# An Ostrich in Marriage

- o You continually call for counseling for the same things.
- o You're rebellious and not respecting your lord.
- O Delayed obedience: delaying, hindering, or postponing something that was instructed for you to do.
  - · Delayed obedience is disobedience.

## Characterístics of an Ostrich in Marriage

- o Criticize: want to take the person down to take the person down and attack them for who he is.
  - i. Proverbs 25:24 (KJB 1611)
    - Are you that brawling woman?
- o Contempt: outright attacking, disrespect, mocking, ridicule, frowning, being sarcastic, rolling eyes, pointing fingers
  - i. Sírach 26:14 (Apocrypha) Are you a sílent woman?
    - Is your mind well instructed?
- O Defensive: focus is on you, how it makes you look, fish for excuses, or point out his faults to avoid examining your faults, downplay what he is observing about you
  - i. Focus on being more compatible and acknowledging your faults.
- o Stonewalling: emotional withdrawal, the husband is shut out, lack of responsiveness, acting like you're so busy.
