis with 1-2 sisters receiving assistance each week.

The receiving sisters will post their list of desired assistance and availability in advance of their assigned week. The other sisters on the assistance committee will respond with what tasks they are capable of assisting with & which day & time they'll be assisting.

Again, to avoid burnout of consistently assisting sisters, it is required for each member to assist another sister at least once within a 4-week period to also receive assistance themselves.

You do not have to assist someone weekly, but as reasonably often as possible.

OUTCOME

After a visit from one or more sisters, recipients are able to accomplish tasks that require multiple individuals, that they are less skilled at, or simply prefer not to do.

This system has been practiced amongst proven Atlanta sisters & so far, we have packed & moved families to new residences, laundry, sewing/fringing, store runs, childcare, Passover prep, general deep cleaning, & much more.








Pantry Organization
