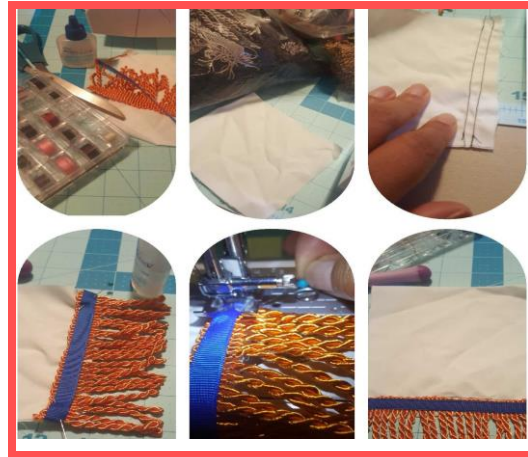


You MUST Have FRINGE

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You must have fringe...
 So, in the last article we talked about how scared I was using this sewing machine for the first time. I learned the proper speed, how to sit, how NOT to feel overwhelmed. When you are new at the sewing, it is like WOOOO!! So, when I tried to attach fringe I naturally gravitated towards the smallest possible thinking this would be the easiest to sew...NOT SEW MUCH. The sew line was like I was swerving in and out of traffic on a sewing machine who does that...me because I was just learning.

That fringe was beyond difficult, but I kept practicing now I had to add a border of blue and keep a straight line. As I was doing this, I had a class playing in the background, my niece and nephew mulling about, my sister and her husband cooking dinner.

Anytime the machine was being weird or acting funny (so not the operator, totally the machine) I reached out for help- sewing with a senior sister is SO helpful. Let us be clear you MUST have patience to teach, you MUST give yourself credit because you are learning something new. Remember to breath, stretch your shoulders out, go slow. #don'trush #takeyourtime #reachout (please see the above photos). Things that you will need:

- Sewing Machine
- Scissors/Thread/Needle for Machine/Pins
- Border of Blue/Fringe/Fringe Check
- You can use an old t-shirt for practice
