Question:

Life will be different...are you ready...are you prepared?

Define: Winter - The coldest season, suitable for storage

2 Timothy 4: 21 (KJV) Do thy diligence to come before winter. Eubulus greeteth thee, and Pudens, and Linus, and Claudia, and all the brethren.

- Winter is brutal

Mark 13:18 (KJV) And pray ye that your flight be not in the winter.

- Christ warned us that we should pray and be prepared for flight in the winter.
- Snow is a metaphor for sure, as well as a blanket. It is light waiting for Springtime.
- The Most High makes all seasons

Psalms 14:7 (KJV) Oh that the salvation of Israel *were come* out of Zion! when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, *and* Israel shall be glad.

- We must make plans, grow plants, grow food to survive.

- As plants we must make sure our roots are covered and planted firmly just as our fore parents did in history.
- Make sure we are well- stocked for the winter.
- We can appreciate other seasons when we deal with winter.
- The Most High wants us to prepare for winter.

Psalms 147:16-17 (KJV)

Vs 16 He giveth snow like wool: he scattereth the hoarfrost like ashes.

Vs 17 He casteth forth his ice like morsels: who can stand before his cold?

- Cold can also be a metaphor as in action.

Exodus 16:14-15 (KJV)

VS 14 And when the dew that lay was gone up, behold, upon the face of the wilderness *there lay* a small round thing, *assmall* as the hoar frost on the ground.

VS 15 And when the children of Israel saw *it*, they said one to another, It *is* manna: for they wist not what it was. And Moses said unto them, This *is* the bread which the LORD hath given you to eat.

- Just as the Most High gave us mana, be prepared for that as we prepare for the winter.
- The mana was like frost, like dew on the grass and on the trees.
- The Game of Thrones, it is a good spiritual likeness of being prepared in winter.
- Boreas =Northwind and devouring one - he was the winter solace god in Game of Thrones
- Our foremothers had many trials that changed their lives in the winter.
- We know that there will be a bigger strain of covid-19 to come and we must be prepared.

Key Points regarding the New Normal

- 1. Right now we are at the point where the Heavenly Father is warning us to be prepared for the tribulation and things to come***
- 2. Life will be different based upon the Covid-19 but will be prepared for the winter and what the new normal is going to be?***

Genesis 6:7, 12-13 (KJV)

vs 7 And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.

vs 12 And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.

vs 13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is

filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

- Things are normal then suddenly Noah gets this message from the Most High and finds out that things are going to be completed different

Genesis 8:14-19 (KJV)

Vs 14 And in the second month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month, was the earth dried.

Vs 15 And God spake unto Noah, saying,

Vs 16 Go forth of the ark, thou, and thy wife, and thy sons, and thy sons' wives with thee.

Vs 17 Bring forth with thee every living thing that is with thee, of all flesh, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth; that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply upon the earth.

Vs 18 And Noah went forth, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him:

Vs 19 Every beast, every creeping thing, and every fowl, and whatsoever creepeth upon the earth, after their kinds, went forth out of the ark.

Genesis 6:12-13 (KJV)

Vs 12 And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.

Vs 13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

- Life was not the same after coming out of the ark, put yourselves in the position of our foremothers. Try to imagine everyone was gone after the flood. Their lives were different, their lives changed forever, this was their new normal.

Ask yourself:

What will our lives be like, what will be different and what will be our new normal when our Black Christ returns?

Genesis 8:19-22 (KJV)

Vs 19 Every beast, every creeping thing, and every fowl, *and* whatsoever creepeth upon the earth, after their kinds, went forth out of the ark.

Vs 20 And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

Vs 21 And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart *is* evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more everything living, as I have done.

Vs 22 While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.

Genesis 9:1-3 (KJV)

Vs 1 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth.

Vs 2 And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moveth *upon* the earth, and upon all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered.

Vs 3 Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.

- Put yourselves into a frame of mind as our foremothers did to help in your households.

Genesis 19:4-8 (KJV)

Vs 4 But before they lay down, the men of the city, *even* the men of Sodom, compassed the house round, both old and young, all the people from every quarter:

Vs 5 And they called unto Lot, and said unto him, Where *are* the men which came in to thee this night? bring them out unto us, that we may know them.

