Topic: Curated For A King Or For The Streets

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There are things that are being named among the Daughters of Sarah that should not be named among the Daughters of Sarah. We have to reel it back and make sure we are setting an example.

Does anyone know what curated means? Or have Spotify or Apple music, where you make a playlist for yourself?

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Curated: Carefully chosen, thoughtfully organized, or presented.

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1 Timothy 2:13 For Adam was first formed, then Eve.

- Remember, it's curated for a king or curated for the streets, we are looking at who was formed first and second.

Genesis 2:21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;

22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.

23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

- It's good to be reminded because we all know that Israel is a forgetful people. God said to remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy so we have to remember our role. Plus, as women we have to remember where we come from and where we start. Adam was created first, then God put Adam to sleep, took his rib and created Eve. He did not take a lump of dirt and decide to make a woman.

Genesis 2:18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.

- After realizing Adam should not be alone he then made Eve who Adam called woman because she was taken from him. God said he would make Adam a help meet, so now we have a sense of a role. This is what Eve's job was: she was made to help Adam.

Tobit 8:6 Thou madest Adam, and gavest him Eve his wife for an helper and stay: of them came mankind: thou hast said, It is not good that man should be alone; let us make unto him an aid like unto himself.

- These are a handful of scriptures that tell us who was made first, who was made second, and what the woman's role is; A helper and a stay. A help meet.
- This chat will focus on the mindset while discussing heathen women's mindset in America because we have adopted many of their ways. That includes their mentality in how we think and move which affects us.
- Everything begins in the mind that is then manifested into your actions and speech. A lot of times when we are talking and speaking to our husbands and have a nigga moment, a lot of the stuff coming out of your mouth are things you've seen on TV, heard from woman at work, or still amidst evil communication that have corrupted your good manners. These are things we have to make sure we are aware of so that we are not behaving clueless and apologizing. I will not say apologizing gets old, but if you keep apologizing for the same thing no one wants to keep hearing it when you are not making any efforts to change your ways.
- *For as a man thinketh so is he*, whatever you're thinking will come out. How do we know that we are not to have the state of mind curated for the streets? Or how does one find out I'm not supposed to be curated for the streets or carefully chosen for the streets. I'm a princess. I want to be curated for a king.

Job 8:8 For enquire, I pray thee, of the former age, and prepare thyself to the search of their fathers:

- In Job it tells us to inquire, basically telling us to search and seek out the book of the Lord and look at our forefathers and foremothers. What were their qualities, characteristics and what was said about them?

Romans 15:4 For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope.

- Is telling us the same thing, that we have to take responsibility for ourselves and seek it out. No one should always have to tell you, you should be proactive.

### **SIDENOTE**

*I remember my first Titus 2, I just thought about this, but we were at Passover in Orlando, and I remember Sister Shamarah telling us don't wait for someone to tell you to do something. We have to be proactive, yes, your husband will correct you on things and tell you what he likes and doesn't like. But be proactive in knowing what he likes, he shouldn't have to tell you all the time. There are just some things you should know that make him excited. **BE PROACTIVE IN SEEKING OUT WHAT YOUR ROLE EMBODIES**, what it encompasses, and put your hand towards the plow and work on it.*

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- We have to understand that it is not just words in a book. If you read Twilight, that's words in a book, if you read Harry Potter, that's words in a book. This book is spiritual; it will change your life. This book will help you elevate to be that Proverbs 31 woman. Those words have no effect on your spirit, they can't convert your soul like the Bible can. When it comes to studying and looking to see how you need to be a woman, a Daughter of Sarah; you need to look at your foremothers and your unrighteous foremothers. You can study your righteous foremothers all you want but at the same time you don't know what the unrighteous did too and if you're not doing those things.
- The scriptures will give us hope, once we see how our foremothers and how they handled situations. We take on these qualities and characteristics as the holy women of old.
- When we are inquiring and we're looking at what was written aforetime we're looking to see what were the qualities, characteristics, and what was said about our foremothers. You may look at Susanna and you don't want a bad report said about you and you want to be blameless in your walk.

