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What's Your Relationship With Your Son?

A Conversation With Our Sons As Per King Lemuel's Mother: Proverbs 31

\*\*\*\*\*Sister Adiya...The beginning of the class, there was no sound on our end, my notes begin when the Soldier turned on the sound\*\*\*\*\*

Mother Naamah:

Our sons should be seeking a wife to grow aged/old together with. Don't hide what your sons are doing. They must be taught to stay away from the other nations to avoid whoredom by not marrying them. But to love their own people and to ask for counsel from those that are wise.

\*Tobit 8:7 And now, O Lord, I take not this my sister for lush but uprightly: therefore mercifully ordain that we may become aged together.

\*Tobit 4:12, 18 Beware of all whoredom, my son, and chiefly take a wife of the seed of thy fathers, and take not a strange woman to wife, which is not of thy father's tribe: for we are the children of the prophets, Noe, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: remember, my son, that our fathers from the beginning, even that they all married wives of their own kindred, and were blessed in their children, and their seed shall inherit the land. 18 Ask counsel of all that are wise, and despise not any counsel that is profitable.

Teach your sons to not be swayed by "flattery". Flattery is the excessive praise for one's own interest. Tell your sons that the girls will be coming after them and will use flattery, make them aware of that fact. Teach your sons what a whore/harlot looks like and to stay away from her. If he gives in to her, he will be like an ox being led to be slaughtered.

-Mother Paryah - The girls today are very forward, you must gird up your sons.

\*Proverbs 7:5, 10-22 That they may keep thee from the strange woman, from the stranger which flattereth with her words. 10 And, behold, there met him a woman with the attire of an harlot, and subtil of heart. 11 (She is loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house: 12 Now is she without, now in the streets, and lieth in wait at every corner.) 13 So she caught him, and kissed him, and with an impudent face said unto him, 14 I have peace offerings with me; this day have I payed my vows. 15 Therefore came I forth to meet thee, diligently to seek thy face, and I have found thee. 16 I have decked my bed with coverings of tapestry, with carved works, with fine linen of Egypt. 17 I have perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes, and cinnamon. 18 Come, let us take our fill of love until the morning; let us solace ourselves with loves. 19 For the good man is not at home, he is gone a long journey: 20 He hath taken a

bag of money with him, and will come home at the day appointed. 21 With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him. 22 He goeth after her straightway, as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks;

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 26:22 An harlot shall be accounted as spittle: but a married woman is a tower against death to her husband.

\*Leviticus 19:29 Do not prostitute thy daughter, to cause her to be a whore; lest the land fall to whoredom, and the land become full of wickedness.

Teach your sons that she uses the exquisite subtilty (being slick) and dishonesty, and that they should not go after their lust. Everyone should be inquired of about who the woman is and let everybody check her out. There may be things that one sees about her that another may not.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 19:25 There is an exquisite subtilty, and the same is unjust; and there is one that turneth aside to make judgment appear; and there is a wise man that justifieth in judgment.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 18:30 Go not after thy lusts, but refrain thyself from thine appetites.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 26:24 A dishonest woman contemneth shame: but an honest woman will reverence her husband.

Teach your children that they are not to marry the other nations, not their sons or their daughters. They will teach the children after their customs and not after following God. King Solomon in all his wisdom was married many strange women and his heart was turned away after their gods. Teach them that there are consequences that will destroy them.

\*Deuteronomy 7:3-4 Neither shalt thou make marriages with them; thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son. 4 For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly.

\*Nehemiah 13:23-25 In those days also saw I Jews that had married wives of Ashdod, of Ammon, and of Moab: 24 And their children spake half in the speech of Ashdod, and could not speak in the Jews' language, but according to the language of each people. 25 And I contended with them, and cursed them, and smote certain of them, and plucked off their hair, and made them swear by God, saying, Ye shall not give your daughters unto their sons, nor take their daughters unto your sons, or for yourselves.

\*I Kings 11:1-4, 11 But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, and Hittites; 2 Of the nations concerning which the LORD said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall not go in to them, neither shall they come in unto you: for surely they will turn away your heart after their gods: Solomon clave unto these in love. 3 And he had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart. 4 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as was the heart of David

his father. 11 Wherefore the LORD said unto Solomon, Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the kingdom from thee, and will give it to thy servant.

Teach your sons that there are punishments and plagues that come with whoredom and marrying the other nations. Our forefather Samson married Delilah of another nation and was punished. Plagues and diseases that are long lasting, and can be transferred to your babies at birth can also come upon you. Some are incurable.

\*Judges 16:4-5, 16, 21 And it came to pass afterward, that he loved a woman in the valley of Sorek, whose name was Delilah. 5 And the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and said unto her, Entice him, and see wherein his great strength lieth, and by what means we may prevail against him, that we may bind him to afflict him: and we will give thee every one of us eleven hundred pieces of silver. 16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death; But the Philistines took him, and put out his eyes, and brought him down to Gaza, and bound him with fetters of brass; and he did grind in the prison house.

