


Event: Titus 2

Topic: Gods Judgement for Interracial Marriage

Date: Nov 4, 2020



Samson was a judge of Israel. Before he was in his mother's womb, an angel came to her while she was pregnant and said the baby you are carrying is going to be a Nazarite. They have certain laws they must follow, and his mother had to follow it.

Numbers 6:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

Numbers 6:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When either man or woman shall separate themselves to vow a vow of a Nazarite, to separate themselves unto the LORD:

When you took this vow, you separate yourself to be closer to the Most High to learn the scriptures and pray more.

Numbers 6:3 He shall separate himself from wine and strong drink, and shall drink no vinegar of wine, or vinegar of strong drink, neither shall he drink any liquor of grapes, nor eat moist grapes, or dried.

Rule 1 - no wine or strong drink

Cannot eat any grapes not moist or dry because grapes turn into wine.

Numbers 6:4 All the days of his separation shall he eat nothing that is made of the vine tree, from the kernels even to the husk.

Numbers 6:5 All the days of the vow of his separation there shall no razor come upon his head: until the days be fulfilled, in the which he separateth himself unto the LORD, he shall be holy, and shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow.

Rule 2 - never cut his hair. He must let his hair grow long

Numbers 6:6 All the days that he separateth himself unto the LORD he shall come at no dead body.

Rule 3- he cannot eat or touch nothing that is dead.

Deuteronomy 6:7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

Make sure each one of us teach this to our children.

Sitting in your house, walking down the street go over the commandments.

Going to bed talk about the commandments and when you rise in the morning talk about the commandments

Deuteronomy 7:6 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

If your children come home wanting to marry anybody outside of the 12 Tribes rebuke them and let them know this is not happening and against God.

We are a holy people we are not to mix. Most High chose us to be special to him out of all the people on the earth Israelites are special to him.

We are spiritually are above all the other nations and we cannot go down to the level and marry them.

Ezra 9:12 Now therefore give not your daughters unto their sons, neither take their daughters unto your sons, nor seek their peace or their wealth forever: that ye may be strong, and eat the good of the land, and leave it for an inheritance to your children forever.

The prophet Ezra was reminding them do not give your daughters to the other nation's son. Your daughter wants to marry them do not consent.

Do not take their daughters of other nations to marry our sons.

Nor seek their peace or wealth forever.

Tobit 4:12 Beware of all whoredom, my son, and chiefly take a wife of the seed of thy fathers, and take not a strange woman to wife, which is not of thy father's tribe: for we are the children of the prophets, Noe, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: remember, my son, that our fathers from the beginning, even that they all married wives of their own kindred, and were blessed in their children, and their seed shall inherit the land.

Tobit is warning his son before he thought he was going to die. If I am not here anymore beware of all whoredom.

Tobit instructing his son when you get marry take a wife of the nation of Israel one of the 12 tribes of Israel. This must be taught to sons young. Do not take a strange woman of the other nations to wife. Which is not of our forefather's tribe.

All married wives of the 12 Tribes of Israel they picked a wife from the nation of Israel. Make sure you continue that we are not to do mixing.

When you married an Israelite women or man, and you all keep the commandments the promise is that the Israelites will rule the planet forever.

If you married outside your race it is not happening.

You must be with someone in your nation of 12 Tribes.

Tobit 4:13 Now therefore, my son, love thy brethren, and despise not in thy heart thy brethren, the sons and daughters of thy people, in not taking a wife of them: for in pride is destruction and much trouble, and in lewdness is decay and great want: for lewdness is the mother of famine.

Love your people.

Do not hate your people

The way you show hate to your people is marrying the other nations.

If you do not pick a wife of your people you hate your people deep down inside.

Abraham was going to die, and he had a son named Issacs. Abraham told his servant special instructions.

Genesis 24:1 And Abraham was old, and well stricken in age: and the LORD had blessed Abraham in all things.

Abraham got old.

Genesis 24:2 And Abraham said unto his eldest servant of his house, that ruled over all that he had, Put, I pray thee, thy hand under my thigh:

Genesis 24:3 And I will make thee swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that thou shalt not take a wife unto my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell:

Abraham making the servant promise him you will not let my son get marry to an African woman.

Genesis 24:4 But thou shalt go unto my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife unto my son Isaac.

Go back to my people Israel and get him a wife from one of the 12 Tribes.