Judith 8:29 For this is not the first day wherein thy wisdom is manifested; but from the beginning of thy days all the people have known thy understanding, because the disposition of thine heart is good.

- She was known for having wise words coming out of her mouth in whatever situation she may have been in. She used discretion without disrespect.
- Who all wants a good name? Have you ever thought about, if you die, what are people going to say about you? You don't want people to show up and be like well, we're here but we have to hurry up and get back. You want to have a good name and that will come by your works.
- If you're married you wonder what your husband will say about you because his opinion matters the most because he knows you through and through and what he says will stick.

Proverbs 22:1 A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold.

- So this is something that is priceless. A virtuous woman is worth more than rubies. A good name is equal to a virtuous woman. In order for us to ensure we are curated for a king and not for the streets. If you are curated for the streets you are for the streets, and Daughters of Sarah cannot be for the streets. We are curated for kings, that's how we need to move, and how we are rolling' making sure we are supporting our men and the vision put forth by God.

Judges 5:11 They that are delivered from the noise of archers in the places of drawing water, there shall they rehearse the righteous acts of the LORD, even the righteous acts toward the inhabitants of his villages in Israel: then shall the people of the LORD go down to the gates.

It says we have to rehearse the righteous acts. Can you name some righteous acts in regards to righteous women?

**1. Submission**

**2. Keepers at home**

**3. Blameless**

**4. Meekness**

**5. Integrity**

**6. Respectful**

- Respect. That word can be transformed into reverence. This is something that we definitely have to rehearse. Because reverencing our husbands and the man in general. Reverence is a deep respect for someone, if you do not have respect for someone how can you have anything else for them, how can you be loyal to someone if you don't respect them? How can you trust someone if you don't respect them? You probably trust them enough to pay the bills but how can your desire be unto him if you don't respect him? Disrespect will not be tolerated. It's like a slap in the face to God. He is giving you as a gift to this king on earth he made perfect with his hands, who is going out teaching the word, providing for his family and doing everything a righteous man should be doing and you can't respect him? That is not good. This is something that should not be named among us.
- You know how you can be out with your husband and heathen have to talk to you because they are taking your order or something? They will look at the women for the conversation and I have to look at my husband and ask him what he wants, because they will know the order too. Do not ignore my man. He takes care of me and these children and he's doing the Lord's work.

- You know how you might be at a doctor's office with your husband and the doctor is intently asking you all the questions? I would look to my husband and he would let them know what we've already decided and I would agree to make sure that they know.
- It's a setup! They put us in a trick back because that is a mild case of being curated for the streets. You think you can make your own decisions and your mind is not after your husband's mind.

Sirach 25:1 In three things I was beautified, and stood up beautiful both before God and men: the unity of brethren, the love of neighbours, a man and a wife that agree together.

- What they don't want is us agreeing with our man. They want a division. They want us divided with our men.
- How can we effectively be molded into this woman that is not only pleasing to God's eyes but to our husbands eyes and making sure we are walking on a righteous path. It's a setup!

### What Comes with Rehearsal?

#### 1. Identifying your role

Sirach 36:24 He that getteth a wife beginneth a possession, a help like unto himself, and a pillar of rest.

- You know that your role is to be a help to your husband and be a pillar. He wants to be able to unwind around you. These are attributes curated for a king because a king will not accept foolishness. You have to make sure that you prep yourself and your mind when you come into his presence and how you talk to him. Look presentable. These are things you have to come back into.
- Women curated for the streets, you know how they look when we are in Walmart with the long eyelashes, bonnets, tank tops exposing cleavage? You have to come correct and be on point. I am referencing the outer portion but your mind has to be on point as well. When you speak you have to make sure you are not a light woman. Before we came into the truth we all had a little street in us and then we came into the truth and we got cleaned up and put together and realized we are not supposed to be doing certain things.
- I was a leggings wearing girl and I remember many arguments on why I was heading out the house looking like that and I wasn't thinking about it but All praises to God you come into the truth and you change that, but you have to be willing.

