Proverbs 31:31 (KJV) Give her of the fruit of her hands; and let her own works praise her in the gates.

- When we do good works, our works will praise us and speak for themselves. That is what will help us to grow in this truth.

1 Timothy 3:11 (KJV) Even so must their wives be grave, not slanderers, sober, faithful in all things.

- A righteous wife must have the attribute of being grave. We should not be lying, making up stories, or being busybodies.
- No one will take us seriously if we are not in a sober state of mind.
- We have to be loyal to the Most High and to our lords so they can trust us; trust that we are doing our duties which allows them to do the work. We should want to do the work of the Most High wholeheartedly and not grudgingly.

Grave definition: having a serious and dignified quality or demeanor.

Faithful definition: remaining loyal and steadfast.

Question: How would a wife show an example of righteous works?

Responses: Ordering her lord's house. Being a true help meet. Submitting to your lord.

Supporting the leadership. Being obedient. Decorating the sanctuary. Packing his camp garment and shoes. Giving alms. Honoring and reverencing your lord. Washing dishes for the body.

Fearing the Lord. Being charitable and hospitable. Minding your manners. Giving him sex, a sandwich, submission, and silence. Being quiet and meek. Being faithful. Teaching the children. Have a welcoming face.

- No matter what we have going on in our lives, we have to show up to the sanctuary and do the work.
- Our leadership notices when you do not have a welcoming face.
 - The men can feel that and they do not deserve that because they do a lot of work; they put their lives on the line, and they teach us day in and day out.
- Aside from the leadership and everyone else, we are doing this for the Most High. We should be operating in our offices with a joyous spirit.

Colossians 3:23 (KJV) And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

- Whether we are doing work for our lord's home or reporting to a duty for an office, we need to complete the tasks as unto the Lord.
- This is what is required of us; it takes work.

- You picked your husband, proved him, married him, and opened your legs to him.
- You chose him, so you *must* follow him.

Genesis 3:16 (KJV) Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

- You must conform to the new life of what he likes.
 - If he wants a foot massage every day, guess what you will be doing?
 - If he wants his kids home-schooled at 8 am, guess what time you will be getting up?
 - It is literally, whatever he likes. You have to learn that man.
- Your desire has to be whatever he likes.
- It's important to make sure that you both get along, and have the same goals; financially, spiritually, and day-to-day.
- You need to enjoy this man's company and his ideas when you enter his world.
 - There are many marriages in the world where the husband and wife do not get along.
- You both need to become one flesh. As a helpmeet, your purpose is to help him and do what he wants to do.
 - This can be difficult if you have an independent woman mindset. You need to get rid of that, deny what *you* want, and become a new creature in Christ.
- The goal should be to please God and enter the kingdom of heaven.

Revelation 21:1,19-21 (KJV) And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. (19) And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald; (20) The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst. (21) And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.

- The Most High showed Paul the new kingdom.
 - There will be no more cement walls in the kingdom.
 - Imagine everything you touch is made of diamonds and precious stones.
 - If you submit and make it into the kingdom of God, these stones will be the foundations of your wall and your ceilings!
 - The streets will be pure gold.
 - Imagine walking out the house and seeing your reflection in the street.
- Endure.



[St. John 14:2 \(KJV\)](#) In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

- Everyone is getting mansions with their lords.
- The streets are pure gold; instead of a cement wall, you'll get jasper, topaz, etc.
- This is already prepared for us.

[2 Esdras 7:11 \(Apocrypha\)](#) Because for their sakes I made the world: and when Adam transgressed my statutes, then was decreed that now is done.

- The Most High made the world for the Israelites. Eyes have not seen what He has prepared for us!
- No matter what, make sure you are doing what is pleasing to God. Do not let a pair of dirty socks keep you out of the kingdom!
- Follow.

Psalm 144:12 (KJV) That our sons may be as plants grown up in their youth; that our daughters may be as corner stones, polished after the similitude of a palace:

- We will be snatched in the kingdom.
 - Everything will be in its perfect place on our bodies.
 - Everyone has abs, and waist snatched.
- Put the foolishness to the side.
- I would pick up 10,000 socks for the kingdom and wash his feet.
- Love up on your husband. Stick by him while he goes through his transition to a son of God.

Daniel 7:27 (KJV) And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.

- The kingdom belongs to the saints which are the Israelite men.
 - In the end, your lord is going to be worth such a great value. Help him to get there.
 - Even if he does not see the vision, you see the vision! Help him. Stick by your man.
 - If you were being nasty, mean, or moody, he will remember that when he gets to the kingdom.
- Do you believe? Your actions tell us where you stand. If you complain, are rude, and look at him like a negro Tyrone, that is not good.
- The Most High made him in the image of Christ. He is your king and going to be king of the planet.
- We are going to live forever in the kingdom. You need to envision what is waiting for us.
 - Stay kingdom minded.
 - We have to be patient together because this new kingdom is coming.
- You need to stop looking at your husband like a negro and start saying “Yes, my lord. I will do whatever you need.”
 - Let’s get it done.
 - Do not be mad when judgment day comes and Christ says. “I never knew you”.
- There will be an extreme burning fire waiting for you and all that rebellion you had.