Make sure my son does not marry no African women..

Abraham gives instructions he is about to die. He called his servant to make sure my son takes a wife of one of the 12 Tribes. Do not let him marry outside his race.

Our forefathers was leaving instructions if they children was not married yet make sure you follow the routine, follow our culture, and custom because the promise is only if you married within the 12 Tribes and keep the commandments

1 Kings 11:1 But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, and Hittites;

King Soloman had many wives, and he married the other women of other nations. Shows you great men can mess up..

God did not like that.

King Soloman was King of Israel. He was King David's son. David gave him instructions and when he got old and his father was not here anymore, he begins to bug out and marry women of other nations

Daughters of other nations:

Pharaoh captivity in Egypt -Africans

Moabites - Chinese

Ammonites- Japanese

Edomites- Caucasian

Zidonians - Africans

Hittetes - Africans

King Soloman started married these different women of other nations

1 Kings 11:2 Of the nations concerning which the LORD said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall not go in to them, neither shall they come in unto you: for surely they will turn away your heart after their gods: Solomon clave unto these in love.

Do not lay with these people or allow them to lay with you.

For you and your children. Do not break Gods commandments.

The problem is when your son gets with these women, they going to tell your son not to worship their own God the Most High but to worship them God.

Esau going to tell white Jesus is the way.

Moab (Chinese) and Ammon (Japanese) women going to have you follow Buda they going to send you to a different god to serve them they not going to tell you to keep your God commandments .

That is why God said stay away from these women because they will turn your heart your mind from following me..

Other nations are not going to put an urgency on keeping God's laws. When they do not care about our God and do not believe in our God.

So, when you marry them, they will turn your heart from follow Most High.

They going to tell you follow Christmas, Thanksgiving, Muslims pray to a rock and now your worshipping an idol.

God said do not get with these women. Get with an Israelite women who know the commandments and who will encourage they mate to keep God's laws so we can inherit the earth.

Soloman was all in love with these women..

1 Kings 11:3 And he had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart.

Soloman had seven wives, princesses and three hundred concubines. These wives not of Israel in his old age encourage him not to keep Gods commandments.

Matthew 15:4 For God commanded, saying, Honour thy father and mother: and He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death.

God commanded all children to honor your parents in the law. If parents not in the law if they not asking you to break the law, you can honor them..

Parents in the law you must train your children they must honor, reverence you, treat you on a high level of respect mean listen to what you say according to the scriptures.

It is our job to instill it in our children.

Children not listening to their father we need to stop them in their track and say what did your father just say.

When we get back in the wilderness a lot of children are going to be put to death if they do not listen to their parents. Most High said just let them die. If they do not listen to their parents, who are they ultimately not following Most High.

Everything you are teaching them coming from the bible.

Example:

They may decide I want to eat pork or marry Esau. Most High said let them die. That is how he feels about it. Do not break my laws.

Ecclesiasticus 3:16 He that forsaketh his father is as a blasphemer; and he that angereth his mother is cursed: of God.

Whoever does not listen to their father in these laws Most High said they are a liar they are not following the Most High. Any child that makes their mother angry and breaks the commandments Most High will curse that child.

If your child is wanting by you and according to God's commandments and they do not follow God said will curse that child.

Example:

That child may walk out marry to this Moabite or I do not have to keep God Sabbath and you get angry. God will curse that child.

The curse doesn't have to be right now it can be 3 months, 6 months, or 10 years, we don't know how the curse is going to come but there is a curse that will be put on that child. If you raise them in the law and they say forget about what you say. I am not listening to your God nor honoring him Most High said I am going to curse them.

Judges 14:1 And Samson went down to Timnath and saw a woman in Timnath of the daughters of the Philistines.

Who are the Philistines? Africans

Samson started honoring these African women. This was his lust and weakness.

Remember he is a Nazarite; he is close to the Most High. Most High wrote that relationship dearly about his vowing a vow.

He gets older he started feeling the other women. He is like aww it is not that serious. He is thinking I can lust after them.

Judges 14:2 And he came up, and told his father and his mother, and said, I have seen a woman in Timnath of the daughters of the Philistines: now therefore get her for me to wife.

He went to his parents knowing the law. He said come on dad please go get this woman. I really like her, I am feeling her, I want to marry her. She is the one.

