*Survival Tips for Police Encounters**

When you encounter an officer, you are not guaranteed fair treatment. The information is intended to aid you to avoid the T.R.A.P.S.

T **DON'T GET TRICKED:** Officers can legally lie to you to obtain incriminating information. Don't believe the hype!

R **RESPECT:** Listen, control your body language and emotions during your police encounter. Do not have an attitude, resist, run, or argue, even if you believe you are innocent. Don't fight back! Say, "Yes Sir/No Sir" "Yes Ma'am/No Ma'am"

A **FREE ATTORNEY:** (6th Amendment Right) If you are placed under arrest, you are entitled to a free attorney. Ask for one immediately. Say, "I would like to speak to my attorney."

P **DON'T GIVE PERMISSION:** (4th Amendment Right) Officers may ask to search you and/or your belongings without a search warrant. Don't consent to a search of your body, home, or vehicle! Say, "I don't consent to this search."

S **SILENCE IS GOLDEN:** (5th Amendment Right) Officer may ask you questions after reading you your **Miranda Rights**. Don't speak without an attorney present! Say, "I wish to remain silent."
Miranda Rights- "You have the right to remain silent. Anything you say can and will be used against you in a court of law. You have the right to an attorney. If you cannot afford an attorney, one will be provided for you. Do you wish to speak to me"? Say, **NO!!!**

- This is what it means to be holy

Definition of Self-discipline – The ability to control one’s feelings and overcome ones’ weaknesses; the ability to pursue what one thinks is right despite temptations to abandon it.

Having Self-Discipline means:

- Examining yourself,
- Having good self-control,

- Do you want to lose weight?
- What is your “why” is? Knowing this will help you with self-discipline.

A. (Sister Princes Batel -Ohio) – My issues are my facial expressions. Whatever I am thinking is written on my face – unknowingly. Also my emotion.

Mama Shamarah

- A part of getting better is acknowledging the problem.
- Find out what your, “nigga woman triggers” are.
- Find a sister/mentor who does not have that problem and inquire how they are able to control that emotion.
- Part of being a revolutionary woman is being able to maintain your emotions.
- Your feelings do not change the truth
- A fact does not change your opinion

John 17:17 (KJV) Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

- We Sister’s do not like correction
- Correction is a way of making us better and edifying us
- The angry black woman stereotype comes from the things that we (Black, Hispanic, and Native American woman) do stereotypically (ex: sucking our teeth, rolling our eyes, negative body language, closed off, attitudes). Changing these things is apart of the revolutionary process.
- The oppressor hate to see women in order (being respectful, mild mannered, showing respect to the black man)

2 Corinthians 13:5 (KJV) Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

- Reprobate – Void of wisdom
- Lack of self - control = Lack of wisdom
- When we are focused on becoming revolutionary women, the old woman will always try to come out.

- A revolutionary woman always acknowledges her wrongs and works towards fixing it.
- In order for us to really be converted, there must be a spiritual exchange to get those spiritual gifts from The Most High.
- Wisdom will NOT enter into a malicious soul.

Being Covetousness

- Saying thank you and please is a whole new language to the Black, Latin, and Native American woman
- We want others to say them, but do you catch yourself when you do not say things?

Sirach 36:23 (Apocrypha) If there be kindness, meekness, and comfort, in her tongue, then is not her husband like other men.

- Characteristics of a good woman are being kind, meek, edifying and exhorting.
- There will always be something to say, but the revolutionary woman understands that there is a time and a place for everything, and some things are left better unsaid.
- Understanding this will help you be in true submission and this is where your power lies in terms of being in order.

Being Cheerful

Nehemiah 8:10 (KJV) Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for *this day is holy* unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

- No one wants to be around a downtrodden, low self-esteem spirit
- A revolutionary woman is always cheerful
- The scriptures are what bring us joy
- The application of the scriptures heals our wounds

Self-Respect

Q. What does self-respect look like to you ladies

A. Dress code, being shamefaced, not having a big mouth.

Mama Shamarah

Proverbs 31:30-31 (KJV)

Vs 30

Vs 31 Give her of the fruit of her hands; and let her own works praise her in the gates.

