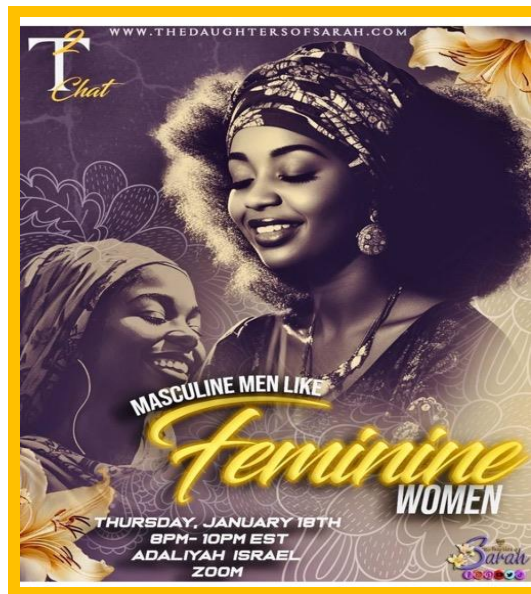

Definition of Femininity – the quality or nature of the female sex: the quality, state, or degree of being feminine or womanly.

Genesis 2:21-25 (KJV) And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; [22] And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. [23] And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. [24] Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh. [25] And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

The woman was created for the man, *not* the other way around.



- A repenting man does not have to put up with the wayward ways of a woman; one that still has the mindset of this world.

We are thankful and grateful to the righteous women of Israel.

Examples of feminine righteous standards of women:

Balance: Foremother Deborah

Judges 4:4-7 (KJV) And Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lapidoth, she judged Israel at that time. [5] And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment. [6] And she sent and called Barak the son of Abinoam out of Kedesh-naphtali, and said unto him, Hath not the LORD God of Israel commanded, saying, Go and draw toward mount Tabor, and take with thee ten thousand men of the children of Naphtali and of the children of Zebulun? [7] And I will draw unto thee to the river Kishon Sisera, the captain of Jabin's army, with his chariots and his multitude; and I will deliver him into thine hand.



Foremother Deborah, known as a prophetess, her heart was towards her leaders.

- She spoke life into the men of Israel.

Our real-life Mother of Balance: **Sister Shamarah**

- She is revolutionary, a wife, a mother with poise and style. She is well-balanced.

Judges 5:7-9 (KJV) The inhabitants of the villages ceased, they ceased in Israel, until that I Deborah arose, that I arose a mother in Israel. [8] They chose new gods; then was war in the gates: was there a shield or spear seen among forty thousand in Israel? [9] My heart is toward the governors of Israel, that offered themselves willingly among the people. Bless ye the LORD.

We have to find a routine, practice discipline, indulge in self-care and be responsible.

- We have to learn how to handle conflict calmly and gracefully; gentle yet firm.
- Be mindful of how we speak and who we are speaking to; watch the attitudes.

Philippians 2:3-4 (KJV) Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.

⁴ Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

Behavior: Foremother Hannah

1 Samuel 1:5 (KJV) But unto Hannah he gave a worthy portion; for he loved Hannah: but the LORD had shut up her womb.

She was provoked and upset because her womb was closed.

- Her husband had to remind her that he was still her responsibility.
- Even though her womb was closed, he still loved her most of all.

Be obedient and gentle.

1 Samuel 1:14 (KJV) And Eli said unto her, How long wilt thou be drunken? put away thy wine from thee.

Eli thought that Hannah was drunk because of the way she was praying.

Our real-life Mothers of Behavior: **Sister Paryah and Sister Anna**

- These are sisters with self-control, authenticity, tactful, and graceful.

We must address our own negativity and move on.

- We must learn to speak softly and cultivate an environment that the men want to be around.



1 Samuel 2:3 (KJV) Talk no more so exceedingly proudly; exceeding arrogance come out of your mouth: for the LORD is a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed.

- Our Foremother Hannah is speaking.

Proverbs 25:11 (KJV) A word fitly spoken is like apples of gold in pictures of silver.

There is a time and season for everything.

Beauty: Foremother Esther

Esther 2:12-14 (KJV) Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of the women, (for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, to wit, six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with sweet odours, and with other things for the purifying of the women;) [13] Then thus came every maiden unto the king; whatsoever she desired was given her to go with her out of the house of the women unto the king's house. [14] In the evening she went, and on the morrow she returned into the second house of the women, to the custody of Shaashgaz, the king's chamberlain, which kept the concubines: she came in unto the king no more, except the king delighted in her, and that she were called by name.

We have to learn to adjust to our lords. Adjust to his desires. Practice makes perfect.

Esther 15:5 (Apocrypha) And she was ruddy through the perfection of her beauty, and her countenance was cheerful and very amiable: but her heart was in anguish for fear.

It is a must that we rule our spirit, be friendly.

- Keep yourself together; keep up your hair, skincare, make-up, and most importantly your diet.
- Learn to dress your body type, practice self-control, and keep a good countenance.
- Cleanliness is purification.
 - Know how to bathe.

Romans 8:28 (KJV) And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Sexuality and sensuality

1 Peter 3:3-4 (KJV) Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; [4] But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.

Titus 2:3-5 (KJV) The aged women likewise, that they be in behavior as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; [4] That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, [5] To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

Traditional Values – Submission and support; know God's order.

Proverbs 10:31 (KJV) The mouth of the just bringeth forth wisdom: but the froward tongue shall be cut out.

1 Corinthians 11:3 (KJV) But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.

Respect and Empathy (Kindness) - Respect is needed. We must speak life into the men.



Proverbs 31:26 (KJV) She openeth her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the law of kindness.

Calmness – There is strength in being feminine. Embrace who we are and how we should be according to the Bible.

Proverbs 31:11 (KJV) The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil.

Proverbs 31:17 (KJV) She girdeth her loins with strength, and strengtheneth her arms.

Confidence

Deuteronomy 7:6 (KJV) For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

Do you believe what the scriptures say?

Sirach 7:25 (Apocrypha) Marry thy daughter, and so shalt thou have performed a weighty matter: but give her to a man of understanding.

We should have no lack of confidence.

- Be secure within yourself, the Most High already chose us.
- Study to show yourself approved.
- We are not in competition; we are all support systems.
- Let the men handle the weighty matters, they are the problem solvers and the leaders.

1 Peter 3:7 (KJV) Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

We are the weaker vessels.

- Beware of what we allow in our spirits.

2 Corinthians 12:9 (KJV) And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

The Most High will bring us strength.

- Be considerate, stress free and receptive, not guarded.