Vs 6 And Lot went out at the door unto them, and shut the door after him,

Vs 7 And said, I pray you, brethren, do not so wickedly.

Vs 8 Behold now, I have two daughters which have not known man; let me, I pray you, bring them out unto you, and do ye to them as *is* good in your eyes: only unto these men do nothing; for therefore came they under the shadow of my roof.

- Our lives will be different when the missiles hit. Life is going to be different, but we must be prepared spiritually.
- Are you spiritually prepared?
- Will you be ready when winter comes for us?
- Our new normal can come in the twinkling of an eye
- Are you willing to make the changes needed so that we can be carried away in the chariots?
- You have to be prepared for whatever your winter is...

Genesis 19:9-11 (KJV)

Vs 9 And they said, Stand back. And they said *again*, This one *fellow* came in to sojourn, and he will needs be a judge: now will we deal worse with thee, than with them. And they pressed sore upon the man, *even* Lot, and came near to break the door.

Vs 10 But the men put forth their hand, and pulled Lot into the house to them, and shut to the door.

Vs 11 And they smote the men that *were* at the door of the house with blindness, both small and great: so that they wearied themselves to find the door.

- Put yourself in this story...The Most High smote all of them with blindness

Genesis 19:12-14 (KJV)

Vs 12 And the men said unto Lot, Hast thou here any besides? son in law, and thy sons, and thy daughters, and whatsoever thou hast in the city, bring *them* out of this place:

Vs 13 For we will destroy this place, because the cry of them is waxen great before the face of the LORD; and the LORD hath sent us to destroy it.

Vs 14 And Lot went out, and spake unto his sons in law, which married his daughters, and said, Up, get you out of this place; for the LORD will destroy this city. But he seemed as one that mocked unto his sons in law.

- It's like someone's coming to your house and banging on the door telling you your house is on fire and then you choose to not listen.
- The Most High gave a warning, but they did not listen
- Life will be different

Ask yourself:

Are you going to panic?

Are you ready to make the next move?

Are you going to be ready when the winter comes for you?

Genesis 19:15-16 (KJV)

Vs 15 And when the morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the iniquity of the city.

Vs 16 And while he lingered, the men laid hold upon his hand, and upon the hand of his wife, and upon the hand of his two daughters; the LORD being merciful unto him: and they brought him forth, and set him without the city.

- We must be prepared so we can be carried away with the chariots

Genesis 19:17-19 (KJV)

Vs 17 And it came to pass, when they had brought them forth abroad, that he said, Escape for thy life; look not behind thee, neither stay thou in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed.

Vs 18 And Lot said unto them, Oh, not so, my Lord:

Vs 19 Behold now, thy servant hath found grace in thy sight, and thou hast magnified thy mercy, which thou hast shewed unto me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die:

Genesis 19:24-26 (KJV)

Vs 24 Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven;

Vs 25 And he overthrew those cities, and all the plain, and all the inhabitants of the cities, and that which grew upon the ground.

Vs 26 But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.

- We must transform into a pillar of righteousness for our families
- She obviously had lots of things that she was leaving behind and so she looked back.
- If she was prepared she wouldn't have looked back
- Life was going to be different and she was not prepared

“We know that when fear takes over, we forget our responsibility and often our Faith in TMH. Look towards the Heavenly Father for guidance and strength in all things, through all situations.”

1 Maccabees 2:1-6 (KJV)

Vs 1 In those days arose Mattathias the son of John, the son of Simeon, a priest of the sons of Joarib, from Jerusalem, and dwelt in Modin.

Vs 2 And he had five sons, Joannan, called Caddis:

Vs 3 Simon; called Thassi:

Vs 4 Judas, who was called Maccabeus:

Vs 5 Eleazar, called Avaran: and Jonathan, whose surname was Apphus.