- This is more spiritual than physical, but both are especially important.
- A dress code shows as a level of revolutionary

Galatians 6:1-3 (KJV)

Vs 1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

- We must correct ourselves and our sisters when we are in the wrong.
- When we walk out of the of the house, we must represent The Heavenly Father, our lords house, and the Nation of Israel in everything we do. (ex: manner of speech, dress code)

Vs 2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

- This applies to not having the spirit of vainglory
- When you love your nation, you will have self-respect

Vs 3 For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.

- You must prove you own work (ex: being keeper of the house, relationships with other sisters, work you do in the body)
- What are you doing to show people you deserve self-respect?

Intelligence

- Our Foremothers (ex: Queen Esther – Good conversation)
- Good behavior, not idle, satisfied with the chief things in life, not covetous, not envious)
- Be knowledgeable of the things that are going on in the world around you.
- A good woman keeps her house, body etc. clean.
- Do NOT let your house get out of out of order, beyond clean.

1 Corinthians 14:40 (KJV) Let all things be done decently and in order.

- We must do everything in order...EVERYTHING!

Love

1 Corinthian 13:4- (KJV)

Vs 4 Charity suffereth long, *and* is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

Vs 5 Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

Vs 6 Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;

Vs 7 Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.

- This is what charity means. A revolutionary woman must strive to have charity.
- We must apply the scriptures to our daily lives
- We must endure until the end and continue pushing, no matter what trials and tribulations we are facing.
- A revolutionary woman should be focused on uplifting up the Black man, woman, and child.

*Quote: “**Revolution** is a serious thing, the most serious thing about a revolutionary’s life. When one commits oneself to the struggle, it must be for a lifetime. We have to talk about liberating minds as well as liberating society. I’m no longer accepting things I cannot change.” ~Angela Davis~*

- This is spiritual, because we must keep The Heavenly Father’s commandments until death or until Christ comes.
- When you break bread you vowing to stay committed until death or Christ returns.

Examples of Revolutionary Women in the Bible

- Deborah, Jael, Judith, Esther, Mary, Martha

Luke 10:38-42 (KJV)

Vs 38 Now it came to pass, as they went, that he entered into a certain village: and a certain woman named Martha received him into her house.

Vs 39 And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word.

Vs 40 But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me.

Vs 41 And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:

Vs 42 But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

- Mary chose to be at Christ's feet, learning the things needed to get her to the kingdom of heaven
- Revolutionary women in the bible put their lives on the line and they were rolling with Christ and the disciples.
- This walk will NOT be easy, and it will only get worse. For this we must always stay girded up.

Ask Yourself... Are you ready to face the heat? This is what revolutionary women must think about.

2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJV) Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Key Points of Poem

- He changed. We must change along with them
- A Mandela Man. Willie Mandela fought for her husbands release for 3 decades.

- We must understand this truth and the cause. We must stay dedicated. We must be able to see this mission.
- Panther's passion. Fred Hampton was a leader in the Black Panther, his girlfriend was in the bed with him and pregnant when he was assassinated.
- This truth is NOT a joke, it is serious, and we must take it serious by applying God's laws.
- Do you have what it takes to be a revolutionary wife?
- Could you be faithful? His mistress = The Work
- Could you handle the outcome of a Malcolm? He was assassinated and hated by his own people.
- Our lords' number 1 job is working for God. "Would you throw a tantrum and bitch or assist him?"
- Ignore the haters, keep pushing forward and stand on what you believe in.
- How strong is your garden? How strong is your belief in this truth?

1 Peter 3:7 (KJV) Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with *them* according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

- Our goal in the truth is to be heirs together with our lords

Genesis 2:18 (KJV) And the LORD God said, *It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.*

- Always ask yourself, how can you be a great helpmeet to him, how can I help the leadership? What talents do I have that will help the organization?