Isaiah 60:9-12 (KJV) Surely the isles shall wait for me, and the ships of Tarshish first, to bring thy sons from far, their silver and their gold with them, unto the name of the LORD thy God, and to the Holy One of Israel, because he hath glorified thee. (10) And the sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall minister unto thee: for in my wrath I smote thee, but in my favour have I had mercy on thee. (11) Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought. (12) For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish; yea, those nations shall be utterly wasted.

- The other nations will build our kingdom for us and bring us our riches.
- The Most High is coming back for us.
 - Stop stressing about money, about where you live, and keeping up with the Jones'.
 - Get your spirit right.
 - Sometimes we want all the wrong things and we do not know how to be kind to one another.
 - It's bad if you cannot be kind to your own husband; it will take time to trust you again.

Deuteronomy 11:24 (KJV) Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even unto the uttermost sea shall your coast be.

- Everywhere we step, we will rule.
- Everything under the heavens will belong to the Israelites.
- Meditate on this when you feel stressed. We need to make sure that we are doing what is pleasing unto the Lord.

Marriage: How to please the Lord?

Hebrews 13:4 (KJV) Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge.

- Marriage is a major thing in the sight of the Most High.
 - He is not bringing ratchet sisters into the kingdom of God.
 - Extract the niggerdom out of you before Christ comes.
 - Every thought and sentence needs to matter. How you speak and conduct yourself matters.

1 Corinthians 7:28 (KJV) But and if thou marry, thou hast not sinned; and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned. Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you.

- In a marriage, you are going to have problems; you or lord are not perfect.
- The Most High called us because we are imperfect.
 - He calls those that are sick.

- It may take years for your lord to get to the level that you want him to be, but you need to be a help meet to get him there.
 - Do not point out his wrongs all the time, or belittle him, or talk to him in a condescending way.
 - Do not throw shade, be dismissive, or have an attitude.
 - You need to come from a genuine and sincere place when dealing with him.
- Use your womanly wiles to help him and to build him up.
 - Watch classes on not being lazy together.
 - Pack his bag so he can be with the Men of Valor.
 - Pray to the Most High that your husband becomes more like Christ.
 - You have to be a praying wife.
 - Be kingdom minded.
- The wife is bound to her husband as long as he is alive on this earth. This is what God ordained from the beginning.
- Speak life into your lord.
- Help him to get his spirit right.
 - Sometimes men may be depressed, suffer from anxiety, or can be stressed. They may act out.
 - You have to be able to identify that and build that man up.
 - He sent you here to assist him and to help him become a better man.
- Be kind. Be nice. Be loving. Do all these things from the heart.
- Be who the Most High ordained us to be, virtuous women.
- In her tongue is the law of kindness (Proverbs 31:24 KJV).
 - She is gentle; having the fruits of the Spirit.
 - She is peaceful and long-suffering. You are going to be right there to pick him up and rub his back and let him know that you see Christ in him.
 - Do not roll your eyes at him or think him dumb; that is *not* what a virtuous woman does.

1 Corinthians 7:39 (KJV) The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will; only in the Lord.

- Pray to the Most High to strengthen your husband.
 - You cannot pray for him to die, that is evil.
- Fast and pray to not be the dragon that you were in the world. It may take you years to become the woman your lord wants you to be.
 - Apologizing is the first step.
 - You cannot be rude, have a slick mouth, be nasty, throw shade, and be moody.
 - Work on becoming a new creature in.
 - Be patient with one another and help each other be better.

- It's a win for you if you play your cards right.
- Stop complaining about your husband.
- Do not let someone else pull you out of the spirit.

