“S.M.S. - Slick Mouth Sisters”

- ECCL. 3:1, 7-8 there is a season to everything..a time to keep silence and a time to speak
- JAMES 1:26 if any man seem religious but bridleth not his tongue, he deceives his own heart and his religion is in vain

The 10 Deadly Attributes of a S.M.S.

1. She is very proud and doesn't know when to shut up. Strong and wrong in her delivery.

- PROV. 9:13 a foolish woman is clamorous, simple and knows nothing.

*Clamorous: vigorous in demands or complaints.

*Clamour: a loud uproar as from a crowd of people. Vehement expression of desire or dissatisfaction.

- ISAIAH 3:12,16-17 women rule over the people and lead them to destruction. The daughters of Zion are haughty, walk with stretched forth necks and wanton eyes..so the Lord smote the crown of their head with a scab
- PROV. 10:18-21 he that hides hatred with lying lips and he that utters a slander, is a fool (not forthcoming about the issues she's dealing with, gossips about other people..). In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin. (As you add to your words you tend to say something wicked in the process. Even if there may be some validity to what you are saying, it will get lost in the multitude of words. Get to the point.) He that refrains his lips is wise. The tongue of the just is as choice silver but the heart of the wicked is little worth. The lips of the righteous feed many, but fools die for want of wisdom.
- PROV. 17:28 even a fool when he holds his peace is counted wise, and he that shuts his lips is esteemed a man of understanding (If your works speak for themselves, you don't need to talk much.)

2. Very emboldened and doesn't know her place. Known to get out of pocket. Forgets that she is in subjection to the man.

- SIRACH 26:14-15 a silent and loving woman is a gift of the Lord, and there is nothing so much worth as a mind well instructed. A shamefaced and faithful woman is a double grace and her continent mind cannot be valued. (Disagreements and different situations come up and if you are in the right, just stay humble.) (A shamefaced and faithful woman supports her husband no matter what.) As the sun when it arises, so is the beauty of a

good wife in the ordering of her house. (A big part of maintaining your house is keeping the peace and a tranquil environment.)

- SIRACH 32:8 let thy speech be short comprehending much in few words. Be as one that knows and yet holds his tongue.
- REV. 2:18-23 the church in Thyatira was full of women with the Jezebel spirit, which calleth herself a prophetess to teach and seduce the servants to commit fornication and eat things sacrificed to idols. She was given a chance to repent but did not..she will be cast her and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation and her kill her children.

3. Very contentious, always in an argument. Picks fights about petty things. Uses her tongue as a weapon against her adversary, which is oftentimes her husband. Nagging, bitter, highly insecure, and never happy.

- PROV. 27:15 a continual dropping on a very rainy day and a contentious woman are alike..she cannot be hidden. (Will embarrass her husband.)
- SIRACH 10:6 bear not hatred to thy neighbor for every wrong, and do nothing at all by injurious practices.
- MATT. 18:15 how to handle certain offenses (The trespass is referring to sin, you need to have a scripture for your complaint. Not every situation is a Matthew 18 moment. This process can potentially end in someone being kicked out of the body, so be sure that it is really needed to go through..)
- SIRACH 28:7 remember the commandments and bear no malice to thy neighbor, wink at ignorance
- JAMES 3:1-8 be not many masters knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation (Be very careful with everything you say and do when you are under a microscope due to your position.) In many things we offend all, if any man offend not in word, he is perfect.. (We all offend to some degree and are not perfect yet.) We put bits in the horse's mouth to turn their whole body. (The mouth is powerful.)The same way, the tongue is a little member but boasts great things..defiles the whole body. The tongue cannot be tamed, it is an unruly evil.
- SIRACH 28:14,18-19 many have fallen by the edge of the sword, but not so many as have fallen by the tongue. Well is he that is defend from it and hath not passed through the venom thereof. A backbiting tongue disquiets many..deprived virtuous women of their labors (Too busy talking, not enough working.)
- JUDE vs 16 these are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts and their mouth speaks great swelling words, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage
- PROV. 26:17-18 he that meddles with strife that doesn't belong to him, is like one that takes a dog by the ears. As a mad man that casts arrows and firebrands etc, deceives his neighbor and says "Am not I in sport?" (Taking jabs, insulting people and then trying to cover it up as if you were joking.

4. Good at causing drama but doesn't realize she is at the root of it.

- PROV. 21:23-24 whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue, keepeth his soul from trouble. Proud and haughty scorner is his name who deals with in proud wrath.
- SIRACH 28:12 if you blow the spark it will burn, if you spit on it it shall be quenched; both come out of thy mouth. (You have the power to exacerbate the situation or shut it down. You may not have started the issue but you may say something to make it worse, or you can react in a way that ends it.)
- PROV. 15:1 a soft answer turns away wrath, but grievous words stir up strife
- PROV. 17:9-10 he that covers a transgression seeks love. (Just move on and keep the peace. Don't hold every little thing against that person.) But he that repeats a matter separates friends. (Don't keep bringing it up, get over it!) A reproof enters more into a wise man than a hundred stripes into a fool.
- EXODUS 14:8-14 the Lord hardened Pharaoh's heart and he pursued the children of Israel and they complained to Moses "Has thou taken us out to die in the wilderness?" (Despite seeing the wonderful manner in which the Lord delivered us out of Egypt, we still complained.)..The Lord shall fight for you and you shall keep your peace.

5. Extremely emotional and has zero self-control.

- PROV. 25:28 he that hath no rule over his own spirit is like a city broken down with no walls (We have to have a level of self-control especially when it comes to our emotions.)
