What do you think it takes to raise a child from birth to betrothal? And how do you keep them from being sexually active both boys and girls.

This is what the class will be about today

How do you keep you children from defiling themselves and living up to the Standards of the Most High God, and making sure the next generation does not repeat the curses that happened to the last generation.

Answers:

- Consistency determination and teaching the laws, that I was not taught growing up, so thet don't repeat what I have done already.
- Be honest about your own experiences and mistakes, as an example and correlating my experiences with the scriptures, so they don't make the same mistakes.



• I was raised by my grandparents I learned a lot from them, in order from me to go out with anyone friends had to come to my house and meet the family. I did the same with my children I had to meet the parents, and they were always chaperoned.

That is excellent All Praises! So this is what we will be talking about today, how to deal with your children thus sayeth the lord.

- In history Israelites, when they were married, they definitely had to meet the parents. The parents of the children knew each other. We are going to read about Leah and Rachel. So this scripture is to show you that Rachel and Leah wer not wandering on their own going to clubs and parties and meeting who they want, lay with them and then bring them home to their parents. That was actually backwards, but this is how society works today, there is no parental guidance, and when something happens everyone is upset.
- What was written aforetime was written for our learning, so we are going to read through the scriptures and see how our forefathers and foremothers did it s we can get it right.

Genesis 29:15-30 (KJV)

And Laban said unto Jacob, Because thou *art* my brother, shouldest thou therefore serve me for naught? tell me, what *shall* thy wages *be*?

16And Laban had two daughters: the name of the elder *was* Leah, and the name of the younger *was* Rachel.

17Leah was tender eyed; but Rachel was beautiful and well favored.

18And Jacob loved Rachel; and said, I will serve thee seven years for Rachel thy younger daughter.

19And Laban said, *It is* better that I give her to thee, than that I should give her to another man: abide with me.

20And Jacob served seven years for Rachel; and they seemed unto him *but* a few days, for the love he had to her.

21And Jacob said unto Laban, Give *me* my wife, for my days are fulfilled, that I may go in unto her.

22And Laban gathered together all the men of the place, and made a feast.

23And it came to pass in the evening, that he took Leah his daughter, and brought her to him; and he went in unto her.

24And Laban gave unto his daughter Leah Zilpah his maid *for* an handmaid.



25And it came to pass, that in the morning, behold, it *was* Leah: and he said to Laban, What *is* this thou hast done unto me? did not I serve with thee for Rachel? wherefore then hast thou beguiled me?

26And Laban said, It must not be so done in our country, to give the younger before the firstborn.

27Fulfil her week, and we will give thee this also for the service which thou shalt serve with me yet seven other years.

28And Jacob did so, and fulfilled her week: and he gave him Rachel his daughter to wife also.

29And Laban gave to Rachel his daughter Bilhah his handmaid to be her maid.

30And he went in also unto Rachel, and he loved also Rachel more than Leah, and served with him yet seven other years.

- So Jacob went to Rachels Father Laban to ask if he could Marry Rachel
- The Point of the story was that Rachel did not just go out and meet Jacob, go to clubs how people date today, Before Jacob even approached Rachel, he went to her Father first and asked if he could marry her.
- Laban said it would be good for Jacob to marry Rachel because he was a righteous man
- Jacob worked 7 years to wait for Rachel, he was a man of patience and feared the lord.
 - We need to take our time and discipline ourselves, to get to know an individual with guidance from our spiritual Father and Mothers advice.
- Jacob was tricked by Laban and was given Leah instead of Rachel because it was not his custom to marry the younger daughter before the younger daughter. So, Jacob waited another 7 years to wait for Rachel.
 - He served a total of 14 years just to marry Rachel the woman he really wanted
- So it was never our custom for a woman to decide on her own who she is going to marry.

The next story is about Abraham who was old at this time, He wanted to make sure his son Issac married a women that was from his

Genesis 24:1-4(KJV)

And Abraham was old, *and* well stricken in age: and the LORD had blessed Abraham in all things.

