



## MEMORIAL BLOWING OF TRUMPETS ACTIVITY

*The Memorial Blowing of Trumpets is detailed in Leviticus 23:23-25. The shofar is used to bring the people together for a variety of reasons, Numbers 10:1-3. We are to keep this ordinance for the generations to come, Numbers 10:6. This activity will allow the young princes to create a play shofar all of their own!*

### *Here's What You'll Need:*

- 1 cardboard tube – paper towel or toilet tissue sized
- Scissors
- Clear or masking tape
- Paint & a paintbrush or Markers

### Here's What to Do:

1. Cut the tube from the bottom to the top. This will be lengthwise.
2. Wrap the tube into a thin cone shape. Your child should start at the bottom, folding on end of the cut cardboard over the other. The tube will naturally start forming a cone.
3. Tape the bottom of the cardboard shofar. Your child can hold the tube together and you can tape or vice versa.
4. Tape the top of the cone. Also add a strip of tape up the seam if needed.
5. Decorate the outside of the cone using your paint or markers! Encourage the child to let their imagination run wild! It is their shofar so there are no wrong designs. As your child paints, he'll need to hold the cone upright. If not, the paint will rub off on the table or whatever surface he is using. If using markers, you shouldn't have this problem.
6. Let the paint or ink dry completely.
