Proverbs 31:1 - The words of king Lemuel, the prophecy that his mother taught him. (Teach your sons what kind of wife to choose).

Sirach/Ecclesiasticus 26:16 - As the sun when it ariseth in the high heaven; so is the beauty of a good wife in the ordering of her house. (Order your house. As a mother you are the teacher they learn first from. Teach using "repetition".

Dolch Words: The list contains 220 "service words" that must be quickly recognized in order to achieve reading fluency. The Dolch Word List is also called Sight Words or The Dolch 220. It includes the most frequently used words in the English language. (words children should know at/by a certain age. Make teaching fun)

#### The Troubles of Education:

I Maccabees 1:41-42 - Moreover king Antiochus wrote to his whole kingdom, that all should be one people, 42 And every one should leave his laws: so all the heathen agreed according to the commandment of the king. 48-50 That they should also leave their children uncircumcised, and make their souls abominable with all manner of uncleanness and profanation: 49 To the end they might forget the law, and change all the ordinances. 50 And whosoever would not do according to the commandment of the king, he said, he should die 57-58 And whosoever was found with any the book of the testament, or if any committed to the law, the king's commandment was, that they should put him to death. 58 Thus did they by their authority unto the Israelites every month, to as many as were found in the cities. 61-63 And they hanged the infants about their necks, and rifled their houses, and slew them that had circumcised them. 62 Howbeit many in Israel were fully resolved and confirmed in themselves not to eat any unclean thing. 63 Wherefore the rather to die, that they might not be defiled with meats, and that they might not profane the holy covenant: so then they died.

2 Maccabees 7:1, 27- It came to pass also, that seven brethren with their mother were taken, and compelled by the king against the law to taste swine's flesh, and were tormented with scourges and whips. 27 But she bowing herself toward him, laughing the cruel tyrant to scorn, spake in her country language on this manner; O my son, have pity upon me that bare thee nine months in my womb, and gave thee such three years, and nourished thee, and brought thee up unto this age, and endured the troubles of education.

Effective Learning Techniques: 1-Elaborative Interrogation 2-Self Explanation 3-Summarization 4-Highlighting 5-Keyword memorization 6-Imagery 7-Re-reading Interleaved 9-Distributed

-Lower Learning Performance: Sensing, reflective, and global. Higher Learning Performance: Visual, reflective, intuitive.

Strategies To Improve Learning: Retrieval, Rule Learning, Engagement, and Feedback

Video: Pomodoro Technique <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mNBmG24djoY> Theory whereby a task is broken down into smaller segments of time. Be aware to avoid distractions and modifications can be made. This is a productivity technique.

Using games increases learning.

### **Sister Bella House of Chanoch:** Home Schooling Your Children

Home schooled Statistics: Statistics show that testing for homeschooled students is higher than that of public schooled students.

\*Introduce a new "word of the day" to your students to increase and expand their vocabulary, (Example: coeval).

\*Set a purpose for HomeSchooling. Your first year will probably be the hardest. Make sure your children are academically competitive with other children.

\*When homeschooling your children, it is OK that you don't know everything.

\*Be mindful of Home School Laws in your respective states. (Personal school day for her house is Monday - Thursday, 3 hours a day.)

\*Focus on one child at a time when teaching multiple children.

\*Dress for the school day to show a difference between "Mom" and "Teacher".

\*Look for "benchmarks", but know that the children may exceed those marks.

B - Beware -

C - Cut and Cleave - Cut them off. You shouldn't stay connected to someone who hates God.