#### 2. Learn your steps and your responsibilities

We have to remember what our role is. A lot of time we like to blur the lines and sis you are not a man. We are women, we are dainty, we are delicate, we are princesses and daughters of a king. You might have to say that everyday so that it can get into your spirit.

Ephesians 5:22 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.

23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

24 Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing.

- These are the other basic steps that are important. You cannot embody any of the proverbs 31 verses from 10 and down if you are not submissive. Because she's doing this for her husband.
- You have to really envision your husband in his kingdom body. You have to ask yourself, do I really believe? Because these words in this bible are enough to make you believe. Like how Bishop Yawasap will say put yourself in the scriptures and once you actually put yourself there and you have that mindset where you can vividly envision it. It's on another level. I suggest trying it if you can.
- The husband is the head of the wife, now a woman that's curated for the streets will look at that and say ain't nobody head over me I'm the head of myself, it's 50/50 it's equal. You are curated for the streets. This is the basis that God is telling us we have to submit ourselves because he already stated the flock of his pasture are men. They are doing His will, because the men can't tell Christ no. Unless he is telling you to sin, although that's not always the case.
- If you battle with that spirit of being submissive with your husband, what are some things you should do?
  - **Fast and pray**
  - **Seek counsel**
  - **And pray 3 times a day**
- You have to work towards being submissive; it's not going to just happen overnight.

Proverbs 31:10 Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price is far above rubies.

11 The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil.

15 She riseth also while it is yet night, and giveth meat to her household, and a portion to her maidens.

23 Her husband is known in the gates, when he sitteth among the elders of the land.

- This is something that we all should be striving to be. This woman is a template. Her husband doesn't worry if she's doing curated for the street activities or an unholy hoe, or just out in the streets not taking care of the children. Those are red flags. She will love

him and do good things; he will speak highly of her and she will have a good name. She doesn't sleep in until noon, or 9:30 she is up while it's still dark. Now your sister will get up at 7, 7:30. I am still working on getting up at 5:30. But, she's rising early to make sure she uses her time wisely, not letting time pass by and trying to get things done quickly and having idle time.

### 3. Apply It

Rehearsals are important because If you miss your steps or you're off count the sequence is off.

Have you ever seen people dancing and they off and they tried to catch up but they try to finish the move and then catch up? With that being said, think about it as when you look at it spiritually you have disturbed the divine order. When we choose not to rehearse the righteous acts of our foremothers, not being submissive, not having discretion and keeping the order that our husband are the head and reverencing him.

1 Corinthians 11:3 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.

8 For the man is not of the woman; but the woman of the man.

9 Neither was the man created for the woman; but the woman for the man.

- This is the divine order God has setup for us. You will hear these scriptures because we need to hear these scriptures. If we truly knew and understood the order everything would be in order there would be things you could not say about us.

Proverbs 3:31 Envy thou not the oppressor, and choose none of his ways.

- We should not envy our oppressors; they have half of our women aborting babies and twerking outside planned parenthood. It's almost as if we're watching a move and then we have to remember that we are living in the last days.

Esther 1:1 Now it came to pass in the days of Ahasuerus, (this is Ahasuerus which reigned, from India even unto Ethiopia, over an hundred and seven and twenty provinces:)

2 That in those days, when the king Ahasuerus sat on the throne of his kingdom, which was in Shushan the palace,

3 In the third year of his reign, he made a feast unto all his princes and his servants; the power of Persia and Media, the nobles and princes of the provinces, being before him:

- I wanted us to read this so we know this is the King who has dominion right now.

Esther 1:9 Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women in the royal house which belonged to king Ahasuerus.