2And Abraham said unto his eldest servant of his house, that ruled over all that he had, Put, I pray thee, thy hand under my thigh:

3And I will make thee swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that thou shalt not take a wife unto my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell:



4But thou shalt go unto my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife unto my son Isaac.

Abraham had a head servant who was in charge of most of his affairs when he was getting old, that he said to him if he dies promise him that his son will not marry a woman from another nation, and to go and find him a wife from his family in Israel

Here is the Father giving instructions about what he wants for his son

Genesis 24:12-19(KJV)

And he said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, I pray thee, send me good speed this day, and shew kindness unto my master Abraham.

13Behold, I stand *here* by the well of water; and the daughters of the men of the city come out to draw water:

14And let it come to pass, that the damsel to whom I shall say, Let down thy pitcher, I pray thee, that I may drink; and she shall say, Drink, and I will give thy camels drink also: *let the same be* she *that* thou hast appointed for thy servant Isaac; and thereby shall I know that thou hast shewed kindness unto my master.

15And it came to pass, before he had done speaking, that, behold, Rebekah came out, who was born to Bethuel, son of Milcah, the wife of Nahor, Abraham's brother, with her pitcher upon her shoulder.

16And the damsel *was* very fair to look upon, a virgin, neither had any man known her: and she went down to the well, and filled her pitcher, and came up.

17And the servant ran to meet her, and said, Let me, I pray thee, drink a little water of thy pitcher.

18And she said, Drink, my lord: and she hasted, and let down her pitcher upon her hand, and gave him drink.

19And when she had done giving him drink, she said, I will draw *water* for thy camels also, until they have done drinking.

- The servant asked the most High to show him a sign , and that sign would be when he went to the well to get water a woman would offer him water as well as his camel.
- Before he could drink Rachel came to the well to draw water
- Rebecca was a virgin and she was beautiful
- The servant asked for water she gave him a drink and fed his camels, she was kind and selfless, which is what he was looking for for Issac

Genesis24:51(KJV)



Behold, Rebekah *is* before thee, take *her*, and go, and let her be thy master's son's wife, as the LORD hath spoken.

- He went to her father and her father said you can take her and let her be your masters son's wife
- This is just showing that the women did not make any decisions on her own, the Father had togo and talk to the parents before thay could even approach the girl.
- So there was no having sex in cars, or at their parents house secretly, that ws not our custom

Genesis 24:57-61 (KJV)

And they said, We will call the damsel, and enquire at her mouth.

58And they called Rebekah, and said unto her, Wilt thou go with this man? And she said, I will go.

59And they sent away Rebekah their sister, and her nurse, and Abraham's servant, and his men.

60And they blessed Rebekah, and said unto her, Thou *art* our sister, be thou *the mother* of thousands of millions, and let thy seed possess the gate of those which hate them.

61And Rebekah arose, and her damsels, and they rode upon the camels, and followed the man: and the servant took Rebekah, and went his way.

- Her Father is now going to call her and talk to her about, and hear what she thought about it going to get married, and she agreed to go, she trusted her Father.
- When she left she took her nurse with her sister
- Her parents blessed her they were happy about her marriage because it was a righteous marriage, they encouraged them to have many children.
- If both fear people in the marriage fear God your children will also fear God
- We need to make sure we are giving our kids a good start

Genesis 24:63-67(KJV)

And Isaac went out to meditate in the field at the eventide: and he lifted up his eyes, and saw, and, behold, the camels *were* coming.

64And Rebekah lifted up her eyes, and when she saw Isaac, she lighted off the camel.

65For she *had* said unto the servant, What man *is* this that walketh in the field to meet us? And the servant *had* said, It *is* my master: therefore she took a vail, and covered herself.

66And the servant told Isaac all things that he had done.

67And Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah's tent, and took Rebekah, and she became his wife; and he loved her: and Isaac was comforted after his mother's *death*.



- Isaac went out to meditate and saw Rebecca coming and Camels
- Rebecca looks across the way and asked who is this that is coming to meet us?
- The servant said that is my master and Rebecca covered herself and was shamefaced, she was not in Issacs face.
- > We need to teach our daughters to be modest and shamefaced
- It is a dishonor when your children make such an important decision with out their parents , it is a dishonor and it is hurtful, and disrespectful.
- The next story is about Tobias his Father Tobit gave him money to go on a trip and would find his wife Sarah.

