- Genesis 2:21-23 (KJB)
 - The woman comes from Adam's rib and Adam said that woman is bone of his bone and flesh of his flesh.
- **➢** Genesis 3:20 (KJB)
 - Eve is the mother of all living.
- Sirach 25:24 (Apocrypha)
 - Of the woman came the beginning of all sin
- > The black, brown, and native American women not in truth are dead.
- ➤ We keep the dead woman alive by not applying repentance.
- Proverbs 21:16 (KJB)
 - The man who wanders out of the way of understanding remains in the congregation of the dead.
- ➤ A lot of us say we are in the truth, but we are spiritually walking in the congregation of the dead.
- > You may say that you don't believe that the black woman is God, but you behave in a way that supports this thought.

- Genesis 3:4-5 (KJB)
 - Eve wanted to be a god.
- When we disobey our lords or leadership, we want to be Eve.
- > 1 Corinthians 11:9-10 (KJB)
 - The woman was made for the man.
- Genesis 3:16 (KJB)
 - o Husbands rule over their wives.

- **Luke 17:5-6 (KJB)**
- ➤ Plan accordingly for the Day of Atonement and Tabernacles
- Dismantle: to take apart, destroy, or end, strip for repair, annihilate, pull down
- 2 Corinthians 10:5-6 (KJB)
 - o Cast down imaginations that exalt against the knowledge of God.

Bring every thought into the obedience of Christ. "Don't thínk just do." - Deacon Labaccha

- > The Eve mentality is that you think you know better than the men.
- > Some of us go into the Day Atonement "fresh", but still take in the old thoughts and ways.
- Luke 13:28 (KJB)
 - Count the cost.
 - As we go into the Day of Atonement consider if you have enough to finish the walk that you started.
- > How do we change our thoughts and dismantle, or tear down our inner Eve?
 - This is for the bad girl and Eve that is within all of us.
 - This is a moment of pause and reflection.
 - 2 Corinthians 13:5 (KJB)
 - Be intentional confront yourself and be honest with yourself about where you are in his walk.
 - Be specific on areas of improvement.
 - What are your strengths and weaknesses?
 - o Do you have a desire to quit, do you believe in this truth or are you just wasting time?
 - How are you representing the Lord in your daily walk and how are showing up in the world?
 - When are you the most out of the spirit?
 - Who am I?
 - What battles are you currently fighting?
 - 2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJB)
 - Be a new creature in Christ.
- > What are some of the negative traits in Eve that we can learn from according to Bishop Nathanvel?
 - Accountability: the fact or condition of being accountable or responsible, taking responsibility for one's actions
 - Genesis 3:13 (KJB)



- Eve blamed the serpent.
- James 5:16 (KJB)
 - Confess your faults one to another to be healed.
- Luke 12:47-48 (KJB)
 - Too much is given much is required.
- Luke 17 and Matthew 7 (KJB)
 - If your brother transgresses against you, forgive them.
 - Take the moat out of your eye and make sure you're not a hypocrite.
- James 1:14-15 (KJB)
 - Every man/woman is tempted when drawn away from their lust which leads to death.

 - Every one of us will give an account of ourselves to God.
- Sirach 34:25-26 (KJB)
 - Why fast if you won't change? There is no profit.
- Revelations 20:12 (KJB)
 - The books will be opened on the day of judgment.
- Learn accountability including how to spell it A-C-C-O-U-N-T-A-B-I-L-I-T-Y
- > The triplets
 - Envy: the feeling of discontent or resentfulness based on what someone else has, it is a strong desire to have the same things that someone else has including a quality, possession, or an attribute that belongs to someone else
 - The most powerful cause of unhappiness.
 - Proverbs 27:4 (KJB)
 - Who can stand before envy?
 - It is one of the worst sins you can commit.
 - Proverbs 14:30 (KJB)
 - Envy is rottenness to the bones.
 - You are destroying yourself from the inside out.
 - Envy makes a person unhappy, and they wish the other person who be just as miserable as they are.



- Malicious envy is an emotion of wanting someone to be ruined because they want to hero to suffer.
- Envy turns into jealousy.
- Jealousy: feeling of unhappiness and anger because someone has something that you want.
 - Philippians 2:3 (KJB)
 - let nothing be given by vain glory.
- *Covetousness:* a strong wish to have something that belongs to somebody else
 - Hebrews 13:5 (KJB)
 - Let your conversation be without covetousness and be content with what you have.
- Envy is, "I like what you have, show me how to get it".
 - Genesis 3:4-5 (KJB)
 - Even like that Adam was a god and wanted what he had.
- Jealousy is, "green with envy." the person is fearful of losing something and may want vengeance. I want what you have, and until I have it you shouldn't have it either.
- Covetousness is I want what you have. I am more worthy of having it than you.
- James 4:2-3 (KJB)
 - Lust and kill to have it, but still don't get what you want because you are coming from a covetous place.
- Titus 3:3 (KJB)
 - We were also once foolish.
 - Leadership wives once were dealing with these spirits also, but we must heal from these.

> Are you battling the triplets and feeding these things to your lord?

