 Paryah

- ⇒ We are under a microscope being married to a ranked man, but we had to go through a process to change.

 Naamah

- ⇒ When we receive negative feedback, we must take it and evaluate ourselves and make sure we are offending less.
- ⇒ Take accountability.

 Paryah

- ⇒ Make sure when we are at fault that we are not pointing the finger and acknowledge that your life is your responsibility.
- ⇒ Own up to it, change, and move on
- ⇒ As leadership wives, we are not above correction.

 Yemina

- ⇒ Do you think some wives avoid accountability because they don't want to acknowledge that they made a mistake, so they walk around like they don't do anything wrong?

 Adalayah


- We are going to get corrected and judged and we must be ready for that.

 Paryah

- ⇒ We've all been there of not wanting to take accountability at one point, but we are human and make mistakes.

 Naamah

- ⇒ When I first came in, I didn't like people who I was not friends with who would correct me. I had to pray for the Lord to help me to take correction no matter if it was my enemy or my friend.

 Susanna

- ⇒ We understand that we are going to make mistakes, but we need the other sisters to understand that we will make mistakes.
- ⇒ **Proverbs 5:14 (KJV 1611)**
 - almost in the midst of all evil in the congregation
 - examine yourself to prevent being evil in the congregation.
- ⇒ **Ecclesiasticus (Sirach) 1:30 (KJV 1611)**
 - Don't exalt yourself or God will cast you down in the midst of the congregation.
- ⇒ We need to keep the commandments and have a healthy fear of the Lord.

Paryah

- **Ecclesiasticus (Sirach) 26:26 (KJV 1611)**
 - A woman who honors her husband is wise.
- We must honor our lords, so we're not stood up in front of the congregation.
- We need to be walking on eggshells to make sure that we are not blaspheming the word of God.

Naamah

- As a deacon's wife we expect you to make mistakes and for even me to make a mistake, but we must get back up and make the change.
- Fight to be better.
- **Titus 3:3 (KJV 1611)**
 - At one point we all were foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving diverse lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hating, and hating one another.
 - We must keep this scripture in mind and know that we came from this and be forgiving to the sisters coming in who need to overcome these spirits.

Eliora: How do you deal with a sister whose demeanor is mean and who uses her lord's rank for her gain?

Paryah

- They use it to manipulate their position and put their sister in fear of who they are and whom they are married to.
- The Most High will pull your card and that is a Jezebel spirit.
- The Most High will give you a chance to get it right, but after a while, the Lord will expose you.

Naamah

- **Ecclesiastes 8:11-13 (KJV 1611)**
 - So, sisters think that because they have not been corrected, they are doing well but their heart becomes more evil.
 - She may be evil to you a hundred times and it may feel long to you.
 - You must trust in the Lord and just walk away.
 - Pray to the Lord and trust in him making sure you don't do evil back.

Susanna

- I'm going to play the other side.
- Make sure that you have concrete facts that she is using her position and her lords' position to be evil.
- **Sirach 27:7 (KJV 1611)**
 - Follow the procedures of IUIC and make sure you don't have an evil eye or are not evil surmising.

Naamah

- If your name is always coming up in something, why are you around that person?

Anaiyah

- **1 Peter 3:9 (KJV 1611)**
 - Don't render evil for evil.
- If you feel this is happening, make sure you are showing good fruits.

Azarayah

- Sisters are emotional and with just the title alone sisters are intimidated.
- Sometimes there is a stigma, and we must make sure that we are not being emotional.
- Sometimes leadership wives must give orders that were given from their lords or other leadership wives, and we don't always have time to explain where the order is coming from.

Paryah

- There are times when we must stand up and be stern about things and some sisters are sensitive.

Yemina

- There was a sister that told me that she was scared to talk to me.
- **1 Corinthians 12:18 (KJV 1611)**
 - The Lord puts people in the body in certain positions as it pleases him.
- The Lord put people in position for a reason so even if the sister is being mean just do what you must do and let it play out to see what lesson needs to be learned.

Eliora: Talk about works and what is expected of leadership wives.

Susanna

- **Titus 2:3-4 (KJV 1611)**
 - We must master being a wife and mother and teach others.

Anaiyah

- I want to be an example and help.
- We must have work and not just sit back and only counsel.

Eliora

- When your leadership wife you love your people, and you are a servant.
- You want to see your sisters win.

Anna

- The laborers are few and we must have a willing spirit.
- I get in the kitchen and help my sisters; I am not handicapped.
- Purpose, perseverance, and patience

Paryah

- We may be involved in other things internationally or in other camps.
- Sometimes we are not always seen and are doing things in the background.

Naamah

- It's a whole job keeping your husband happy.
- Sometimes you're getting blamed, and he comes home angry, or frustrated, but you must be there for him and help him.
- Due benevolence and no matter how tired you are be ready to please him.
- Make sure you are giving your lord the attention he needs.
- Learn each child's weaknesses and make each weakness their strength.
- Make sure the children are learning every day the necessary things.
- Teach your children to pray in affliction.
- Make sure the congregation is getting what they need by creating groups and supports that are needed.
- Make sure you have a balance, and you are meeting the standard of being a virtuous wife.

Adalayah

- The burden is not on you to decide whether your counselor is too busy or not, your counselor knows their own house.
- **Proverbs 14:23 (KJV 1611)**
 - There is profit in all labor, but talking a good game led to penury.
 - You can talk the talk, but will you put in the labor that is needed?