Tobit 7:9-10(APOC)

9So he communicated the matter with Raguel, and Raguel said to Tobias, Eat and drink, and make merry

10For it is meet that thou shouldest marry my daughter: nevertheless, I will declare unto thee the truth.

Sarah's father was Raguel and Tobias asked to marry his daughter, the father gave him permission and asked him to eat

Tobit 7:11-13 (APOC)

11 have given my daughter in marriage to seven men, who died that night they came in unto her: nevertheless for the present be merry: But Tobias said, I will eat nothing here, till we agree and swear one to another.

<u>12</u>Raguel said, Then take her from henceforth according to the manner, for thou art her cousin, and she is thine, and the merciful God give you good success in all things.

<u>13</u>Then he called his daughter Sara, and she came to her father, and he took her by the hand, and gave her to be wife to Tobias, saying, Behold, take her after the Law of Moses, and lead her away to thy father: And he blessed them,

- Sarah married many men before and before and before they could consummate the marriage they would die
- These men were not who the Most High intended for her to be with, but she did not know that at the time
- Her father wanted her to marry Tobias because he was a righteous man
- Her Father went to Sarah and told her he wanted her to marry Tobias



- The mother and father were very involved, the mother prepared the bed chamber, this was very personal
- The Mother created the bed chamber and they cried together
- •

- So the women never lived on her own apartment on her own , because she thinks she is old enough to be on her own. The women always had a man over them to watch over them guiding them, until the husband comes to take over not hurrying them out of the house to be on her own.
- What happens when you put a gorgeous girl in an apartment with no guidance? Men are going to come in , get inside her head, she can get pregnant, have abortions and be thrown away like garbage, drinking, drugs, depression. If her father and mother were there to protect her this will not happen.
- With the freedom comes a lot of wickedness, that was not our culture to let our daughters go on their own, hold on to your daughter until you can give her to a righteous man.

Tobit 8:14-17 (APOC)

14And called Edna his wife, & took paper, and did write an instrument of covenants, and sealed it.

15Then they began to eat.

16After Raguel called his wife Edna, and said unto her, Sister, prepare another chamber, & bring her in thither.

17Which when she had done as he had bidden her, she brought her thither, and she wept, & she received the tears of her daughter, and said unto her,

18Be of good comfort, my daughter, the Lord of heaven and earth give thee joy for this thy sorrow: be of good comfort, my daughter.

- So Raguel called his wife and they signed a marriage certificate, Mom and dad were included in this
- > After they signed the Marriage certificate the parents prepared the feast
- After the feast the mother prepared the marriage chamber and she brought her daughter and they cried together, because this was very personal and a big step to give your daughter to a righteous man.
- > We need to get back to this, we are royalty and we need to instill this in our children

Tobit8:4-6(APOC)



5Then began Tobias to say, Blessed art thou, O God of our fathers, and blessed is thy holy and glorious Name for ever, let the heavens blesse thee, and all thy creatures.

6Thou madest Adam, and gavest him Eve his wife for an helper & stay: of them came mankind: thou hast said, It is not good that man should be alone, let vs make unto him an aide like to himself.

7And now, O Lord, I take not this my sister for lust, but uprightly: therefore mercifully ordain, that we may become aged together.

- Tobias said let us pray that the most High will bless our marriage
- We need to teach our daughters that she is to be his helper, not in his face, or with the independent mindset, we still need to submit.
 - She needs to help him to the bet of her ability, like he his helping himself
 - We need teach our daughters that we are preparing them for their husbands to be a helpmeet, a Godly woman.
- For our son's we need to let them know ,you don't pick a woman for sex, or lust they need to be virgins also.
- A woman who is a virgin does not come with the same baggage as a woman who has slept with multiple men. There is usually hurt, pain, mental triggers that make creating strong relationships difficult
- This is the type of behavior that creates broken homes where the fathers are not in the home, and the cycle of broken families continue.
- The Most High is calling us to change this cycle
- Again I am just showing you how in our history it has always been or custom to remain virgins. Many of us have made the same mistakes over and over again picking the wrong person to deal with
- > This is not how we should be conducting our selves that is the behavior of a whore.