10 On the seventh day, when the heart of the king was merry with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king,

11 To bring Vashti the queen before the king with the crown royal, to shew the people and the princes her beauty: for she was fair to look on.

12 But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by his chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

13 Then the king said to the wise men, which knew the times, (for so was the king's manner toward all that knew law and judgment:

- She refused his commandment to be shown off and he counseled with his wise men on what to do about this.

Esther 1:15 What shall we do unto the queen Vashti according to law, because she hath not performed the commandment of the king Ahasuerus by the chamberlains?

16 And Memucan answered before the king and the princes, Vashti the queen hath not done wrong to the king only, but also to all the princes, and to all the people that are in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

17 For this deed of the queen shall come abroad unto all women, so that they shall despise their husbands in their eyes, when it shall be reported, The king Ahasuerus commanded Vashti the queen to be brought in before him, but she came not.

18 Likewise shall the ladies of Persia and Media say this day unto all the king's princes, which have heard of the deed of the queen. Thus shall there arise too much contempt and wrath.

- Remember we were there under their rule. I don't want you all to get mistaken, yes I'm reading about a heathen now, but we took on a lot of their characteristics, attributes, and qualities.
- Who are all gathered talking about this? The men. Which shows us that this was a universal law that men were running things unlike today. I wanted to point out that there was always a man in charge, we can not be left alone because we will mess stuff up eventually. Our foremother took her place.
- In this story we are about to hear. I want you all to know there was no malice or deceit. It was all innocent but it is very crucial about being replaced.

### **Sister Neora**

When I came into the truth, my very first day coming, I didn't get off work until 4:30 I was going to come straight to the school. When I pull up at the school, obviously everybody is inside because class has already started. However, I see a sister getting her baby out of the car and I

ask her are you going in? And she says oh yeah I will walk you in, don't worry let me just get the baby out of the car. Fast forward a couple years later her then husband is now my husband. Back then she would say that her husband would always complain that she's always late to sabbath and I think after a few months of me being there I don't think we ever saw her again. Eventually leadership asked me about the brother and vice versa and we never really thought of each other that way until God put it in them to say something. So, my husband's ex-wife used to congregate. I was right there with her and she walked me into the doors of the church. She walked me basically to my husband.

A lot of us like to think we aren't replaceable especially if the men are doing what they're supposed to do. God will be like why is it that my prophet has to suffer all this and will give him a gift.

Some of us come in with our husbands and we are so opposed to the scriptures and what God has and we don't want to keep the laws and we never know how much time we have.

**Ephesians 5:22 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.**

- That is a foundation for us, to be submissive.
- So Vashti was replaced by Esther. Our foremother knew and revered not only her uncle but was able to save the entire nation of Israel. Going back to Vashti, that mindset and the deeds like abortions, and we will see Esau's women being submissive to their husbands but they don't plant that into our minds. That's why they have food stamps, housing, and WIC, where the man can't be living there. This is a way that they subconsciously do that and put our women on tv to belittle and talk down not only to each other but towards the men as well. Not only is it in the music but they're okay with pushing it. I used to listen to country music and I have never heard them say stuff about their women or men.
- These are the mindsets and ideologies that we as repented sisters have taken on. The same evil deeds that Vashti was doing, being rebellious, not submissive which led to her estate being given to another. That's a babylonian, nigga, not curated to a king mindset. If you have these thoughts you need to quickly mortify your mind with the scriptures. If we continue in this mindset death is what we are seeking. The scriptures say choose life not death. The scriptures tell us every way not to die.

**Deuteronomy 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:**

- We have a choice and we need to choose life. Sometimes people may say it's not that easy, it is that easy when you really want to do it. You have to be willing; no man wants a sandwich you just halfway put together.

Exodus 35:5 Take ye from among you an offering unto the LORD: whosoever is of a willing heart, let him bring it, an offering of the LORD; gold, and silver, and brass,

29 The children of Israel brought a willing offering unto the LORD, every man and woman, whose heart made them willing to bring for all manner of work, which the LORD had commanded to be made by the hand of Moses.