Vs 6 And when he saw the blasphemies that were committed in Juda and Jerusalem,

- Our forefather is explaining the conditions around him and he's upset about it He has zeal along with his sons and their wives had to have much zeal in order to encourage them

1 Maccabees 2:19-30 (KJV)

Vs 19 Then Mattathias answered and spake with a loud voice, Though all the nations that are under the king's dominion obey him, and fall away every one from the religion of their fathers, and give consent to his commandments:

Vs 20 Yet will I and my sons and my brethren walk in the covenant of our fathers.

Vs 21 God forbid that we should forsake the law and the ordinances.

Vs 22 We will not hearken to the king's words, to go from our religion, either on the right hand, or the left.

Vs 23 Now when he had left speaking these words, there came one of the Jews in the sight of all to sacrifice on the altar which was at Modin, according to the king's commandment.

Vs 24 Which thing when Mattathias saw, he was inflamed with zeal, and his reins trembled, neither could he forbear to shew his anger according to judgment: wherefore he ran, and slew him upon the altar.

Vs 25 Also the king's commissioner, who compelled men to sacrifice, he killed at that time, and the altar he pulled down.

Vs 26 Thus dealt he zealously for the law of God like as Phinees did unto Zambri the son of Salom.

Vs 27 And Mattathias cried throughout the city with a loud voice, saying, Whosoever is zealous of the law, and maintaineth the covenant, let him follow me.

Vs 28 So he and his sons fled into the mountains, and left all that ever they had in the city.

Vs 29 Then many that sought after justice and judgment went down into the wilderness, to dwell there:

Vs 30 Both they, and their children, and their wives; and their cattle; because afflictions increased sore upon them.

- This is the scripture that describes our men and what they stand for today. In the time of the Maccabees they were not going to listen to the king and eat swine, but instead chose to stand for God at any cost. Forefather Matthias had a passion and zeal that we must use as an example and doing what God always wants. Are we ready for that?
- We as Israelite women must do as our Lords say. So, we must always be prepared for anything they may say to do. When we get married, we have a new life. Our lives will not be the same. When we are new in the truth or lives will not be the same. What will be our new normal? The winter is coming, are you ready? In this time of the Maccabees they had to flee into the mountains. Just

imagine having to pick up and just go without warning. We must be prepared for just such a thing at any time. The winter is coming, are you ready?

Matthew 24:20 (KJV) But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:

- 70ad was the fall of Jerusalem – the Romans cut off our food and water.
- Just imagine we were in the middle of cannibalism eating our babies because of the siege during this time

Luke 21:5-6 (KJV)

Vs 5 And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, he said,

Vs 6 *s for* these things which ye behold, the days will come, in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.

Luke 21:24 (KJV) And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled.

- In this scripture we learned while the Maccabees were in the mountains the evil came for them.

Luke 23:27-30 (KJV)

Vs 27 And there followed him a great company of people, and of women, which also bewailed and lamented him.

Vs 28 But Jesus turning unto them said, Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for me, but weep for yourselves, and for your children.

Vs 29 For, behold, the days are coming, in the which they shall say, Blessed *are* the barren, and the wombs that never bare, and the paps which never gave suck.

Vs 30 Then shall they begin to say to the mountains, Fall on us; and to the hills, Cover us.

Because times really getting bad..
Christ saying don't feel bad for me I feel bad for yourselves

Deuteronomy 28:53-54; 57 (KJV)

Vs 53 And thou shalt eat the fruit of thine own body, the flesh of thy sons and of thy daughters, which the LORD thy God hath given thee, in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee:

Vs 54 *So that* the man *that is* tender among you, and very delicate, his eye shall be evil toward his brother, and toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the remnant of his children which he shall leave:

Vs 57 And toward her young one that cometh out from between her feet, and toward her children which she shall bear: for she shall eat them for want of all *things* secretly in the siege and straitness, wherewith thine enemy shall distress thee in thy gates.

- We must take heed to what our forefathers and foremothers went through and use it as a guide to be prepared for our winter...whatever it is.
- We must understand we will have a new normal.
- They had to accept their new normal even though it was painful

Ex. Keep up with your Health, discipline your children correctly >>> work on these things

2 Kings 6:24-30 (KJV)

Vs 24 And it came to pass after this, that Benhadad king of Syria gathered all his host, and went up, and besieged Samaria.