Esther was to be married to the king and she preparing herself to be in a pageant, that the king had to choose his new wife. There was a certain way she carried herself before she moved into the Palace

Esther 2:10(KJV)

10Esther had not shewed her people, nor her kindred: for Mordecai had charged her, that she should not shew it.

11And Mordecai walked every day before the court of the womens house, to know how Esther did, and what should become of her.

• Mordecai checked on Esther everyday, when she moved into the Palace, even though he didn't live there to keep an eye on her/



- Some parents when our children turn a certain age , we let them go on their own on don't check up on them, who they are with and where they are going.
- We don't just send our children with just anyone, unless we prove them first

Ecclesiasticus(Sirach)30:1-2

1He that loveth his son, causeth him oft to feel the rod, that he may have joy of him in the end.

2He that chastiseth his son shall have joy in him, and shall rejoice of him among his acquaintance.

- You have to train your children, you have to woop their butts when they do wrong, they must submit to you as the parents
- Start teaching them while they are little, teach about what an abortion is so they can know what it is and wont end up on the abortion table, I showed my daughter who is 10 what trimester 1,2,and 3 abortions were. We have to teach our children young.
- If you have the opportunity to teach your children about the, you can not wait until they to teach women their role as a wife and men their role a righteous husband.
- You will have joy in the end if you correct them and make boundaries

Ecclesiasticus (Sirach) 30:11(APOC)

11Give him no liberty in his youth, and wink not at his follies.

- Give your children no freedom, you cannot allow your children to be around ungodly people, they will learn a bunch of wicked things.
- I look at my children as gifts from God, so I take looking after them seriously
- We need keep our kids on our hip, and around Godly people
- Children don't need privacy, phone calls should be on speaker
- God says honor your mother and Father for a reason, no one loves you more than your Father and Mother
- Pray for your children , pray that no boys or girls in you sons and daughters face,
- I used to wait for my daughter when she went to college to make sure she was protected
- You know what you need to do to keep your child safe, so that they will not have to feel pain
- It is important for both parent to be on one accord, that way the children will not be able get away with doing what they want.
- TV glorifies whoredom and we need to teach them what really happens when they lead that top of lifestyle using the scriptures, diligently teaching them the laws.
- You know the type of child you have, you need to keep your child protected no matter what

Shalom everyone Most High Name Christ Bless, Naamah asked me to speak for a moment, I am going to do a little bit of story time util she comes back.

A lot of sisters ask me what was the catalyst for me and my own spiritual walk, and the primary catalyst was the birth of my daughter, especially when you realize you are creating a mini me, it put me on the straight path that I was doing and saying the right things, as the scripture says *Ezekiel 16: 44 as is the mother so is the daughter*.

Bishop and I went to a very large Israelite wedding, and they did not hold back any expenses, so we looked at each other and said we need to get ourselves together so we can have this type of wedding when our daughter gets married.

When I first started the daughters of Sarah website, I had a page about raising your daughter and is was a picture of me and Asiyah she was probably about 8 and it was my wish and desire for her that she always stayed in the truth and the Lord does not remove his Holy Spirit from her, and that she be worthy of a lord that she would be a righteous helpmate, wife, pillar of rest, she would find a man that loves the truth and to love er and would never cause her any emotional pain, and would be able to provide for her. So that is the goal of a righteous mother or parents.

Bishop Kani said years ago that "the man I allow to marry my daughter, I don't give a damn if she loves him, I have to love him." And I never forgot that, that the heavenly Father has given the pwer to a man to choose a man of understanding for his daughter is a powerful thing. We need to remember that when we are raising our daughters, we need to set them up for success.

I saw this quote in a book when I was in the Doctor's office waiting room and this is what it said:

My daughters enlighten me about myself the presence acts as constant reminder and everchanging reflection of me, as well as a source of feedback. I see myself in their attitudes, mannerisms, and relationships.

