2 Thessalonians 3:11 We should be well doing. Use social media for the truth. Don't be a busy body.

Exodus 23:2 You still can respond right. Don't follow others to do evil. Don't let others behavior take away from your godliness.

Mark 13:11 Speak the truth. Sometimes you may be better off not saying anything. Walk away, be at peace stay in your lane. Be quiet sometimes it's for your best interest. No response is a response. See Satan when he comes. Gain the discernment. Your speech is good if you spoke thus saith the Lord.

Be Quiet ... Don't Respond

"Being quiet is a response in itself".

Proverbs 17:19-20 If you like to go back and forth with others, you're in sin, you're are seeking destruction. (Be Quiet)

Don't exalt yourself trying to be holier than thou... build a name for yourself.

Don't speak the things that don't concern you.

Romans 12:18 Be at peace with one another. People should expect peace from you.

The forms of silence:

Masking: Not telling the whole truth or what you feel. You must avoid masking and sugar coating what you feel. We talk but not addressing the issue. Avoiding conversations.

Awkward silence: A withdrawing conversation or exiting room or. Empty space no conclusion no closure.

Mindful silence: Reflect on what you're going to say.

Matthew 9:4 Don't think evil in your heart. TMH already knows what's in your heart. Your thoughts turn into action. Change your thinking process.

1 Corinthians 14:35 Learn from your lord.

Be okay with not being liked. Everyone is not going to like you. Love and like yourself that's important. Watch your actions for the old woman will creep up.