Yemina

- I don't like when sisters try to manage my schedule.
- Call me if you need me and if I am busy at that time, I will call you back.
- Stop making excuses.

Naamah

- Make sure as a ranked man's wife that you are happy.
- You should love your husband and be honored and happy with your role.
- Make sure you are not going through the motions and doing all this labor and then there is no love in the end.
- Give him all the love you can so he can say he would marry you again.

Anna

- My lord is always mad, but I always try to make him laugh and offer him the things he may need to relax.
- Always give him the 3 S's silence, sex, submission, sustenance

Naamah

- The men watch how you treat their children, how you homeschool their children, how you talk to them, and whether you are doing it with joy and love.

Paryah

- Be patient with the children through the pains of education.
- You are learning also as you are teaching them.
- **2 Maccabees 7:27 (KJV 1611)**
 - Endure the pains of education.

Naamah

- The pain of teaching your children is real.
- The firstborns are usually on it because you have more time to put in, but this doesn't mean the younger children are not as smart.
- Sometimes you must change your child's environment such as going to the library or a café or somewhere else they may enjoy for them to relax and focus on their schoolwork.
- What are you putting out into the atmosphere for your family?

Anaiyah

- It is a mindset, and that spirit of frustration, annoyance, aggravation, and demotivation is not good because this is your lot.
- Know when something is wrong with your lord so you can help ease it.
- Making the home environment happy and welcoming is important because we never want to hear our children say that they wish they were in public school.

Naamah

- I want my legacy to be that I was the best wife and mom and very loving.
- Are you waking up daily to bring your lord joy? Don't worry about the austere face.
- Breathe life into them because you don't know when the last time will be.

- What do your children think of you?
- 📖 Eliora
 - We need our minds instructed well so we can be great wives and mothers.
 - In the next segment, we will discuss mental fortitude in marriage.
 - **Sirach 26:14-15 (KJV 1611)**
 - A silent and loving woman
 - We must have a sound mind to function and take care of our children and our lords.
 - You need to love yourself enough to love others.
- 📖 Yemina
 - **Sirach 7:26 (KJV 1611)**
 - Have a wife after your mind.
 - You need to ask what your lord wants in this life and what his goal in this life is.
 - What can you do to help him achieve these things?
 - Forsake means to abandon.
 - You shouldn't want your lord to go anywhere so have a mind after his mind.
 - You can't be a helpmeet to your lord if you are a light woman because you know nothing.
- 📖 Naamah
 - It takes discipline to get over yourself and be there for your lord.
 - Don't give him Aunt Jemima poom poom!
 - Get yourself together, smell good, and give your best performance ever.
 - Don't give casket sex!
- 📖 Anaiyah
 - You better be happy that he still wants you even though you have mood swings and are changing.
 - You don't want him to hope that you go to sleep first.
- 📖 Naamah
 - Bishop Kani said that he loves his wife so much that he could never see his life without her.
 - That's what you want your lord to say about you.
- 📖 Paryah
 - I remember going through a moment for years of having to accept my desire needing to be to my husband.
 - I had goals that I wanted like going back to school but for him, I had to not be so self-centered.
 - My goal didn't work for him at that time.
 - I went through feeling like he didn't care, and it was all about him with all that I have done giving him 13 years.
 - One day it clicked that the Lord put me with my lord for a reason and trust in my lord.
 - I had to check myself and realize that my goal didn't work for my lord's household.
 - It's all about him and what he wants for his family.
- 📖 Naamah
 - Other women ask their lords if they can stay home but their lords tell them no.

- I tried to do clinical psychology and my lord told me he wanted me to just stay home and teach the children.
- Some women cry to stay home but some of us want to go to work.

📖 Bayla

- You must have a selfless spirit.
- You must know your role and have a humble spirit because our lords will be traveling more lords will with the order Bishop gave for Isaiah 11:11
- Even when your lord gets rank you still need to put in the work and not put it off to the newer sisters to do.

📖 Eliora

- **Matthew 23:11 (KJV 1611)**
 - He that is greatest will be your servant.

📖 Susanna

- You need to have mental toughness and prefer one another.
- If your lord is leadership, it shows that he prefers his people and may seem that he prefers others over you.
- **Tobit 2:1-5 (KJV 1611)**
 - Tobit was gone for a long time.
 - Remember that your lord loves his people and be grateful.
 - Tobit put his people first and after being gone for so long still put his people first.

📖 Yemina

- Anna was different, look at all she went through.
- Check yourself if you are at the point of your walk to handle this like a champ.

📖 Naamah

- Think about Anna hearing that one of their people was dead in the street, she forgot about the dinner too and was worried about her people so your mindset would be like your lords in this case.
- Speak life back into when he comes back like Anna had to do with all he was feeling about having to bury his people.

📖 Yemina

- Tobit 2 is such a good spirit checker.

📖 Paryah

- A sister said to me using the analogy of a sunflower. Your lord may have a mindset to do something different than what you were thinking, we need to be like a sunflower and follow the sun wherever it goes.
- Sometimes we don't know our lord's expectations.
- Anna didn't catch the feeling behind the change her lord made but just did what she had to do and supported him.

📖 Azarayah

- Paryah truly represents her husband and I have learned a lot from her.
- My lord is spontaneous like 10:00 pm let's take a bike ride. I can't complain but rather just go be with my lord.

📖 Paryah

- Being a leader wife, people are watching your example and it is everything that you are that example to learn from.
