

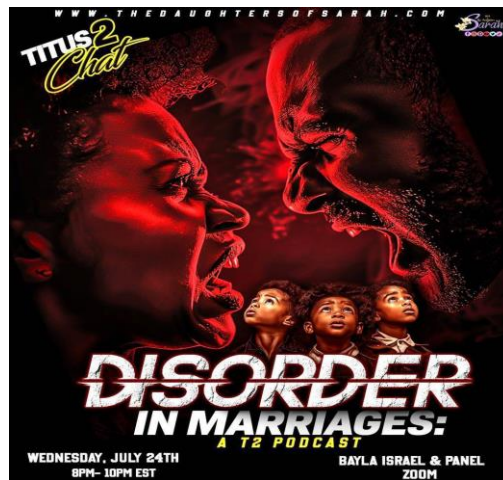


Event: Titus 2

Be sure to take in what is being taught. We know that with the Lord, actions are weighed (1 Samuel 2:3 (KJV)).

Inspiration: We get a lot of questions concerning the challenges we all face in marriage. The goal of this lesson is to affirm that building a marriage with a prophet requires work and patience. You must have a spirit of humility.

Usurping Authority

Wisdom Of Solomon 14:26 (KJV) “Disquieting of good men, forgetfulness of good turns, defiling of souls, changing of kind, **disorder in marriages**, adultery, and shameless uncleanness.”

What does disorder in a marriage look like?

The number one form of disorder in a marriage is disobedience or **usurping authority over your lord**.

to take control of a position of power, especially without having the right to:

• Local control is being usurped by the federal government.



Usurp means to take a position of power without Having the right to. So essentially this means that the authority does **NOT** belong to you.

1 Timothy 2:11(KJV) Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection:

V12 But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence.

As a sister, if you have a spirit of usurping authority, what are some things that you should practice to combat that spirit?

- Understanding and Accepting Your Role
- Take Correction
- Don't Be Emotional
- Apply The Scriptures

Dealing with a spirit of usurping authority over your lord goes hand in hand with dealing with a spirit of Rebellion.

Jeremiah 44:15 (KJV) Then all the men which knew that their wives had burnt incense unto other Gods, and all the women that stood by, a great multitude, even all the people that dwelt in the land of Egypt in Pathros, answered Jeremiah, saying,

V 16 As for the word that thou hast spoken unto vs in the name of the Lord, we will not hearken unto thee.

V 17 But we will certainly doe whatsoever thing goeth forth out of our own mouth, to burn incense unto the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her, as we have done, we and our fathers, our kings and our princes in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem: for then had we plenty of victuals, and were well, and saw no evil.

This is an example of sisters choosing not to listen to the men that were over them, but instead lean on their own understanding.

1 Sam 15:23 (KJV) "For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry: because thou hast rejected the word of the Lord, he hath also rejected thee from being king."



Proverbs 11:29 (KJV) “He that troubleth his own house, shall inherit the wind: and the fool shall be servant to the wise of heart.”

If you are not able to humble down to your lord, you are now causing disorder in the household. The lord says if you trouble your own house, you will inherit **nothing**.

Having Unrealistic Expectations

Don't be afraid to ask for help!

1 peter 3:7 (KJV) “Likewise ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers be not hindered.”

James 3:17 (KJV) “But the wisdom that is from above, is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy, and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.”

James 4:1 (KJV) “From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts, that war in your members? 2Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and ware, **yet ye have not, because ye ask not.**”

Do not expect your lord to know when you need help. Be prepared and willing to ask. Also note that when asking your lord for anything, make sure you are in order. That goes far beyond just speech, but also making sure you are dressed nicely, you smell good, and you are being kind to him.

Don't Make Your Husband the Enemy

1 Tim 3:4 (KJV) One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity.

V5 (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the Church of God?)

Genesis 3:16 (KJV) Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception. In sorrow thou shalt bring forth children: and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

In this truth, you must make sure that any expectations you have for your lord aligns with the scriptures. Your true desire is supposed to be unto your lord.

Your Treasure

Matthew 6:19 (KJV) Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through, and steal.

V 20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, & where thieves do not break through, nor steal.

V 21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

There are actions that we need to take to make sure we lay up treasure in heaven for ourselves. Our main treasure should be our lord.