Vs 25 And there was a great famine in Samaria: and, behold, they besieged it, until an ass's head was *sold* for fourscore *pieces* of silver, and the fourth part of a cab of dove's dung for five *pieces* of silver.

Vs 26 And as the king of Israel was passing by upon the wall, there cried a woman unto him, saying, Help, my lord, O king.

Vs 27 And he said, If the LORD do not help thee, whence shall I help thee? out of the barnfloor, or out of the winepress?

Vs 28 And the king said unto her, What aileth thee? And she answered, This woman said unto me, Give thy son, that we may eat him to day, and we will eat my son to morrow.

Vs 29 So we boiled my son, and did eat him: and I said unto her on the next day, Give thy son, that we may eat him: and she hath hid her son.

Vs 30 And it came to pass, when the king heard the words of the woman, that he rent his clothes; and he passed by upon the wall, and the people looked, and, behold, *he* *hadsackcloth* within upon his flesh.

- Are we spiritually ready for some of the trials our people had to adjust to?
- Just like the story of the Maccabees, are we prepared?
- The Lord is warning us winter is coming.
- It is the woman's responsibility to buy food and keep her family and herself in good health.
- We must be able to nurture good health for ourselves and our families.

Ecclesiastes 1:9-11 (KJV)

Vs 9 The thing that hath been, it *is that* which shall be; and that which is done *is* that which shall be done: and *there is* no new *thing* under the sun.

Vs 10 Is there *any* thing whereof it may be said, See, this *is* new? it hath been already of old time, which was before us.

Vs 11 *There is* no remembrance of former *things*; neither shall there be *any* remembrance of *things* that are to come with *those* that shall come after.

- These scriptures tell us there is nothing new under the sun.
- We know that we have been here before and what was written aforetime was written for our learning.
- We are blessed that we cannot remember what we went through back then.

Genesis 49:19 (KJV) Gad, a troop shall overcome him: but he shall overcome at the last.

Sirach 12:10-18

Vs 10 Never trust thine enemy: for like as iron rusteth, so is his wickedness.

Vs 11 Though he humble himself, and go crouching, yet take good heed and beware of him, and thou shalt be unto him as if thou hadst wiped a lookingglass, and thou shalt know that his rust hath not been altogether wiped away.

Vs 12 Set him not by thee, lest, when he hath overthrown thee, he stand up in thy place; neither let him sit at thy right hand, lest he seek to take thy seat, and thou at the last remember my words, and be pricked therewith.

Vs 13 Who will pity a charmer that is bitten with a serpent, or any such as come nigh wild beasts?

Vs 14 So one that goeth to a sinner, and is defiled with him in his sins, who will pity?

Vs 15 For a while he will abide with thee, but if thou begin to fall, he will not tarry.

Vs 16 An enemy speaketh sweetly with his lips, but in his heart he imagineth how to throw thee into a pit: he will weep with his eyes, but if he find opportunity, he will not be satisfied with blood.

Vs 17 If adversity come upon thee, thou shalt find him there first; and though he pretend to help thee, yet shall he undermine thee.

Vs 18 He will shake his head, and clap his hands, and whisper much, and change his

2 Peter 1:10-12 (KJV)

Vs 10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:

Vs 11 For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Vs 12 Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know *them*, and be established in the present truth.

- We are no strangers to hardship, Black Lives before the crash>> before the market crash.
- We are living the curses
- We are naturally good at gardening and planting and we have moved far from it

Deuteronomy 28:15-18 (KJV)

Vs 15 But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

Vs 16 Cursed *shalt* thou *be* in the city, and cursed *shalt* thou *be* in the field.

Vs 17 Cursed *shall be* thy basket and thy store.

Vs 18 Cursed *shall be* the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy land, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep.

Vs 19 Cursed *shalt* thou *be* when thou comest in, and cursed *shalt* thou *be* when thou goest out.

