

- Leadership is spiritual, they are prophets that were sent to turn this world right side up how it should be and it's very important that we understand our role as women
- o Jezebel was not displaying holy behavior
- o She hated the prophets; her daughter was just the same way
 - As is the mother, so is the daughter

We must renew our minds and change if we want to get the kingdom...

The scriptures instruct us, but we allow our emotions to cause ourselves to sin by not taking heed to the counsel.

Be grateful for those who are watching out for your soul...

It's only to build us and not to break us

"Don't take everything as a personal attack"

Romans 15:4 (KJV) For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope.

<u>Ask yourself:</u> Are we really thinking about the integrity of Susanna, Abigail's patience; the compassion of Esther and Judith, and the works of are foremothers?



- Are you displaying holy behavior? Take a step back and examine.
- o Are we taking on the qualities and the attributes that our foremothers showed?

"We are the light of the world, so should be no on or off switch"

<u>2 Corinthians 13:5 (KJV)</u> Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

Quote: "Don't let your emotions distract you from doing what needs to be done, control your emotions."

- O Your emotions will control you if you let them
- o If you're wrong, except that, don't let that distract you from those trying to help
- O You must always think about the message

Revolutionary women cannot be emotional, you must be down for the cause...

Don't let your emotions get in the way of clear thinking. We must think spiritually, not carnally.

List the sins you are battling...

Things you want to improve really examine. We will use this as a guide throughout the class.

Titus 2:3-5 (KJV)

<u>vs 3</u> The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

<u>vs 4</u> That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

<u>vs 5</u> To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

- We have to show that the light is here amongst the repentant Israelite woman
- We must be the light of this world

Teaching the children...

When our children see wickedness whether it be in public or social media, they should be able to call out the sin.

We must cut out the worldly way of thinking...

We have to show them our light.

"How am I an asset to this nation?"

Romans 7:12 (KJV) Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.

- o The scriptures show us how we should be conducting ourselves
 - How are you conducting yourself?



- How is your behavior toward others?

Married ladies:

Are you leaving wiggle room for the cleanup lady? Because she is serious.

<u>1 Corinthians 7:29 (KJV)</u> But this I say, brethren, the time is short: it remaineth, that both they that have wives be as though they had none;

Ephesians 5:33 (KJV) Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.

- o A holy woman shows reverence toward her lord
- o The small things like having his camp clothes ready and looking good
 - If you have to wake up earlier to make sure things are done, that's okay

<u>2 Esdras 14:34 (KJV Apocrypha)</u> Therefore if so be that ye will subdue your own understanding, and reform your hearts, ye shall be kept alive and after death ye shall obtain mercy.

o She subdues her own understanding and follows her lord as he follows Christ

<u>Ecclesiasticus 6:36 (Apocrypha)</u> And if thou seest a man of understanding, get thee betimes unto him, and let thy foot wear the steps of his door.

- o Single sisters, worry about that time factor when they get married
- We must be taught by those we see moving in righteousness

Romans 12:2 (KJV) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

- Overcome the worldly mindset and putting on the new mind
- o Learn to love, trust, and respect your lord
- You must subdue the carnal part in us that thinks she knows what's best and wants to do things her way

<u>Define subdue:</u> Overcome, to bring under control

<u>Genesis 26:8 (KJV)</u> And it came to pass, when he had been there a long time, that Abimelech king of the Philistines looked out at a window, and saw, and, behold, Isaac was sporting with Rebekah his wife.

- They were enjoying each other
- o Am I showing that love that he deserves
 - Bring that joy, show love and give compliments
 - Sport with him

Serving your lord...

Single sisters: learn how to cook food, reach out to sisters to ask for recipes, bring out the nice plates and practice plating.

Don't be disrespectful...