Judges 14:3 Then his father and his mother said unto him, is there never a woman among the daughters of thy brethren, or among all my people, that thou goest to take a wife of the uncircumcised Philistines? And Samson said unto his father, Get her for me; for she pleaseth me well.

His parents reminded him of the commandments. You cannot find a woman in Israel you like. You should not be messing with those women.

You need to find a woman within the 12 Tribes. Even among the 12 Tribes can you at least get a woman from there. Why you want to get a woman from the Africans. This is against God they remind him

You are going to those ungodly people. Uncircumcised you do not cut the foreskin of the man penis. Uncircumcised in heart means they do not keep the laws of God. They are without the laws. You are going to a set of people that is without God's laws.

You are talking about want to be with her and marry her, and want us to get her that is wrong.

Samson said I really like her, want to marry her, I want to be with her, and she pleases me.

Judges 14:4 But his father and his mother knew not that it was of the LORD, that he sought an occasion against the Philistines: for at that time the Philistines had dominion over Israel.

His parents did not know it was a lust Samson has and Most High going to use his lust to his advantage.

At the same time everyone here going to learn a lesson.

The Most High not dealing with the Philistines. Most High do not like these Africans' people.

In the time of Judges, the Philistines was over Israel like Esau is over us today.

Key Point:

Most High already wanted to jack the Philistines up and punish them but Most High going to use Samson weakness to his advantage since Samson not listening anyway.

Israel is under the Philistines they have dominion meaning they are ruling. God saw an occasion and wanted to get the Philistines away. So, he going to kill two birds in one stone.

Judges 14:5 Then went Samson down, and his father and his mother, to Timnath, and came to the vineyards of Timnath: and behold, a young lion roared against him.

Samson was going down to Timnath a lion came out and roared against him meaning like attack him.

Judges 14:6 And the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and he rent him as he would have rent a kid, and he had nothing in his hand: but he told not his father or his mother what he had done.

One of the gifts God gave Samson he was the strongest man to ever live on earth.

When the Lion came up Samson ripped that lion up into pieces. That is how strong he was.

When he took the vow of Nazirite that was his gift. He did not tell his parents he killed the lion.

What is one of the vows? Do not touch the dead. He is being deceitful.

Judges 14:7 And he went down and talked with the woman; and she pleased Samson well.

Samson went and started talking and getting with her.

Judges 14:8 And after a time he returned to take her, and he turned aside to see the carcase of the lion: and, behold, there was a swarm of bees and honey in the carcase of the lion.

He returned to marry her. He messed with the dead lion.

Bees landed on lion and made honey in the lion..

Judges 14:9 And he took thereof in his hands, and went on eating, and came to his father and mother, and he gave them, and they did eat: but he told not them that he had taken the honey out of the carcase of the lion.

He took the honey out of the lion which he was not supposed to be touching. He ate it and shared with his parents and did not tell them what he did.

He did not tell his parents he took the honey.

Who saw him take the honey? Most High saw him

Judges 14:10 So his father went down unto the woman: and Samson made there a feast; for so used the young men to do.

Samson has a wedding feast. He married this African woman.

He was not supposed to marry her. That is evil..

Judges 14:11 And it came to pass, when they saw him, that they brought thirty companions to be with him.

They brought thirty men to be with him

Judges 14:12 And Samson said unto them, I will now put forth a riddle unto you: if ye can certainly declare it me within the seven days of the feast, and find it out, then I will give you thirty sheets and thirty change of garments:

Wedding feast lasted seven days not one day; we came from royalty.

If you can solve my riddle you can get thirty hot outfits for all your men.

Judges 14:13 But if ye cannot declare it me, then shall ye give me thirty sheets and thirty change of garments. And they said unto him, put forth thy riddle, that we may hear it.

Samson: If you do not solve my riddle you must get me thirty seven beautiful garments.

They said we going to try to solve it.

Judges 14:14 And he said unto them, out of the eater came forth meat, and out of the strong came forth sweetness. And they could not in three days expound the riddle.

He gave them seven days to solve the riddle and after three days they could not figure it out.

Judges 14:15 And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they said unto Samson's wife, Entice thy husband, that he may declare unto us the riddle, lest we burn thee and thy father's house with fire: have ye called us to take that we have? is it not so?

Her African people went to her and said go to your Israelite husband and find out the answer. If you do not find out, we going to burn you and your father with fire.