Vs 20 The LORD shall send upon thee cursing, vexation, and rebuke, in all that thou settest thine hand unto for to do, until thou be destroyed, and until thou perish quickly; because of the wickedness of thy doings, whereby thou hast forsaken me.

Vs 21 The LORD shall make the pestilence cleave unto thee, until he have consumed thee from off the land, whither thou goest to possess it.

Vs 22 The LORD shall smite thee with a consumption, and with a fever, and with an inflammation, and with an extreme burning, and with the sword, and with blasting, and with mildew; and they shall pursue thee until thou perish.

Vs 23 And thy heaven that *is* over thy head shall be brass, and the earth that is under thee *shall be* iron.

Vs 24 The LORD shall make the rain of thy land powder and dust: from heaven shall it come down upon thee, until thou be destroyed.

Vs 25 The LORD shall cause thee to be smitten before thine enemies: thou shalt go out one way against them, and flee seven ways before them: and shalt be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth.

Vs 26 And thy carcase shall be meat unto all fowls of the air, and unto the beasts of the earth, and no man shall fray *them* away.

Vs 27 The LORD will smite thee with the botch of Egypt, and with the emerods, and with the scab, and with the itch, whereof thou canst not be healed.

Vs 28 The LORD shall smite thee with madness, and blindness, and astonishment of heart:

Vs 29 And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save *thee*.

- We went through it and we still going through it
- Tells us we will be cursed in the field which is a consequence for being disobedient to the Highest.
- Getting back to homeschooling is for admin of it is for our benefit
- The wife is the keeper of the home we must be able to teach our children

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 (KJV)

vs 4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

vs 5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

- Our power comes from God
- Our superpowers from the Commandments/the Laws of God
- Make sure you are able to support your lord
- Be sure to keep up your skill set in order to help maintain home

Jeremiah 31:22 (KJV)

How long wilt thou go about, O thou backsliding daughter? for the LORD hath created a new thing in the earth, A woman shall compass a man.

- Women have always been used to filter the work force it's always been easier in the workforce because of the curses but we must use this to be a helpmate to our lord
- Our men are perceived as threats and as nothing
- We must ask ourselves why are our men being treated the way they are? We know that the Bible tells us they are made in His image and this is a threat to all other nations.

Psalms 37:32-37 (KJV)

Vs 32 The wicked watcheth the righteous, and seeketh to slay him.

Vs 33 The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged.

Vs 34 Wait on the LORD, and keep his way, and he shall exalt thee to inherit the land: when the wicked are cut off, thou shalt see *it*.

Vs 35 I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a green bay tree.

Vs 36 Yet he passed away, and, lo, he was not: yea, I sought him, but he could not be found.

Vs 37 Mark the perfect *man*, and behold the upright: for the end of *that man is* peace.

- Be prepared, winter is coming. People of color should start the black businesses movement again; we must support each other and be privy to what it is we need to do.

2 Corinthians 9:8-12 (KJV)

Vs 8 And God *is* able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may abound to every good work:

Vs 9 As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever.

Vs 10 Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for *your* food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;

Vs 11 Being enriched in every thing to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God.

Vs 12 For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God;

- We are working for what we need and want not only for ourselves before brothers and sisters.
- Unity is key.

1 Thessalonians 4:11-12 (KJV)

Vs 11 And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;

Vs 12 That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and *that* ye may have lack of nothing.

- Be about your own business along with the Lord's business
- We cannot take the threats upon her people or against our nation as jokes, they are not joking.
- We must remember that Esau's system has never worked in our favor
- We need to understand that Esau always underestimates the numbers of those of us that have died

Question: Are you prepared?

Ezekiel 35:5 (KJV) Because thou hast had a perpetual hatred, and hast shed *the blood* of the children of Israel by the force of the sword in the time of their calamity, in the time *that their* iniquity *had* an end:

- There is an ongoing a perpetual hatred for our people. This is something that the Bible tells us will not change
- They were fearful and threatened by what organized black men can do

- We have been under the quarantine of coronavirus for the past almost 4 months. Things have been shut down, rearranged and some things just out right over with. Yet our people, particularly our men are being gunned down, shot and killed in the middle of a pandemic.
- When we think of Rosewood 1928 our people had to flee.
- We should not keep our history in the Bible hidden.