So the reason why that quote stopped me was because, especially if you have parents in this truth your marriage should be a representative obviously of the foundation of God, Christ, man and woman, as Bishop says that a strong marriage is the fundamental basis of a strong nation. And by teaching your daughter to be a good wife and setting her up for success from birth, whether it be a physical birth or a spiritual birth, if you have spiritual parents. It is important that you grow there by, as the scriptures say.

I want to point out that as Naamah said , my daughter was always at my hip and I didn't realize it but as *the years have progressed she has grown in to a beautiful young woman*.

When I was younger my grandmother you used to always ask me "You courting yet?" an old expression in the south about courting.

Courting is a very serious subject and I pride myself in that fact that Titus 2 has given excellent classes for sisters about courting and getting yourself ready for marriage. So if a repenting daughter of Sarah is applying the things that the aged women are teaching her there is really no excuse if she is flowing the things that have been taught.



- > Your daughter is a reflection of you
- The best compliment that you can ever receive is well raised children from birth to betrothal, that way when your daughter is standing before God and the congregation you know that you did a good job.
 - I am immensely proud of Deacon Asaph and Naamah for raising their daughter, and we can see that through their works
- As a mother you need to examine yourself

2 Corinthians 13:5 (KJV)

Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith: prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

As a mother you need to should be examining yourself to make sure you are setting the right example for your daughter, and for those who are spiritual mothers, you need to do the exact same thing.

- > Is your daughter a righteous example of you? If not you need to examine yourself
- My grandmother and mother always used to say that you get paid back through your children for all your rebelliousness, rudeness, all of the things you did as a rebellious teenager, you get that back from your children, but we have an opportunity to correct those things.
- Respect the righteous woman that your daughter is becoming, if you have raised her well in keeping the commandments, she has grown into her own woman. In the south they say that two women can't live in the same house, but 2 righteous women is a sisterhood.
- The daughter that the heavenly Father and give you responsibility for in Christ can grow to be a loving kind friend as well and that is something to take into consideration.

It is important to remember all of the biblical stories we have about virginity and marriage, as we set our daughters up for betrothal and marriage, we need to make sure our daughters have the following:

- Self confidence
- High Level of self esteem
- They need to know what real beauty is
- Understand 1 Peter 3:3 Beauty is not always outward adorning, but you still need to make yourself look attractive and keep yourself up until death do you part.
- Enforce the dress code policy , thus sayeth the lord
- Teach your daughters in the house what submission, and humility looks like
- Teach your daughter how to cook and be a homemaker
- A routine for laundry, studying, meal planning, waking up

We need to make sure we are setting our daughters up for success!



We don't date we wait for a wedding feast to celebrate!

It is a beautiful thing when we see all of these righteous marriages occurring from courting to betrothal to eventually marriage and having children.

We need to teach our children to be humble and giving, We have these examples of all the young women who are in the congregation that are now growing older getting married and having children, It's a blessing to be able to live through it and to see it.

We need to teach our daughters that the parents really have to decide and have the final decision when picking a lord for your daughter, and they need to trust the decision.

1 Timothy 5:14

I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

The purpose of Titus 2 is to direct our young women to do the following:

- To Marry
- To bear children
- To Guide the house
- To Give no occasion for the advisory to speak reproachfully

That is very important to both our physical and spiritual daughters in this truth to make sure that they adhere to those principles.

It is an honor to be here, What a journey it has been to have three daughter and to watch them grow, Sisters it is not easy.

- When we first came into the truth my lords daughters were already teenagers, for sisters who are just coming into the truth and have older children, and you see sisters who are just having babies and are able to start from scratch, its not impossible, it's doable. Now you are in the truth, and you are not by yourself.
- When my lords house started our family we did not have the, Israelite support, Mama Shamara, Mama Naamah, I had a feminist mother in law a feminist stepmother, and a mother that was absent. So it was a miracle and the work of the Most High, to get to this point. And to be able to marry my lord, to have two daughters marry, I have had the honor to raise his children and seeing that the fruits are being manifested, our middle



daughter just got married and yes she was a virgin, and it was an honor for all the years of toil and sacrifice to be able to see our prayers answered.