\*Deuteronomy 28:58-61 If thou wilt not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that thou mayest fear this glorious and fearful name, THE LORD THY GOD; 59 Then the LORD will make thy plagues wonderful, and the plagues of thy seed, even great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance. 60 Moreover he will bring upon thee all the diseases of Egypt, which thou wast afraid of; and they shall cleave unto thee. 61 Also every sickness, and every plague, which is not written in the book of this law, them will the LORD bring upon thee, until thou be destroyed.

Teach your sons to seek out a wife not for her outward appearance, but seek one who is meek, being in subjection, shamefaced and faithful. She should be one who uses discretion and has a mind that is well instructed. Her mind should be like his.

\*I Peter 3:3-5 Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; 4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price. 5 For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

\*Zephaniah 2:3 - (Meek) Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 26:13-15 The grace of a wife delighteth her husband, and her discretion will fatten his bones. 14 A silent and loving woman is a gift of the Lord; and there is nothing so much worth as a mind well instructed. 15 A shamefaced and faithful woman is a double grace, and her continent mind cannot be valued.

Teach your sons that the wife they choose should not be a light woman or stupid, as in a woman

who does not keep the commandments. She should be a wise and good woman who keeps the commandments. Our foremother Judith was known for her wisdom even from her youth. She had the wisdom to please and to do it speedily.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 7:26 Hast thou a wife after thy mind? Forsake her not: but give not thyself over to a light woman.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 7:19 Forego not a wise and good woman: for her grace is above gold.

\*Judith 8:29 For this is not the first day wherein thy wisdom is manifested; but from the beginning of thy days all the people have known thy understanding, because the disposition of thine heart is good.

\*Judith 12:14 Then said Judith unto him, Who am I now, that I should gainsay my lord? surely whatsoever pleaseth him I will do speedily, and it shall be my joy unto the day of my death.

-STATISTICS: Domestic Violence = 1-5 years prison sentence; Rape = 10-25 years prison sentence; Statutory Rape = NO means NO!

Mother Shamarah:

Our foremother with the 7 sons was their teacher. There is mother and son relationship. As the first teacher, the mother is to train up her child, make him self aware and be a motivator. He will be less likely to be influenced by peer pressure. They will tend to be successful.

\*2 Maccabees 7:27 But she bowing herself toward him, laughing the cruel tyrant to scorn, spake in her country language on this manner; O my son, have pity upon me that bare thee nine months in my womb, and gave thee such three years, and nourished thee, and brought thee up unto this age, and endured the troubles of education.

\*Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

The majority of the son's time is spent with the mother. She should be taking every opportunity to teach him. The first foundation or bond begins when they are born. A son with a loving mother has the ability to articulate verbally with words calling her blessed.

\*Deuteronomy 11:19 And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

\*I Timothy 5:2 The elder women as mothers; the younger as sisters, with all purity.

\*Proverbs 31:28 Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praiseth her.

---Several questions were asked online and one of which was: What do you admire in your dad and why?

How close is a mother/son relationship? There is some form of emotional connection, intimacy, emotions, and words.

It is the mother's responsibility to build up her son. The adolescence age is an age of change for young boys and foolishness is in their minds and shows by what they do. She must teach him what is good. While they are young, keep them around the elders and leadership so that they can listen and be taught.

\*Proverbs 22:1, 15 A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold. 15 Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

\*Proverbs 20:11 Even a child is known by his doings, whether his work be pure, and whether it be right.

\*Romans 7:12 (Good) Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 6:32-37 My son, if thou wilt, thou shalt be taught: and if thou wilt apply thy mind, thou shalt be prudent. 33 If thou love to hear, thou shalt receive understanding: and if thou bow thine ear, thou shalt be wise, 34 Stand in the multitude of the elders; and cleave unto him that is wise. 35 Be willing to hear every godly discourse; and let not the parables of understanding escape thee. 36 And if thou seest a man of understanding, get thee betimes unto him, and let thy foot wear the steps of his door. 37 Let thy mind be upon the ordinances of the Lord and meditate continually in his commandments: he shall establish thine heart, and give thee wisdom at thine own desire.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 25:3 If thou hast gathered nothing in thy youth, how canst thou find any thing in thine age?

Teach your sons to obey their parents for this pleases God. If he lusts for money put him to labor. The authority of the mother is over the son and he should honor, and be a comfort to her that he be not cursed of God. Are you as a mother, an ostrich? For the mother in dishonour is a reproach to the children.