Habakkuk 2:4 (KJV) Behold, his soul *which* is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

Deuteronomy 28:49-51 (KJV)

vs 49 The LORD shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, as *swift* as the eagle flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand;

vs 50 A nation of fierce countenance, which shall not regard the person of the old, nor shew favour to the young:

vs 51 And he shall eat the fruit of thy cattle, and the fruit of thy land, until thou be destroyed: which *also* shall not leave thee *either* corn, wine, or oil, *or* the increase of thy kine, or flocks of thy sheep, until he have destroyed thee.

Example: They took everything in Tulsa, burned homes, murdered Doctors and Lawyers, etc. All of this was done because of jealousy and hatred

Isaiah 32:9 (KJV) Rise up, ye women that are at ease; hear my voice, ye careless daughters; give ear unto my speech.

- We must rise up spiritually Israel, pay attention, the Most High is warning us.
- We must be prepared, no more sleeping pay attention the Lord is warning us to rise up and come out asleep
- **Proverbs 22:16 (KJV)** He that oppreseth the poor to increase his *riches*, and he that giveth to the rich, *shall* surely *come* to want.
- We should Eliminate as much debt as we can
- Borrowing and paying with interest keeping us in the cycle but we must keep everything in balance within our homes

Proverbs 22:7 (KJV) The rich ruleth over the poor, and the borrower *is* servant to the lender.

- We must support our own businesses.

- We must create our own businesses so that we can support our own businesses, our own people.
- What was old is new, history will repeat itself.
- We must always keep the Commandments of God and know that God supplies all our needs.

Philippians 4:19 (KJV) But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

- We must make sure we know how to budget.
- We should have a regular budget for everyday needs, along with an emergency budget.

Psalms 37:25 (KJV) I have been young, and *now* am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

- Keeping His commandments we will be able to look out for one another making sure we have food, clothing, and shelter
- The keeping of the Commandments are going to come first in foremost
- Things are uncertain but we must prepare

Proverbs 30:7-9 (KJV)

vs 7 Two *things* have I required of thee; deny me *them* not before I die:

vs 8 Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me:

vs 9 Lest I be full, and deny *thee*, and say, Who *is* the LORD? or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God *in vain*.

- It is very important for us to remember during depression we did more with less and this is what we must do again.

Remember: In your prayers to the Most High ask him for just enough and be grateful as it states in the word "the Lord do not make me poor and do not make me rich but just give enough for me to sustain"

Proverbs 24:3 (KJV) Through wisdom is an house builded; and by understanding it is established:

- We must build upon the Scriptures it is the only way we can build with a positive outcome
- Everything during the great depression is seemingly repeating itself.
- We must remain spiritually sound enough to handle it.

Proverbs 21:1-3 (KJV)

Vs 1 The king's heart *is* in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.

Vs 2 Every way of a man *is* right in his own eyes: but the LORD pondereth the hearts.

Vs 3 To do justice and judgment *is* more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.

- It is not an Israel custom to vote. This will not help us in anyway.

Sirach 29:21 The chief thing for life is water, and bread, and clothing, and an house to cover shame.

- We must remember the scripture "chief things in life" you must know the difference between what we need and what we want.
- Everything that's going on is spiritual

The Other Nations Prey On Us...

Support black businesses we have to be able to support our own

Get your nails done by your sisters

The other nations don't like it when we don't support them

Don't buy where you can't sit down to eat

We must support our own nation as Christ returns

Our people must repent and return back to God

We are being used as an example for the others along their journey

We cannot be slack in terms of responsibilities

We are spoiled with the foods ready at hand many of us don't know what it is to pick a vegetable

When things start crashing down will you be prepared?

Matthew 11:12-14 (KJV)

Vs 12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

Vs 13 For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John.

Vs 14 And if ye will receive *it*, this is Elias, which was for to come.

