TOBIT 2:11

"And my wife Anna did take women's works to do."

In our walk of repentance, we are instructed by the Most High through the scriptures how to conduct ourselves as a repented Israelite woman. Ask yourself, are you building your lords home in righteousness? The bible says in Matthew 7:20 (KJV) "wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them." Are you conducting yourself as a righteous wife in the absence of your lord as he is putting in the work to teach his people and to bring in the lost sheep? We've all heard The General Bishop Nathanyel's order for the prophets to go and wake our people up all over the world. In order for your lord to accept this mission you must have your mind in accordance with his mind and be ready for the battle. We cannot get caught up in what we think our marriage is supposed to be according to the standards of Babylon.

Our lords are the chosen of the Most High and we must understand that they have a commitment that they are making to the lord, with this being said he will have to go and teach and there are times when he will be unavailable. "Now when I was come home again, and my wife Anna was restored unto me, with my son Tobias, in the feast of Pentecost, which is the holy feast of the seven weeks, there was a good dinner prepared me, in the which I sat down to eat."

Tobit 2:1 KJVA

Anna took on a woman's work to help her lord when he was unable to work and reminded him of his righteousness when he accused her of stealing. Tobit stated he was abashed at her meaning he was embarrassed and instead of arguing with her lord she replied with kindness in her tongue and reminded him of his righteous deeds.

"But she replied upon me, It was given for a gift more than the wages. Howbeit I did not believe her, but bade her render it to the owners: and I was abashed at her. But she replied upon me, Where are thine alms and thy righteous deeds? behold, thou and all thy works are known. "Tobit 2:14
