**Deuteronomy 4-7**

### Forgiveness for Christ Sake

Our walk is about trying to become perfect not better than the next one but trying to be more to be pleasing to TMH. You should be more righteous than your neighbor who is wicked. This walk is about fixing you - you die daily and TMH has it that way because we don't know how to act. We must forgive constantly. The person is showing a different behavior and you're still holding a grudge. You hate that sister or your husband or your children but you're still holding onto what happened in the past but then ask TMH for forgiveness. A sister has apologized to you, but you just can't let it go.

**Colossians 3:12-15** - Put on therefore (as the elect of God, holy and beloved) bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, long suffering,<sup>13</sup> Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. <sup>14</sup> And above all these things put on charities, which is the bond of perfectness. <sup>15</sup> And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body: and be ye thankful.

I hate to watch a parent do something wrong to a child and say I can do that because I'm the mother.

Humble down to your children if you're wrong. If you genuinely messed up humble down and apologize to them. If you are bold enough to talk crazy to your Lord humble down and apologize to him and yes he must forgive you and if he apologizes accept it because we want forgiveness from TMH. Kindness sticks out in these verses. The kindness goes with Ephesians 4:32.

**Ephesians 4:32** <sup>32</sup> And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you



It's not about you not liking how she said something to you. If she did you wrong and never apologize to you - you still must forgive her, TMH is going to see what you're going to do.

Brothers are more straight to the point if a sister did something wrong he will say she has the devil on her, that's it's. TMH can do something to us from our complaining. TMH blesses us but we still complain by upsetting him and he blesses us again and we turn around and upset him and that's how sister's ought to be, forgiving.

We don't know the day when Christ is coming back.

**Matthew 6:14-15** For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: <sup>15</sup> But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

TMH wants us to forgive and humble down.

**Question:** How did they get Christ down from the crossed?

**Answer:** He was nailed with stakes that were at least 18-24 inches. He was stabbed in his side and whipped and spit on, a crown of thorns was put on his head, they pulled his beard out, they gave him vinegar, stripped his clothes off and mocked him.

After all of that he said forgive them father for they know not what they do but they knew what they were doing. Now you're telling me that you can't forgive a sister, you can forgive her you just don't want to forgive her. Then you wonder why you prays just hit the ceiling. If you battle with that lack of forgiveness spirit than ask TMH.

**Sirach 28:2-8** Forgive thy neighbour the hurt that he hath done unto thee, so shall thy sins also be forgiven when thou prayest. <sup>3</sup> One man beareth hatred against another, and doth he seek pardon from the Lord? <sup>4</sup> He sheweth no mercy to a man, which is like himself: and doth he ask forgiveness of his own sins? <sup>5</sup> If he that is but flesh nourish hatred, who will



intreat for pardon of his sins? <sup>6</sup> Remember thy end, and let enmity cease; [remember] corruption and death, and abide in the commandments.

<sup>7</sup> Remember the commandments, and bear no malice to thy neighbour: [remember] the covenant of the Highest, and wink at ignorance.

<sup>8</sup> Abstain from strife, and thou shalt diminish thy sins: for a furious man will kindle strife,

We are commanded to abide in the commandments. Live in the commandments, that's where your success comes from, your spiritual success that's what will get you to the kingdom.

Your mad at your Lord, kids or a sister out of nowhere (your emotions), what will being mad do for you it will fix nothing. We are held at a different standard than the world. Your life is not your own you start saying "I didn't sign up for this" but now you must deal with it because your life is not your own. TMH laughs at us when we think we knew what we want or what will happen to us in life. You think you're only going to have one child, but you don't know because your life is not your own.

In the world we didn't care about the proper ways to dress or when the sun was going down but remember our life is not our own so die daily.

**Question:** Sometimes we still have baggage is it okay if we done something wrong to them and they are not in the truth do we have to confess our faults to them?

**Answer:** If they're open to confessing but it's not mandatory. If you're estranged and you want to ask for forgiveness yes you can but if they are one of those wall people no it's not mandatory by God.

Deuteronomy 4 in this chapter Moses continues to give our history and what will make us stand out from the other nations.

**Deuteronomy 4:21** - <sup>21</sup> Furthermore the LORD was angry with me for your sakes, and sware that I should not go over Jordan, and that I should not go in unto that good land, which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance:



Moses keeps repeating that he was not able to go into the land because of us.

**Deuteronomy 4:6** <sup>6</sup>Keep therefore and do them; for this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.

We were such a wise people that the judicial system is setup from us, it's from the Bible.

**Deuteronomy 4:4** - <sup>4</sup>But ye that did cleave unto the LORD your God are alive every one of you this day

This is according to us today as well, it's two fold about that generation and us to this day.

\*In reference to Forgiveness, think about how TMH is letting us go from Sabbath to Sabbath and live but we're still holding onto a grudge against a sister\*

**Deuteronomy 5:29** - <sup>29</sup>O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my commandments always, that it might be well with them, and with their children for ever!

This is what works well for us, keeping the commandments not marching or protesting but keeping the commandments we must give that a try. The other nations don't march or protest, but the commandments were not given to them, but we have been separated from TMH.

Here we were given the 10 commandments again which we were also given to us in Exodus.

## **Deuteronomy 6**

What works well for us is keeping the commandments. We are commanded to love TMH with everything. Our constant work must be what is pleasing to TMH, that's what our children must see. If you have



a slothful spirit teaching your children you must pray to TMH to take that spirit off you. Your children will ask you something even though your Lord could be sitting right there. Motherhood as an Israelite woman is different. Their father could say one thing and they would straighten up, you probably would also. Frontlets means it is constantly on your mind.

This is going into the blessings and the curses that would happen to us if we did not keep the commandments. We were commanded not to marry the other nations because they will take us from TMH.