Getting mad, giving the silent treatment. You nagging is disrespectful

"You don't have to say anything, it's what you look like sometimes"

Ecclesiasticus 36:23 (KJV Apocrypha) If there be kindness, meekness, and comfort, in her tongue, then is not her husband like other men. she will comfort him and not disrespect

- o Give him the encouragement that he needs
- O Support and help build him speak life into him

Ephesians 4:31 (KJV) Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

o If you don't have anything good to say, don't say anything

Ephesians 4:32 (KJV) And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

- When you are going through your trials go to the word
- o Your own understanding will mess you up every single time
- o This is why it helps to have a counselor to get you back in the spirit

"We really have the practice that holy behavior"

Ephesians 5:22 (KJV) Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.

Humble down and let your lord guide you...



The prophets are back on the earth, you don't know what spirit you are married to, so really have that respect.

Sirach 26:13-16 (Apocrypha)

vs 13 The grace of a wife delighteth her husband, and her discretion will fatten his bones.

<u>vs 14</u> A silent and loving woman is a gift of the Lord; and there is nothing so much worth as a mind well instructed.

<u>vs 15</u> A shamefaced and faithful woman is a double grace, and her continent mind cannot be valued.

<u>vs 16</u> As the sun when it ariseth in the high heaven; so is the beauty of a good wife in the ordering of her house.

- o **Discretion**: speaking in a way to avoid or to cause offense
- o Understanding what submission is and do it unto the Lord

<u>1 Peter 3:7 (KJV)</u> Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

- O You must be on one accord with your husband so that your prayers be not hindered
- Whether it's prayers for good health or any other goals you have for yourselves

The Lord is not an author of confusion...

We bring confusion when we bring in our own way of thinking. This is the time we must take a step back and think, what does the Bible say?

Know that marriage is an honorable thing...

We should bring that honor to our marriage. We do it using the scriptures.

<u>1 Peter 3:8 (KJV)</u> Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:

- o To be pitiful means to have compassion
- o To be courteous means to be polite
 - Polite in one's attitude toward another

Behavior, it's about the way you treat others...

Single sisters: how are you treating leadership? **Married sisters:** how are you treating your lord?

- Are you taking heed to counsel?
- o Do you have a good report?
- o Are you getting along with your sisters?

"We are supposed to be practicing the fruits of the spirit with each other, we're family"

When the root of bitterness springs up in us...



We have this denial that comes. Once we don't check it, that demon gets irritated when you have to be around the person you have an issue with. That's darkness because it's hatred.

Romans 12:21 (KJV) Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

 Let others see that you don't go railing for railing instead let those hot coals heap upon their head

<u>Define Accountability:</u> The willingness to expect responsibility for your actions.

Do you own up to your own work or do you try to make excuses for yourself when something goes wrong? A person that takes accountability communicates honestly to whomever about it rather than hiding the truth.

"You must be accountable for yourself"

Romans 14:12 (KJV) So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

o It's a dangerous place when you don't want to be accountable because you aren't examining yourself

<u>Isaiah 58:9 (KJV)</u> Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I am. If thou take away from the midst of thee the yoke, the putting forth of the finger, and speaking vanity;

<u>Ezekiel 14:14 (KJV)</u> Though these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, they should deliver but their own souls by their righteousness, saith the Lord GOD.

• They had to deliver themselves through their own actions

<u>Job 30:14 (KJV)</u> They came upon me as a wide breaking in of waters: in the desolation they rolled themselves upon me.

• We have to show that the scriptures can change you if you allow them to

<u>Romans 12:9 (KJV)</u> Let love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good.

- Ask Yourself: What are you feeding your spirit?
- O You don't have to fake it to make it and pretend
 - We spent a lot of time building that representative
 - You would be deceiving your own selves
 - Be genuine
- o Confess your faults
- o Examine and get council

1 Corinthians 7:3-4 (KJV)

<u>vs 3</u> Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband.

<u>vs 4</u> The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body, but the wife.

- o Go to what the Bible says and do
- We must make sure we are showing our lords that respect and honor they need because we were created for them

"Be who you are but be a doer"

Ecclesiasticus 36:24 (Apocrypha)

He that getteth a wife beginneth a possession, a help like unto himself, and a pillar of rest.

• We were created to walk in that holy behavior