- God only wants those with a willing heart. Have you ever like wanted someone to do something and they are not in the spirit to do it and you quickly dismiss them and do it yourself?
- It may be some sisters out there sitting on their high horse that say they make sure they are submissive to their husbands and all praises that's good, but when they had the sabbath class where they talked about fecal being in the women's showers, you didn't feel any type of way?
- The scriptures say you are Daughters of Sarah as long as you do well, and that is doing dirty. I wanted to say that to say this, when one of us does it we reflect us all and we are to be blameless.

2 Corinthians 6:3 Giving no offence in any thing, that the ministry be not blamed:

- There is no way the ministry should be blamed. Anytime something happens that's named among Daughters of Sarah we should feel like it is not good and strive to do better and send up prayers to be better, do better, and look out for one another.
- That act that those sisters did in the showers was curated for the streets. A woman that's curated for a king make sure she smells good and is thoroughly cleaned. When you think about Susanna she was bathing and had bath bombs she was not pooping in the garden.
- Things like this should not be spoken about us.
- There are many things that are in the streets, we always talk about the around the way girl, but some of us like to punch our husbands in the face because you didn't get your way. That is not what we're supposed to do, you are not curated for a king. Now if our men had the power to do what they wanted you wouldn't even be able to get close to them, you would be dead.

1 Esdras 4:29 Yet did I see him and Apame the king's concubine, the daughter of the admirable Bartacus, sitting at the right hand of the king,

30 And taking the crown from the king's head, and setting it upon her own head; she also struck the king with her left hand.

- She was doing whatever she wanted demeaning him in front of his court. She was a concubine that took his crown off and struck him in his face. Some women put their hands on their husband in ways that may not be full blown fighting but where he has to take all this belittling, disrespect and non-reverence and still go out into the streets and teach.

- If you get so upset and your mindset is curated for a king what do you do?
- Scriptures come to mind helping me deescalate the situation.

Proverbs 14:16 A wise man feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident.

- A wise man or wise woman says they fear God and knows that is not how they should respond to the situation and departs from evil. But this comes from Romans 15:4 and Job 8:8 you are researching and studying and looking aforeside to see how your foremothers' handled things and what attributes and qualities you need to put on and what you are struggling with. Bishop Nathaniel just went over a class about how many demons we battle. We battle 13 and you can't just ignore that, and to ignore it you are not here and oblivious to what's going on.
- Half of the time when our husbands ask us would you do that to Christ? We all collectively say no, but in actuality we would. That should make us all examine ourselves because we think we are gonna fool Christ? Like do you really think you will be able to get over on Christ? We need to pray and ask for forgiveness in thinking that way.
- A fool will stay in it, that is a light woman who is for the streets. Have you ever seen our women in the streets going crazy? If there is an argument they are loud, unbearable and some of us are like that, keeping the sabbath, attending the feast days and it's something to really examine ourselves in.
- A wise woman will speak the scriptures, stay in the spirit and deescalate the situation.

Proverbs 12:4 A virtuous woman is a crown to her husband: but she that maketh ashamed is as rottenness in his bones.

- We do not want to be the woman that has their husband decaying or slowly dying. A virtuous woman is a crown to her husband.

Proverbs 27:15 A continual dropping in a very rainy day and a contentious woman are alike.

- God compared us to rain that drops on you and gets on your nerves its not something someone wants to be around at all

*The flips side to this is...*

Sirach 26:13 The grace of a wife delighteth her husband, and her discretion will fatten his bones.

14 A silent and loving woman is a gift of the Lord; and there is nothing so much worth as a mind well instructed.

- We are here to fatten his bones to make sure he is good all the way around and prolong his life. We are not here to speed up his death.
- Our mind should be instructed by our husbands and his heart can safely trust in us.

Proverbs 11:16 A gracious woman retaineth honour: and strong men retain riches.