- **Genesis 3:6 (KJB)**
 - Eve ate and gave some to her husband.
 - Stop the pillow talk and understand that if you do that, you are sowing seeds of discord, and hatred, and it's a form of manipulation!
 - Manipulation: harmful behaviors to avoid responsibility, to conceal true intentions, or to cause doubt and confusion
- Risk assessment in business:
 - 1) Identify the hazards. Spiritually could be gossip, talebearing, lack of submission, not shamefaced, not modest.
 - 2) Decide who might be harmed and how based on the hazard. A marriage, and friendships, could be harmed by the hazard.
 - 3) Evaluate the risk and decide on the precautions. Lust, evil, surmising, or what law is being broken?
 - 4) You need to record your findings and implement them. Correction needs to come out, apply.
 - 5) Prevent harm from happening and identify possible hazards that hurt the organization and our organization is the entire nation as a whole.



- Examples: a soft answer will turn away wrath, defrauding your lord could be a setup for adultery, overeating could lead to obesity
- To dismantle the Eve that is within and without, we need to have a risk assessment.

> Bishop said that Eve was selfish.

- Selfish: lack of consideration for others, concerned chiefly with your profits or gains.
- Are you a selfish person?
 - Are you seeking or concentrating on your advantage, pleasure, or well-being without regard for others, including your husband?
 - Do you have a lack of concern or welfare or only building up to your advantage?
 - In Genesis 3, Eve did not trust her husband to lead, had selfish ambitions to be equal to her husband, and committed a self-act to get power.
 - Philippians 2:4 (KJB)
 - Look not at your things but at the things of others.
 - Are you looking to see how you can help another sister?
 - Does she need help with her kids, cleaning, or anything at all?
 - Did she just give birth?
 - How are you being helpful to the nation overall?
 - Galatians 6:1-2 (KJB)
 - Bear one another's burdens and fulfill the law of Christ.
 - The Eve spirit won't care if another is lacking food, or their lights went out.
 - 2 Timothy 3:1-7 (KJB)
 - All of these characteristics are Eve-like traits.
 - The Daughters of Sarah theme for this year is "Endure until the End", but some of us won't endure the trials and endure until the end because of the spirit of rebellion and witchcraft.

• Are you sorry or are you just saying just to say it?

- Adam and Eve despite all they went through and Eve being disobedient, were able to work it out.
- If your lord was demoted or made a mistake, you still need to comfort him and be there for him as long as he is still willing to keep the commandments. After all, Eve did, Adam still was there for her through her trial.
- Matthew 6:13-15 (KJB)
 - Forgive to be forgiven.
 - Sin is sin whether a person did a "big" or "small" sin according to our opinion. It doesn't matter sin is sin.
- Grateful: a feeling or showing appreciation and kindness, being thankful
- Genesis 3:16-17, 19, 23-24 (KJB)
 - Our lords go out and work, sweat, etc. to support us and we still dare to be ungrateful and have an attitude with our lords.



- Stop being ungrateful.
- They were cast out of their home.

Sirach 29:21 (KJB)

- The chief things in life
- For those who cannot forgive, you need to ask the lord for the spirit of forgiveness because it is through growth that obtain this.
- Discomfort is part of the growth process.
- Growing pains because growth is painful.
- Babies and toddlers don't give up when they are learning to walk, but we give up at the least amount of adversity and correction.
- We can't go through the day of atonement without any battle scars.
- Everybody wants to be a diamond, but nobody wants to be cut (cut by the scriptures).

1 Peter 2:1-3 (KJB)

 If we want to grow, we must be able to drink the sincere milk of the word.

> Courage

- If you feel stuck and stagnant, you may not know what to do. However, as we go into the day of atonement you must gain the courage to change and apply the commandments.
- Self-doubt: the fear of failure and judgment
 - Proverbs 3:5 (KJB)
 - Lean not on your understanding.
 - This will help you to overcome fear.

1 Peter 3:5 (KJB)

- We are daughters of Sarah as long as we do without fear.
- Prove to me, leadership, and your lord that you are not afraid to admit what you have done wrong.
- Build up your courage and show yourself that you can do this walk without fear as a daughter of Sarah.

> Clarity and Action

- 2 Peter 1:5-7 (KJB)
 - If we have these things, we will be fruitful.
 - *Diligence:* careful and persistent work or effort
 - Have you been careful, consistent, and putting in work, and effort?
 - Virtue: behavior showing high moral standards
 - Do you have high moral standards?
 - *Knowledge*: facts and information, skills acquired through experience and education
 - Study, pay, and apply.
 - **Temperance:** a quality of moderation or restraint



- *Patience*: compacity to accept or tolerate trouble or suffering without getting angry or upset
- *Faith:* complete confidence in something or someone without actual proof
 - Hebrews 11:1 (KJB)
 - Faith is things hoped for
- > Manage self-care through the discomfort.
 - o Be patient with yourself because you must unlearn old limits and habits.
 - We need to focus on our evolution.
 - Seek counsel and apply the counsel given.
 - o 1 Corinthians 13:11-12 (KJB)
 - When I was a child, I thought as a child.
 - It is time to grow up spiritually.
 - Accept all the trials and tribulations that come in this journey.
 - o Growth demands a temporary feeling of insecurity.
 - It is time to let go of things. Even nature knows to let go at this time of year.
 - James 2:26 (KJB)
 - Faith without works is dead.
 - If you have an issue with forgiving people, you must put the work in to overcome it.