Sirach 36:24-25 (Apocrypha)

Vs 24 He that getteth a wife beginneth a possession, a help like unto himself, and a pillar of rest.

Vs 25 Where no hedge is, there the possession is spoiled: and he that hath no wife will wander up and down mourning.

Quote: "A revolutionary woman can't have no reactionary man. If he's not about liberation, if he's not about struggle, if he ain't about building a strong Black family, if he ain't about building a strong Black nation, then he ain't about nothing." ~Assata Shakur~

- A revolutionary man cannot have a reactionary woman or a complacent woman in this society.

- A revolutionary woman in this truth must know the Bible.
- She must believe and must be fully rooted in this truth and have strong faith.
- A revolutionary woman must know what her role is in this movement.
- A revolutionary woman must not be fearful according to the scriptures
- The greatest movement outside of when Christ was on the scene is happening, right now!!!

A revolutionary woman must be caught up on current events, unfortunately sometimes there must be death.

Definition of Martyr – A person killed because of their beliefs.

Psalms 116:15 (KJV) Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints.

- Christ was the ultimate martyr because he sacrificed his life for the Children of Israel
- A revolutionary woman will understand that her loved ones will be put to death as well.
- Revolutionary women must recognize who our enemy truly is.
- The revolutionary woman loves her natural features and beauty, she is not afraid to rock her own hair and skin.
- What are you doing with you man to help keep the mission going?

12. Fred Hampton - Was killed at the age of 21 years and left behind his pregnant girlfriend.

13. Medgar Evers – He was killed in his driveway by someone from the KKK in 1963 who admitted and bragged to killing him. He stood for what he believed in and the civil rights movement. His wife was a ride or die, because she made sure that even though two white juries acquitted this man he got arrested and sentenced to life in prison in 1994.

- Part of being a revolutionary wife is being aware of what is going on and making sure that your lord's home is like his sanctuary. So make sure you have his best interest at heart and keep your home safe for him.
- We must be there behind our men and stand down for the cause while understanding that we could be putting our own selves at risk.
- You must use wisdom in all of your endeavors with the enemy (ex: speech, how you raise your children during this climate, the way that you uplift your lord during these times).

- His father Sammy Younge Sr. said, this is an era of social revolution and in such revolutions, individual sacrifice their lives.

- As a revolutionary wife you have to understand that the prophets of God go out everyday to fight on the battlefield.
- All of us have the ability to be a revolutionary wife.
- To become a revolutionary wife you must take on the scriptures and be molded into whatever it is that your lord wants you to be
- Part of the revolutionary struggle is that you will continuously get tried which will in turn mold you into a revolutionary wife/woman
- Your mold will be thus saith the Lord
- Your righteous foremothers as an example

Luke 21:36 (KJV) Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

- We must watch and pray always so that we can have ourselves accounted for so that we are able to escape the things that are to come.
- We are in battle mode and we must be ready at all times

2 Timothy 3:1-5 (KJV)

Vs 1 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

Vs 2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

Vs 3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

Vs 4 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

Vs 5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

- The Heavenly Father is warning us as revolutionary women that these are the things that we must be mindful of each and every day.
- We must examine ourselves to help us stay focused on the mission at hand.

Matthew 24:36-44 (KJV)

Vs 36 But of that day and hour knoweth no *man*, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.

Vs 37 But as the days of Noe *were*, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

Vs 38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying, and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,

Vs 39 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

- This scripture is important because it states, “but as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.” (ex: eating, drinking, clubbing, marrying, etc.)
- Be mindful that there is nothing new underneath the sun, those same people will be “outside of the ark,” you would want to be “spiritually inside the ark.”

Vs 40 Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

Vs 41 *Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left.*

- Our goal should be focused on not getting left here.

Vs 42 Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.

Vs 43 But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up.

Vs 44 Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.

- We as women have an alarm system and that is the Bible. The scriptures are always warning us just in case so that we will be ready.
- We must be aware and always remain watchful and praying of the things taking place before us.