- A gracious woman retains honor. I looked up some synonyms for gracious
- Which are; Well mannered, kind, considerate, charitable, decent. This is all opposite of what Vashti and the women Samson dealt with and Jezebel. A gracious woman is curated for a king, she is carefully chosen, thoughtfully organized and presented. She has her head on straight and moves in wisdom that is what a righteous man loves.

Sirach 26:1 Blessed is the man that hath a virtuous wife, for the number of his days shall be double.

Judges 14:1 And Samson went down to Timnath, and saw a woman in Timnath of the daughters of the Philistines.

2 And he came up, and told his father and his mother, and said, I have seen a woman in Timnath of the daughters of the Philistines: now therefore get her for me to wife.

3 Then his father and his mother said unto him, Is there never a woman among the daughters of thy brethren, or among all my people, that thou goest to take a wife of the uncircumcised Philistines? And Samson said unto his father, Get her for me; for she pleaseth me well.

- We all know that Samson loved dealing with the other nations that were just the thorn in his side. But I want to pick from the women he dealt with for not only how wicked, but how they can also be found among sisters that congregate that shouldn't be named among us.

Judges 14:12 And Samson said unto them, I will now put forth a riddle unto you: if ye can certainly declare it me within the seven days of the feast, and find it out, then I will give you thirty sheets and thirty change of garments:

13 But if ye cannot declare it me, then shall ye give me thirty sheets and thirty change of garments. And they said unto him, Put forth thy riddle, that we may hear it.

14 And he said unto them, Out of the eater came forth meat, and out of the strong came forth sweetness. And they could not in three days expound the riddle.

- They wanted her to notice her husband and some of us do that. To entice is to bait, lure, and tempt. That is deceitful and evil to your husband. There is no reason to entice our husbands for things, that should be one of things not named among us.

Judges 14:16 And Samson's wife wept before him, and said, Thou dost but hate me, and lovest me not: thou hast put forth a riddle unto the children of my people, and hast not told it me. And he said unto her, Behold, I have not told it my father nor my mother, and shall I tell it thee?

- I feel like we are all guilty of putting on tears and whining to our husbands to soften their hearts. Being manipulative to get our husbands to tell us things. Who says he has to tell you everything?

Sirach 33:19 Give not thy son and wife, thy brother and friend, power over thee while thou livest, and give not thy goods to another: lest it repent thee, and thou intreat for the same again.

22 In all thy works keep to thyself the preeminence; leave not a stain in thine honour.

23 At the time when thou shalt end thy days, and finish thy life, distribute thine inheritance.

- In no scenario the man has to tell us everything. That is not what he has to do. He is not here to pillow talk. There are things that he has to keep to himself, he has to keep that power he cannot let you have that power and with Samson that's what they wanted to know.
- There are women who set up their husbands like they did to Samson when they learned of his weaknesses. That is a curated for the streets mentality. Our women do that out here in these streets against their baby daddies, they set up their man to be put to death.
- Your husband will not give up his preeminence, if that is something you want you need to examine yourself and go back to the order. Why would the head over you give pre-eminence to you? A lot of the time it is for your safety.

Judges 14:17 And she wept before him the seven days, while their feast lasted: and it came to pass on the seventh day, that he told her, because she lay sore upon him: and she told the riddle to the children of her people.

Judges 16:5 And the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and said unto her, Entice him, and see wherein his great strength lieth, and by what means we may prevail against him, that we may bind him to afflict him: and we will give thee every one of us eleven hundred pieces of silver.

- Keep in mind I understand these are heathen women, but God has them written in here for a reason to learn from how they are acting because in the last days many of our women have these same attributes.
- They actually said they were going to bind him up and hurt him and the thing is a lot of our women don't care. Sisters do the same thing and it may be minor but over time it can grow, don't count it out. Let's make sure we have respect, reverence and loyalty. And you might say her people will burn her up, and etc. You could say to your husband, these men came to me and this is exactly what they said. A prophet always has a plan because they have wisdom and the spirit of God on them. You can't let fear creep in and be that scapegoat. Esther was scared too and this is what I was referencing about learning aforesaid from our foremothers. And with what our men are turning this world upside down.

