- **Stop nagging, criticizing, complaining**

When we do this, we are telling our lord that we have no faith in him. It also shows a lack of patience and FAILURE to fulfill the role God made us for. Our responsibility is to not injure his pride and kick him when he is down. We are to be his best friend and not his enemy in times of trouble. *"Hard times will always reveal true friends."*

- **Be his comfort**

The grace of a wife delighted her husband (Sir 26:13). While your lord may not say it, this is the time he needs you most. If his own wife doesn't believe in him, who will? Uplift him by writing down his strengths and things you love about him and tell him, thank him. Congratulate his successes no matter how small. When he is in a low estate, remind him who he is and bring him back to the comfort of the scriptures. We must learn to speak words that will encourage and not diminish our lords. Each one of us have a way to uplift our husbands in a way no other person in this world can. We were ***Appointed From The Beginning*** by TMH to do so.

- **Offer Support.**