Judges 14:16 And Samson's wife wept before him, and said, Thou dost but hate me, and lovest me not: thou hast put forth a riddle unto the children of my people, and hast not told it me. And he said unto her, Behold, I have not told it my father nor my mother, and shall I tell it thee?

She went to her husband Samson to get the answer. She feared for her life that they were going to burn her and her father with fire. She does have loyalty to her people.

She was like, "you could have told me, you do not love me why are not you are telling me the answer". She is crying all over the place during the wedding feast. If you love me, you will tell me. Some women know how to do those water works well.

Samson said he "I did not even tell my parents the answer, why will I tell you?"

Judges 14:17 And she wept before him the seven days, while their feast lasted: and it came to pass on the seventh day, that he told her, because she lay sore upon him: and she told the riddle to the children of her people.

She kept crying and crying during her wedding feast. It is about to break him down.

On the seventh day he gave her the answer. She kept begging and begging and following him, so he told her.

Her loyalty was to her people. This African woman was deceitful. She was disloyal to Samson but loyal to her people.

Judges 14:18 And the men of the city said unto him on the seventh day before the sun went down, what is sweeter than honey? and what is stronger than a lion? And he said unto them, if ye had not plowed with my heifer, ye had not found out my riddle.

The answer was this verse.

If you all did not mess with my wife, you would not have found out my answer.

He knows she betrayed him and told the answer to the Africans.

Judges 14:19 And the Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle. And his anger was kindled, and he went up to his father's house.

He had to keep his deal and went to Ashkelon and slew those men to get thirty different garments and had to give it to them. Thirty changes of apparel.

Judges 14:20 But Samson's wife was given to his companion, whom he had used as his friend.

While Samson is gone to get garments, her father gave her to another African man who was his friend to marry her. They are loyal to their own people.

The father gave away Samson wife to their own people like it was nothing.

That is why God said do not give your sons to their daughters or take their daughters to our son.

Deuteronomy 23:17 There shall be no whore of the daughters of Israel, nor a sodomite of the sons of Israel.

Judges 15:1 But it came to pass within a while after, in the time of wheat harvest, that Samson visited his wife with a kid; and he said, I will go in to my wife into the chamber. But her father would not suffer him to go in.

When Samson returned from the trip, he got the kid like a goat food. Samson said I am going in to lay with my wife. He does not know yet they gave his wife away.

Judges 15:2 And her father said, I verily thought that thou hadst utterly hated her; therefore I gave her to thy companion: is not her younger sister fairer than she? take her, I pray thee, instead of her.

Listen I thought when you were gone, I thought you hated her because you did not return at the appointed time. So, I gave her to another man. You can have her sister she is younger and prettier.

That is what he gets he should have stayed with a strong Israelite woman, his own kind.

Judges 15:3 And Samson said concerning them, Now shall I be more blameless than the Philistines, though I do them a displeasure.

Samson said I am going to do you all a displeasure for giving way my wife.

Judges 15:4 And Samson went and caught three hundred foxes, and took firebrands, and turned tail to tail, and put a firebrand in the midst between two tails.

Key Point:

Samson caught three hundred foxes and tied them by twos and lit a fire between them.

Judges 15:5 And when he had set the brands on fire, he let them go into the standing corn of the Philistines, and burnt up both the shocks, and also the standing corn, with the vineyards and olives.

Philistines was growing a lot of corn in the field. He knew that their fields are full of corn. Samson lit the foxes on fire, and they are running through the field full of corn to destroy the food. Samson doing evil back to them.

Judges 15:6 Then the Philistines said, who hath done this? And they answered, Samson, the son in law of the Timnite, because he had taken his wife, and given her to his companion. And the Philistines came up and burnt her and her father with fire.

They ask who lit our field on fire?

One person said Samson lit it because her father gave Samson wife to someone else.

They were like really, he wanted to burn up our stuff. Bring that African woman here. They mad at the father for marrying him. You all brought this evil to us. We are going right in front of him and her father.

They going to hurt his soul because he likes her, he done laid with her, that is his wife and they burned her with fire and her father.

He should not have been with this African woman in the first place. All this evil following him because he went with her because of his lust.

Judges 15:7 And Samson said unto them, though ye have done this, yet will I be avenged of you, and after that I will cease.

Samson said, I am going to get you all back. I am going to get my revenge.

Judges 15:8 And he smote them hip and thigh with a great slaughter and he went down and dwelt in the top of the rock Etam.

