- DO NOT eat anything with leaven in it. (Exo. 12:20)
- KEEP the first and last day of this 7 day feast as Sabbaths(Exo. 12:16)
- EAT lamb (Exo.12:21)
- REMOVE all leaven (sin) from our spirit. (1 Cor. 5:7-8)

Blueberry Unleavened Bread

- 3 sticks softened butter
 - 3 eggs
 - 1 c white sugar
 - 3/4 brown sugar
 - 1 tsp vanilla paste
 - 1 tbsp vanilla
 - 1 container blueberry cream cheese
 - 1/2 tsp pink salt
 - 1 c evaporated milk
 - 2 and a fourth c AP flour
 - 2 c fresh blueberries (tossed in flour)
- all ingredients room temperature**



Cream butter and sugar. Add cream cheese. Mix in one egg at a time. Add extracts. Alternate liquid and flour into mixture (half cup liquid, mix, then one cup flour, mix...repeat). DONT OVERMIX. Toss blueberries in flour until well coated. Fold them into the batter. Bake in greased pan at 350 until knife comes out clean.