Quotes...

Stokely Carmichael – “I maintain that every civil rights bill in the country was passed for white people, not for black people.”

James Baldwin – “The only thing that white people have and black people need or should want is power and no one holds power forever.”

2 Esdras 6:9 Apocrypha - For Esau is the end of the world, and Jacob is the beginning of it that followeth.

- All we must do is continue to keep the commandments and Esau is going down.
- Part of the revolutionary movement is knowing what the outcome is.

Vs 30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this *is* the first commandment.

Vs 31 And the second *is* like, *namely* this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

- Having integrity in our walk means applying these scriptures and doing the right thing in everything that you do.

Positive Attitudes – Nothing is impossible when you are keeping God's laws

Matthew 6:33 (KJV) But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

- We must believe that those things will come true.

What do we want our culture and values to look like?

Q. Why do we exist?

A. We as revolutionary women exist to be helpmeets and pillars of rest to our lords.

Q. Why do we believe?

A. We believe that our Lord and savior, The Black Messiah is going to save us from our enemies.

Q. Where do we want to go?

A. We want to go HOME!!!

Q. What are you going to do to help us get home?

A. Works, talents and exchanging of gifts

Purpose

2 Timothy 1:9 (KJV) Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

- His purpose is that we serve Him

Ephesians 1:11 (KJV) In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

Philippians 2:2 (KJV) Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, *being* of one accord, of one mind.

1 Peter 2:21-22(KJV)

Vs 21 For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

- We must follow the steps and examples than Christ left for us.

Vs 22 Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

- As sisters we must be mindful of how a “good woman” carries herself. (ex: manners, saying thank you, please, no arguing or fighting)

Ownership and Accountability/Applies the scriptures

- We are accountable to our Foremother Sarah as long as we do well, through the application of the scriptures.

Romans 14:12 (KJV) So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

Hebrews 10:25 (KJV) Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some *is*; but exhorting *one another*: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Revelation 20:12 (KJV) And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

- A revolutionary woman understands that every idle word and action is being written down and recorded.
- She is careful and mindful of her speech
- Scriptures says, “alms covered a multitude of sins”

Having Effective Communication

- W must have effective communication with your lord, leadership and brothers and sisters in the congregation
- Her conversation brings hope and encouragement.

Hebrews 13:5-6 (KJV)

Vs 5 *Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.*

Vs 6 *So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.*

- In this walk having faith especially during these trying times, people are able to see the hope that you have in your belief and faith in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 4:29 (KJV) *Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.*

Leadership/Teamwork

Matthew 12:33 (KJV) *Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit.*

- As a revolutionary woman, what is your fruit? Are you known as a good or bad tree?
- There is time for you to water your own grass to get yourself back in alignment with the woman that God called you to be.

Colossians 4:6 (KJV) *Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.*

- How do you interact with other sisters and shamefaced with men inside and outside of the body of Christ?

Ephesians 4:11 (KJV) *And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors, and teachers;*

- In the unity of the sisterhood we all have gifts that could be used to help the men get the work done.
- Just like our righteous foremothers and the women in the civil rights movement (ex: flyers, grants, writing organization, prison ministry, what your lord needs, cooking cleaning and daycare, etc.)

Isaiah 32:9-11 (KJV)

Vs 9 Rise up, ye women that are at ease; hear my voice, ye careless daughters; give ear unto my speech.

Vs 10 Many days and years shall ye be troubled, ye careless women: for the vintage shall fail, the gathering shall not come.

Vs 11 Tremble, ye women that are at ease; be troubled, ye careless ones: strip you, and make you bare, and gird *sackcloth* upon *your* loins.

- We must listen to what the Heavenly Father is saying. Do NOT get comfortable here because many days shall be troubled.
- We are living in the last days which are evil, and part of being a revolutionary woman is not getting comfortable as this is not our rest.
- We are awaiting the kingdom of heaven to come back and we must rise up and take heed to the things that we have learned.