Samson started murdering them.

Judges 15:9 Then the Philistines went up, and pitched in Judah, and spread themselves in Lehi.

Judges 15:10 And the men of Judah said, why are ye come up against us? And they answered, To bind Samson are we come up, to do to him as he hath done to us.

Samson started murdering them. The African men went to the Israel men. There were thousands of African men. They showed up to the Tribe of Judah. Judah was like why are you all here? They said we want Sampson captive because what he did to us.

Judges 15:11 Then three thousand men of Judah went to the top of the rock Etam, and said to Samson, Knowest thou not that the Philistines are rulers over us? what is this that thou hast done unto us? And he said unto them, As they did unto me, so have I done unto them.

Judah took three thousand men and went to Samson in the hills. They said you are crazy. Do you not know the Africans rule over us? What did you just do? You cannot do that.

Samson said they took my wife and gave her to another man. So, I burned their fields. Then they killed my wife, so I started killing them.

He thinks it is logical what he is doing. That is his pride right now.

Judges 15:12 And they said unto him, we are come down to bind thee, that we may deliver thee into the hand of the Philistines. And Samson said unto them, swear unto me, that ye will not fall upon me yourselves.

Judah said we came down here to take you captive to give you them because we do not want no problem. You need to go and give yourself in to them.

Promise me you will not kill me. Deliver me to them. I am good.

Judges 15:13 And they spake unto him, saying, no; but we will bind thee fast, and deliver thee into their hand: but surely, we will not kill thee. And they bound him with two new cords and brought him up from the rock.

They took him from the mountain and took him back to the Philistines.

Judges 15:14 And when he came unto Lehi, the Philistines shouted against him: and the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and the cords that were upon his arms became as flax that was burnt with fire, and his bands loosed from off his hands.

When they started yelling at him with rage and anger at the Africans. The spirit of the Lord gave him strength to beat anybody down. The string they tied him with he broke it like it was a joke.

Judges 15:15 And he found a new jawbone of an ass, and put forth his hand, and took it, and slew a thousand men therewith.

He saw the jawbone of a donkey that had deceased.; a whole jaw, it is big.

Samson killed a thousand men by himself. That is a superhero.

Once Christ return it is going down the power our men will have.

Judges 15:16 And Samson said, With the jawbone of an ass, heaps upon heaps, with the jaw of an ass have I slain a thousand men.

Samson was like now yeah, I killed a thousand men

Judges 15:17 And it came to pass, when he had made an end of speaking, that he cast away the jawbone out of his hand and called that place Ramathlehi.

After he killed them with the jawbone, he threw it down because he was tired.

Judges 15:18 And he was sore athirst, and called on the LORD, and said, Thou hast given this great deliverance into the hand of thy servant: and now shall I die for thirst, and fall into the hand of the uncircumcised?

Samson prayed to the Most High I know you deliver me and gave me the strength to do this. Please give me something to drink I am dying to thirst.

Imagine that thousand men he killed of course he is thirst.y

Judges 15:19 But God clave an hollow place that was in the jaw, and there came water thereout; and when he had drunk, his spirit came again, and he revived: wherefore he called the name thereof Enhakkore, which is in Lehi unto this day.

Most High sent water on the floor.

So, once he drinks the water, he gets his energy back thinking he learned his lesson.

Judges 16:1 Then went Samson to Gaza, and saw there a harlot, and went in unto her. Now he is messing with whores.

No whores in the daughters of Sarah
You lay with a woman you must make her your wife

Judges 16:2 And it was told the Gazites, saying, Samson is come hither. And they compassed him in, and laid wait for him all night in the gate of the city, and were quiet all the night, saying, In the morning, when it is day, we shall kill him.

While he in there with the whores they are plotting and scheming on him when he come out, we going to kill him because he killed a thousand of their men. He escaped in the middle of the night.

Judges 16:4 And it came to pass afterward, that he loved a woman in the valley of Sorek, whose name was Delilah.

Samson meet another woman name Delilah

Judges 16:5 And the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and said unto her, Entice him, and see wherein his great strength lieth, and by what means we may prevail against him, that we may bind him to afflict him: and we will give thee every one of us eleven hundred pieces of silver.

The men came to her and her people said let him flirt with you and get him and let him tell you why he gets his power from. Why he is so strong?

They told her we will give you eleven hundred each of silver. God said do not mix with them. His Prentis reminded him.