\*Colossians 3:20 Children, obey your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 3:1-11, 16 Hear me your father, O children, and do thereafter, that ye may be safe. 2 For the Lord hath given the father honour over the children, and hath confirmed the authority of the mother over the sons. 3 Whoso honoureth his father maketh an atonement for his sins: 4 And he that honoureth his mother is as one that layeth up treasure. 5 Whoso honoureth his father shall have joy of his own children; and when he maketh his prayer, he shall be heard. 6 He that honoureth his father shall have a long life; and he that is obedient unto the Lord shall be a comfort to his mother. 7 He that feareth the Lord will honour his father, and will do service unto his parents, as to his masters. 8 Honour thy father and mother both in word and deed, that a blessing may come upon thee from them. 9 For the blessing of the father establisheth the houses of children; but the curse of the mother rooteth out foundations. 10 Glory not in the dishonour of thy father; for thy father's dishonour is no glory unto thee. 11 For the glory of a man is from the honour of his father; and a mother in dishonour is a reproach to the children. 16 He that forsaketh his father is as a blasphemer; and he that angereth his mother is cursed of God.

There may shortcomings or mommy-ism. Single mothers with sons who did not get the love of their fathers must set rules and boundaries. They must be patient and consider using a soft answer. It is noted that mothers tend to raise their daughters and nurture or spoil their sons. This gives them a sense of entitlement because she tends to over-protect them.

\*Romans 12:12 Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;

\*Proverbs 15:1 A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.

---Video: The Willie Lynch Letter (Denzel Washington) The breaking process of the nigger woman and how she does a role reversal in the raising of her children. A phenomenon is occurring in respect to Ezekiel 37 the dry bones are rising up.

If you teach your sons to keep the commandment, you grieve the enemy. Put them to labour and teach them to work.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 30:3-13 He that teacheth his son grieveth the enemy: and before his friends he shall rejoice of him. 4 Though his father die, yet he is as though he were not dead: for he hath left one behind him that is like himself. 5 While he lived, he saw and rejoiced in him: and when he died, he was not sorrowful. 6 He left behind him an avenger against his enemies, and one that shall requite kindness to his friends. 7 He that maketh too much of his son shall bind up his wounds; and his bowels will be troubled at every cry. 8 An horse not broken becometh headstrong: and a child left to himself will be wilful. 9 Cocker thy child, and he shall make thee afraid: play with him, and he will bring thee to heaviness. 10 Laugh not with him, lest thou have sorrow with him, and lest thou gnash thy teeth in the end. 11 Give him no liberty in his youth, and wink not at his follies. 12 Bow down his neck while he is young, and beat him on the sides while he is a child, lest he wax stubborn, and be disobedient unto thee, and so bring sorrow to thine heart. 13 Chastise thy son, and hold him to labour, lest his lewd behaviour be an offence unto thee.

The salvation of our sons.

\*Isaiah 43:6 I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth;

---Factors that have an impact on the nation:

#### #1 Lack of Family Structure

\*Genesis 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

#### #2 Gangs and Violence

\*I Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

\*2 Corinthians 6:14-15, 17 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? 15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? 17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 37:12 But be continually with a godly man, whom thou knowest to keep the commandments of the Lord, whose mind is according to thy mind, and will sorrow with thee, if thou shalt miscarry.

\*Ecclesiastes 8:11-13 Because sentence against an evil work is not executed speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil. 12 Though a sinner do evil an hundred times, and his days be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear God, which fear before him: 13 But it shall not be well with the wicked, neither shall he prolong his days, which are as a shadow; because he feareth not before God.

\*Proverbs 1:8-10 My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother: 9 For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck. 10 My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not.

\*Exodus 23:2 Thou shalt not follow a multitude to do evil; neither shalt thou speak in a cause to decline after many to wrest judgment:

### #3 Abortions

\*Job 31:1 I made a covenant with mine eyes; why then should I think upon a maid?

\*2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

\*Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 42:8 Be not ashamed to inform the unwise and foolish, and the extreme aged that contendeth with those that are young: thus shalt thou be truly learned, and approved of all men living.

--NOTE: The daughters are not having babies alone. Teach your sons that they must take responsibility.)

\*James 1:12 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

### #4 High Incarceration Rates / School to Prison Pipeline / Institutional Racism

\*Romans 13:1-3 Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. 2 Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation. 3 For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same:

\*Ephesians 6:1-2 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. 2 Honour thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise;

\*I Peter 2:17 Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.

\*I Timothy 4:12 - Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

\*Psalms 119:9 Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word.

\*Wisdom of Solomon 1:5 For the holy spirit of discipline will flee deceit, and remove from thoughts that are without understanding, and will not abide when unrighteousness cometh in. (Create a nurturing environment.)

#5 Having A Sense of Community - Have good communication skills

\*I Corinthians 1:10 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

Teach your sons to flee and to stay separate.

\*James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

\*Matthew 5:25 Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou are in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison.

\*Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.