There's something called Emit Lynching Memorial in Alabama. The Emmitt Teal Lynching became a law on 2/26/2020! 120 years after the killing of Emmitt Teal. This is 120 years later after the lynching and after 200 attempts to make lynching illegal!! 200 attempts!! Let that sink in! This is just further examples of why we need our own areas,

our own businesses and we must support black businesses only. All other nations do it and we have to do it as well.

Hosea 5:15 (KJV) I will go *and* return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.

- We must be spiritually and physically ready for the winter. There is hope in the Scriptures.

Acts 4:34 (KJV) Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,

- We must make sure our children are healthy and build up their immune system.
- We must use our resources and plan accordingly the winter is coming.

Jeremiah 29:5 (KJV) Build ye houses, and dwell *in them*; and plant gardens, and eat the fruit of them;

- We must make use of healthcare, dental care and other resources that we have available.
- You are the keeper of the home it is our responsibility to make sure everyone is taken care of. Avoid missing any Medical/Dental appointments

Jeremiah 8:15;22 (KJV)

Vs 15 We looked for peace, but no good *came*; *and* for a time of health, and behold trouble!

Vs 22 *Is there* no balm in Gilead; *is there* no physician there? why then is not the health of the daughter of my people recovered?

James 5:13-15 (KJV)

Vs 13 Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms.

Vs 14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

Vs 15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Psalms 21:9-11 (KJV)

Vs 9 Thou shalt make them as a fiery oven in the time of thine anger: the LORD shall swallow them up in his wrath, and the fire shall devour them.

Vs 10 Their fruit shalt thou destroy from the earth, and their seed from among the children of men.

Vs 11 For they intended evil against thee: they imagined a mischievous device, *which* they are not able *to perform*.

- If we become ill or sick, we should call leadership immediately. We should also reach out to leadership and the elders for prayer.

Habakkuk 3:14 (KJV) Thou didst strike through with his staves the head of his villages: they came out as a whirlwind to scatter me: their rejoicing was as to devour the poor secretly.

- We must stay healthy Israel because if we have any way to survive, we must listen to the Most High, through the Prophets and leaders and follow the Commandments. If we must take vaccines, we can overcome them, if they are meant to harm (and we know they are) because our immune system's will be built up and strong. All praises to the Most High.

Matthew 22:36-40 (KJV)

Vs 36 Master, which *is* the great commandment in the law?

Vs 37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

Vs 38 This is the first and great commandment.

Vs 39 And the second *is* like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

Vs 40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

Matthew 25:40 (KJV) And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done *it* unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done *it* unto me.

- We must be prepared for many people to start repenting and coming back to Gods Laws, Statutes and Commandments.
- Our people will heed the warnings of TMH.

Proverbs 19:17 (KJV) He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD; and that which he hath given will he pay him again.

- We can never outdo the Lord. When you give to another TMH will bless you and give it back.

Isaiah 65:21-23 (KJV)

Vs 21 And they shall build houses, and inhabit *them*; and they shall plant vineyards, and eat the fruit of them.

Vs 22 They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree *are* the days of my people, and mine elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands.

Vs 23 They shall not labour in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they *are* the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their offspring with them.

Amos 9:14 (KJV) And I will bring again the captivity of my people of Israel, and they shall build the waste cities, and inhabit *them*; and they shall plant vineyards, and drink the wine thereof; they shall also make gardens, and eat the fruit of them.

2 Peter 3:1-2 (KJV)

Vs 1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *both* which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance:

Vs 2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,

- The winter is coming will you be prepared?
- Things will be different yet the same.
- We must remember to depend on one another as TMH commands and He will help us and fight for us.

Philippians 2:12 (KJV) Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

Hebrews 12:1-3 (KJV)

Vs 1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset *us*, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,

Vs 2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Vs 3 For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

2 Peter 3:11-15 (KJV)

Vs 11 *Seeing* then *that* all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of *persons* ought ye to be in *all* holy conversation and godliness,

Vs 12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

Vs 13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

Vs 14 Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.

Vs 15 And account *that* the longsuffering of our Lord *is* salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;

Conclusion:

We must be found by TMH, at the return of our Black Christ, to be without spot, without blemish, and in Unity. Be prepared for winter!!!