Judges 16:6 And Delilah said to Samson, tell me, I pray thee, wherein thy great strength lieth, and wherewith thou mightest be bound to afflict thee.

She gets with him. She is asking him how you get this strong, you are sexy and strong, how you get like this? She is hugging and kissing him making him feel good.

Judges 16:7 And Samson said unto her, if they bind me with seven green withs that were never dried, then shall I be weak, and be as another man.

If they tie me with seven leaves and I will be weak like other men. Samson's strength is that he never cut his hair. Most High gave him great strength. He was not to tell anyone. Delilah asking him and he lied to her.

Judges 16:8 Then the lords of the Philistines brought up to her seven green withs which had not been dried, and she bound him with them. (She tied him up)

Judges 16:9 Now there were men lying in wait, abiding with her in the chamber. And she said unto him, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And he breaks the withs, as a thread of tow is broken when it toucheth the fire. So, his strength was not known.

She ties him up and gassing him up feeling good. He lies to her. Once she finds out and the Philistines waiting at the door.

She screams out and starts saying the Philistines are coming to get me help me.

Philistines runs in believing the green leaves are going to break his strength. He pops up like a rubber band. He started beating them up. They were unable to capture him. He beats them up agai.

Judges 16:10 And Delilah said unto Samson, Behold, thou hast mocked me, and told me lies now tell me, I pray thee, wherewith thou mightest be bound.

She says, "you lied to me why you did not tell me the truth". She is acting like she not with those men. Tell me the truth if you love me tell me Samson

Judges 16:11 And he said unto her, if they bind me fast with new ropes that never were occupied, then shall I be weak, and be as another man.

Samson lies to her again.

If they tie me with new ropes that never been used, I will be weak as other men.

Samson knows in his spirit he is not supposed to tell anyone.

Judges 16:12 Delilah therefore took new ropes, and bound him therewith, and said unto him, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And there were laying in wait abiding in the chamber. And he breaks them from off his arms like a thread.

After she does her scheme, she says, "Samson help, help, help the Philistines is on us, they are coming for you" He pops the band off like it is a threat.

She was confused and she thought she got the answer.

He tears them up again. They cannot capture him. This Israelite is strong.

Judges 16:13 And Delilah said unto Samson, hitherto thou hast mocked me, and told me lies tell me wherewith thou mightest be bound. And he said unto her, If thou weavest the seven locks of my head with the web.

Samson said listen if you tie my hair down with a web, I will be weak

She is crying. She said you are mocking me, and you keep lying to me. You said you love me, and you would not tell me the truth. Samson said fine if you tie my hair down, I will be weak.

Judges 16:14 And she fastened it with the pin, and said unto him, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And he awaked out of his sleep, and went away with the pin of the beam, and with the web.

She does it again and she screams at the Philistines after me and he busts through that too. He smashes them like an Incredible hulk. Most High gave him that strength

Judges 16:15 And she said unto him, How canst thou say, I love thee, when thine heart is not with me? thou hast mocked me these three times, and hast not told me wherein thy great strength lieth.

Delilah using a love card you do not love me; I ask you three times and you would not tell me.

Judges 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death.

She kept stressing you do not love me, she is crying, she is upset, you will not tell me your secret, and she kept crying you will not tell me your strength

Samson said okay. He feels like he wants to die like this the whole relationship going on where my strength come from.

Judges 16:17 That he told her all his heart, and said unto her, There hath not come a razor upon mine head; for I have been a Nazarite unto God from my mother's womb: if I be shaven, then my strength will go from me, and I shall become weak, and be like any other man.

Samson told this African woman all his business who is not Israel. God told him not to tell no one

You remember the angel came to his mother and said do not cut his hair or strong drink. Even in her womb she did not drink any wine. It is was serious.

Samson like she really loves me, let me tell her so we can move on with our life

He told her if you shave my hair, I will be weak like other men.

Judges 16:18 And when Delilah saw that he had told her all his heart, she sent and called for the lords of the Philistines, saying, Come up this once, for he hath shewed me all his heart. Then the lords of the Philistines came up unto her and brought money in their hand.

When she finds out she went back to her people.

She was loyal to her people. She went back to her people.

They know that not us even if you marry them, they know that are not Israel.

She got her money for doing the job.

She tells her people his power is in his hair.

Can I get my money please? She asked.