Romans 8:35 (KJV) Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

- We would not be here if it were not for the Most High.
- We are unprofitable servants. *Nothing* should remove you from submitting to the Most High.
- Focus on keeping the commandments and do what the Bible says.
- No one should have the power over you to make you leave the Most High.
 - If your Lord is cussing and screaming, you still do what is pleasing to God to make it into the kingdom. Do not render evil for evil.
 - Adam blamed Eve and the Most High took the kingdom away from us.
 - He does not allow any excuses.
- Do not use stress as a reason to lose the kingdom of God.
 - Nothing should stop you from seeking the commandments of God.
 - You need to study and read your four chapters a day.
- The Most High can replace us with new wives.
 - He can raise up stones to replace us.
 - Stop playing with God and these men.
 - They are more precious than fine gold.
 - He may not look like gold to you now, but he will be more precious than gold.
- You need to make a conscious decision on how much you want to make it to the kingdom.
 - I am Team Asaph.
 - Whatever he thinks he is not good at, I'm on it to figure out how to help him.
 - That is my mindset.
- You need to be his cheerleader, his #1 fan.
 - Sometimes you can have people believe in themselves based on you believing in them.
 - Be the example and let your light shine.
 - Do not give up on your lord. These men are going to be kings in the kingdom and ruling the planet; they will be the lords over everything.
 - Make sure that you are a faithful wife and faithful to God.
- We do what our husbands like.
 - Whatever he likes is what is getting done.
 - If he changes what he likes from day-to-day, change with him.
 - Do not argue.

- Your husband may want your children to be smart in the scriptures, so you need to get on that. If they are not as smart as he would like them to be in schoolwork, you need to get on that.
 - I used to wake up at 5 am to teach my kids before they went to school. Now they are homeschooled and we still do it.
- Our mansions are waiting for us. Are you going to do what's pleasing to God to get them?
 - You need to support these men.
 - No matter what happens in the home, keep the commandments.
 - Be kingdom-minded. Do not render evil for evil.

Proverbs 9:10 (KJV) The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.

- TMH can do anything to us for breaking his laws.
 - You need to learn about his judgments.
 - You have to fear God to have wisdom and ask for understanding.

Tribulation in Marriage

Ecclesiasticus 2:1 (Apocrypha) My son, if thou come to serve the Lord, prepare thy soul for temptation.

- Everything you think and say needs to be pleasing to the Lord. Study to prepare your soul.

1 Peter 3:5 (KJV) For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

- Trust in the Most High and be in subjection to your husband.
- Ask him to give you eloquent speech; be kind, gentle, and peaceful towards him.

Isaiah 55:8 (KJV) For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD.

- Do not defraud your husband.
 - Light some incense and give your husband what he needs.
 - Take a Tylenol or extra-strength Tylenol if you have a headache.
 - Stop playing games ladies.
- Your husband is going to transform into that man of God like pure gold.
 - Your husband needs a woman next to him that is going to support him on his journey.
 - Pray for your husband in a happy, loving, and kind spirit.
- Have consistency in righteousness.
 - You cannot be Foremother Esther one day and Satan the next day.

- Do not say you are a virtuous Proverbs 31 woman when you are flipping back and forth between niggardness.

Ephesians 4:32 (KJV) And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

- Be soft and loving towards your lord.
- Nothing should stop you from keeping these laws, statutes, and commandments.
 - If your lord is evil, you should still enter the kingdom based on your actions and setting a righteous example, consistently.
 - It is a win-win for you; do not use him as a reason to get out of the spirit.
 - The Most High allowed our Foremother Abigail to be married to a king.
- Give your lord time to evolve and transform.
 - Help him wherever he is on his journey.
 - Have patience, forgive and let it go.
 - This walk is about a lot of forgiveness; for your lord, your children, and your sisters!
 - Be kingdom-minded.

Romans 12:17 (KJV) Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men.

- Do not be petty towards your husband when he does something you don't like.
 - Stay calm. Forgive.
- Do not let someone have that much power over you to leave from God.
- Do not be on the phone for 3 hours and then suddenly have a headache when your husband wants you.

James 3:11-13 (KJV) Doth a fountain send forth at the same place sweet water and bitter? (12) Can the fig tree, my brethren, bear olive berries? either a vine, figs? so can no fountain both yield salt water and fresh. (13) Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.

- No one should be able to move you. Work on being honest and sincere. Your husband needs to see consistency in righteousness.

Proverbs 18:21 (KJV) Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

- You can either build your husband up or you can give him death by being disrespectful.
- You need to have the law of kindness in your tongue. Train yourself to have life come out of your tongue.

Ephesians 4:31 (KJV) Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

- Stop using bitter words towards your husband and speaking evil behind his back.
- Do not put more effort into your house, or your car than in your spirit.
- Rule your spirit and control your anger.
- Pray to the most High to put a better spirit on your husband. Be kind after your prayer.
- Trust in the Lord.

Revelation 20:11-12 (KJV) And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. (12) And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

- There are books written on everything we have done and everything we say.
 - It does not matter if we are wearing fringes, if we do not fix our spirits as wives we will not make the kingdom.
- A righteous woman has to have righteous works to enter into the kingdom.
- Get counsel. Do not get out the spirit. Pray, fast, and watch classes.

Colossians 4:6 (KJV) Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.

- If your lord is going off, listen to him and wait until he finishes speaking.
- Work on what he wants you to improve on.
- There is a kingdom that awaits us with more than our hearts could ever desire.
- Challenge yourself and try to be a righteous woman with righteous works.
