

Q & A WITH MAMA ANNA HO BISHOP YAWASAP

Anna of the House of Bishop Yawasap is a mother figure we all desire to have in our lives. She is the Mother, Auntie, and Big Sister that will feed you, share pearls of wisdom with you, and correct you all in one hour. She is that person that if you invite her to your home, she just may kick you out of your own kitchen and make a huge pot of Bustelo tidying up as she goes along. Our Northern Kingdom Bishop's wife has been in the truth longer than some of us have been alive. Here is a short Q&A to give us a glimpse into who she is and share some of the knowledge that over twenty years of marriage will bring.



1. How do you as a wife lift up your lord when he is going through a heavy trial?

I tell my lord that trials/tribulations are not ours; there's a reason for everything. These storms are only for a moment. I try to remind him to give all his trust to TMH, and the Lord will make everything possible.

Mark 11:23-24 *For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.*

Psalms 118:6 *The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?*

Psalm 55:22 *Cast thy burden upon the Lord, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.*

1 Peter 5:7 *Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.*

2. How do you keep the fire going after being married for so many years?

You keep the fire by staying quiet and keeping the peace.

1 Peter 3:1 Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;

Ephesians 5:33 *Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.*

Give your lord what he wants & needs.... give it up! Never withhold sex from your lord!

1 Corinthians 7:3-5 *Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband. The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body, but the wife. Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency.*

Some suggestions and things to keep in mind are

- dress the way he would like for you to dress up
- speak to him using gracious words
- give him what he wants
- laugh together
- giving a massage to your lord and help him relax
- always make your lord feel valued & wanted
- set the mood from time to time: fixing the room w/ scented candles, putting smooth music & be romantic
- flirting with him

3. What advice would you have given your younger newlywed self?

I should have listened to & obeyed my father & mother in my earlier years

- head of the household (*Ephesians 5:23*)
- the key essence of a partnership is communication. Share ideas, have a righteous conversation, & enjoy one another (*James 1:19*)
- learn to stay quiet & speak w/ gracious words (*Proverbs 15:1*)
- be humble (*Galatians 5:22*)

Single Sisters Advice:

- obey & follow leadership counsel (*Hebrews 13:17*)
- take correction (*Proverbs 12:1*)
- take heed of the scriptures and Pay Attention! (*1 Timothy 3:16*)

4. As women we all go through emotional periods/rough patches..what do you do to bounce back?

First thing is to SPA - Study, pray, and apply. Fast, watch some videos & spend some time with your sisters. Seek TMH & ask him to remove that spirit out of you.

Joel 2:12 *Therefore also now, saith the LORD, turn ye even to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning:*