Judges 16:6 And Delilah said to Samson, Tell me, I pray thee, wherein thy great strength lieth, and wherewith thou mightest be bound to afflict thee.

11 And he said unto her, If they bind me fast with new ropes that never were occupied, then shall I be weak, and be as another man.

- Delilah actually went and bound Samson with ropes and continued to go with the plan by acting as if the Philistines had shown up when in actuality she let them in and hid them until it was their queue to come out. This is a woman curated for the streets. We cannot be moving like this and then try to find a way to get out of it or make excuses that you didn't mean it. Although this is her people, us being in the mindset of our oppressors and enemies this how they push unto our people, especially in the rap world. People get set up and killed and you know how many women they are around who are mainly our women. Right now our women's minds are curated for the streets, they are worried about getting money, getting over on people, and if they get pregnant they have a plan B.

Judges 16:15 And she said unto him, How canst thou say, I love thee, when thine heart is not with me? thou hast mocked me these three times, and hast not told me wherein thy great strength lieth.

16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death;

17 That he told her all his heart, and said unto her, There hath not come a razor upon mine head; for I have been a Nazarite unto God from my mother's womb: if I be shaven, then my strength will go from me, and I shall become weak, and be like any other man.

- He ended up telling her because she kept pressing on him and some of us can't let up even if your husband tells you to, you just keep going, constantly nagging. We cannot be like that, that is not a righteous quality to have and is not a woman curated for a king. Once our husbands say something we need to just take it and let it be.

Sirach 25:23 A wicked woman abateth the courage, maketh an heavy countenance and a wounded heart: a woman that will not comfort her husband in distress maketh weak hands and feeble knees.

- A wicked woman can make feeble a man's hands and knees, not being able to push the truth like he needs too.

1 Peter 3:5 For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

6 Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement.

- This is who we should be modeling ourselves after. He needs to be making sure we are studying, rehearsing the righteous acts of our foremothers and like Jezebel, who was an Israelite, married to Ahab. And you all know when we sin we take it to the next level. She sent letters in her husband's name, usurped authority over him, manipulative. 1 Timothy 2:12. I just wanted to put that in there. If you want to read about Jezebel it's 1 Kings 21:7-16. She was lying and caused a lot of death and caused an innocent man to be killed. This is why it is so important we speak wisely that we do not move with a deceitful and manipulative spirit because it can do a lot of damage and cause havoc within our own nation.

Susanna 1:27 But when the elders had declared their matter, the servants were greatly ashamed: for there was never such a report made of Susanna.

- Susanna had a good report ever since she was young, her parents made sure to teach her correctly in the law of Moses. So when the incident happened and she was accused of sleeping with them, it was strange because she never had a report about her. That's also why the outcome was the way it was because she trusted in God. This could easily scare someone and it was said that they did this to other daughters of Israel. This is how fear will creep in and you give in because your fear overtakes your faith in God.

Genesis 24:15 And it came to pass, before he had done speaking, that, behold, Rebekah came out, who was born to Bethuel, son of Milcah, the wife of Nahor, Abraham's brother, with her pitcher upon her shoulder.

- We want to have a good report, good name, and doing well in reference to Sarah and Susanna. Sarah called her husband Lord, get into it, give it a try.

Genesis 24:62 And Isaac came from the way of the well Lahairoi; for he dwelt in the south country.

67 And Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah's tent, and took Rebekah, and she became his wife; and he loved her: and Isaac was comforted after his mother's death.

- I wanted to read this because she had show submissiveness towards the servant that came giving water for him and his camels. She also had reverence for Isaac before she even met him.

**Ask yourself this, are you curated for a king or curated for the streets?**