Judges 16:19 And she made him sleep upon her knees; and she called for a man, and she caused him to shave off the seven locks of his head; and she began to afflict him, and his strength went from him.

She threw that cookie jar on him like never. She was like yes, I am getting the money, getting some of you. I am taking you for everything you got. She had some sexual intercourse with Samson and got that money.

She did what she had to do that night to get what she wanted from him

She got it in that night she made him fall to his knees after he was with her

You know what it is to have a man sleep in a feeble position

While he was sleep, she cut his hair, so they will not have to do it when they come in the room

She started to afflict him to see if he was strong.

Samson is knocked out from all the love

Judges 16:20 And she said, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And he awoke out of his sleep, and said, I will go out as at other times before, and shake myself. And he wist not that the LORD was departed from him.

She called for the Philistines. Delilah was like “Samson the Philistines are coming get up”

Samson thought she was calling him for help, and he was like let them come in. I am going to beat them up

They came in and his strength was gone because God told him do not tell no one your strength, do not cut your hair, don't marry other nations, don't eat honey from dead carcass, don't sleep with whores. Samson was disobedience

Things written aforetime is written for our learning, so we will not repeat the same mistakes. Teach our sons when God said do not be with these other women.

They are loyal to their own people. They do not care about us.

They will use our people to marry them and get that money.

Tobit said when you marry them you hate your own people .

Judges 16:21 But the Philistines took him, and put out his eyes, and brought him down to Gaza, and bound him with fetters of brass; and he did grind in the prison house.

They took Samson and dug out his eyes immediately. They stabbed into his eyes and pulled it out.

They hated him; they were jealous of the strength he had because he killed, their people. He lost his eyes and had to work in prison. He could never see again. That was his judgement from the Most High.

Movie of Commentary

Tell me something you saw according to the scriptures and what was not in the scriptures they did Wedding Feast looking gay guy he said a riddle first and then Samson said a riddle

Was that in the scripture? No Samson said the riddle.

Fighting scene - got to feel one Israelite man taking thousand men by himself.

Imagine when judgment taking back this place. The strength our men will have!

Superheroes they show these cartoons they really talking about Israel how strong we were.

Forefathers going to be given back their strength when Christ comes.

They killed Samson father and its Samson first wife, and her father killed by fire.

What did he do with the foxes?
He lit them on fire and let them go.

How did his parents act when he wanted to take another wife of another nation? They were not happy and said to him "You cannot find one woman here in Israel?". They were asking who is her father? The father said you are going to bring shame to our family.

Esau knows our commandments and customs that is why they push interracial marriage for us to sin against our God. Nearly every TV show has interracial

Three things as a Nazarite he was supposed to keep

1. He touch and ate the honey from the carcasses
2. Not supposed to drink wine
3. Never cut his hair

Israel had to go get Samson and bring him to the Philistines, so it will not be a disaster.

The scripture never said he had a brother now we see they mix the truth with a lie.

Samson was a judge in Israel help deliver his people from Philistines.

We train our sons not to make the same mistake our forefathers Soloman and Samson did but married your own women in Israel.

God put him in high position and God made vow with him and he get pulled in this lust and it messed him up.

Romans 15:4 For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope.

That is going to be our hope. We are getting the scriptures and learning the scriptures

It is written foretime for our learning, so we do not make the same mistake and our children do not do it

These was great men who knew the commandments and fell.

How do we make sure it does not happen again and again?

Acts 8:31 And he said, how can I, except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him.

Numbers 6:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

Numbers 6:3 He shall separate himself from wine and strong drink, and shall drink no vinegar of wine, or vinegar of strong drink, neither shall he drink any liquor of grapes, nor eat moist grapes, or dried.

Isaiah 40:15 Behold, the nations are as a drop of a bucket, and are counted as the small dust of the balance: behold, he taketh up the isles as a very little thing.

The other nations are like a drop of water in a bucket nothing to the Most High. They cannot compare to Israelites.

2 Esdras 6:56 As for the other people, which also come of Adam, thou hast said that they are nothing, but be like unto spittle: and hast likened the abundance of them unto a drop that falleth from a vessel.

The other nations that came from Adam are nothing compared to Israel.

Deuteronomy 7:6 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

Thou Israelites are special. We are not on the same level. We are above in the Most High eyes and they are way down below. In the Most High eyes we high and other nations are low.