- For our daughters we started when the were young talking about marriage. It was never any instance where we condoned boyfriend and girlfriend.
- You have to emphasize to your children to come out of Babylon, I always emphasized yes go to college, we have to have a job in captivity, and you will always have something to fall back on to help your household and help your lord if something happens.
- It is important to emphasize that the purpose for you on this earth is to be a wife and a mother.

My Oldest Abigail is the brainiac of the family, she had aspirations about traveling the world doing international law, I told her all that is fine but you were born to be a mother. She finished Highschool at 14, she was homeschooled since second grade she taught herself calculus, taught herself trigonometry, she was so smart and bright. One day she came tome crying, saying she feels bad because she has been going to school and working hard because of the influence from the world, and her grandmother, but all she wants to do is be a wife and a mom, is it bad for having these feelings? I told her know that is your purpose.

• Even though we shelter our children , don't think that the world does not have influence o our children subconsciously.

You have to pray with out ceasing

1 Thessalonians 5:17

Pray without ceasing

You can not stop praying from the time the girls were little we always prayed, in it says wisdom walks with you in crooked places, Not knowing who we were then that the most High was merciful I would pray for their husbands, that he give them righteous husbands, like their father, that wont abuse them .

- I came from a broken home, and I went to see my mother when Abigail was born, and I told her that I forgive her for everything, because she was not aware that I remember things she had done.
- Sisters, Be careful with how you speak and to your children, it is one thing to discipline, but you have to make sure you are not tearing down without building them up.
- That trauma comes from how our mothers dealt with us, you have to rewrite history and not repeat it
- You can rewrite your future. I had to rewrite everything, it is not impossible, we are in the truth now we have righteous husbands, righteous leadership to guide us, and the scriptures to teach us how to break the generational curses.



You have to let your daughters know they have enemies, you have to emphasize what an enemy is, it is not always obvious ,like some having a gun , it could be someone at school smiling anyone not keeping the commandments and meant to derail you from your purpose.

Ecclesiasticus (Sirach) 6:13

13Separate thy self from thine enemies, and take heed of thy friends.

Sister Naamah:

When I was in college there were a group of 30 girls all of them where virgins, the first valentine's day all of them had lost their virginity, and I went to their rooms and all of them were crying, somof them were crying in the dark some crying in the light, and when I would ask them what was wrong, they all said they got dumped after sleeping with these boys the first year.

I remember when I first came in one of the Bishops wives asked me what school am I going to send her to when she goes to college, and if I would let her live on campus, and I said yes of course, she asked me how will I ensure her virginity if she lives on her own. And I never forgot that and I have kept close watch of her every since.

You have to teach them these girl are jealous of you, you have to make sure virginity is the norm. We have to

When you send your daughters to school if you are not able to home school they are not there to make friends you are their to get an education and get out. They should be keeping company with people who are like minded and keeping the commandments, the people at school are not their friends

2 Esdras 16:49(KJV)

Like as an whore envieth a right honest and virtuous woman:

- Do not let your guard down with your children, always keep up with what they are doing, do not get weary.
- My girls would talk about heir wedding when they were little, let them dream and imagine what their wedding feast will look like, we need to normalize marriage.
- Play wedding create a wedding feast for fun
- Start a hope chest for your daughter when they are 9 or 10, you can put things in it that the will take with them when they get married
- Cut a piece of fabric that they would want to use for their wedding
- > My daughter wrote letters to her married self

In the Black community there is so much emphasis and celebrations for the kids when they graduate there is assign on the grass and parties , Oh we have a senior , but yet they have a daughter who is a whore, or a daughter who had an abortion at 17 or 18, or she's smoking



weed. We need to celebrate when are children don't defile themselves, and save themselves for marriage.

We need to scrub our children's brains, and reprogramming them to what is Godly, reiterating the commandments and correcting all the wrong they see in the world.

Ecclesiasticus (Sirach) 42:9(APOC)
